THE TWINS: Have gone 1-3 through four games on their nine-game, 10-day homestand, dropping a three-game series 2-1 against the Cardinals over the weekend, followed by a loss against the Braves last night...this evening, the Twins will continue the homestand with the second of three games against Atlanta and finish the series tomorrow night...they will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then play three against the Blue Jays over the weekend.

**Pespite going 2-6 in their last eight games and 9-11 in their last 20, the Twins are 65-46 in their last 111 games since April 22, tied with Los Angeles-NL (65-42) for the most wins in baseball since that date.

RUNS, RAIN AND MORE RUNS: The Twins lost to the Braves last night at Target Field by a score of 10-6...the game experienced an 86-minute rain delay in the second inning...Bailey Ober (12-6) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing nine runs on seven hits in 2.0 innings pitched, all nine runs coming in the first two innings (4 in the 1st, 5 in the 2nd)... Scott Blewett pitched 3.0 scoreless innings of relief with no walks and three strikeouts...the oftense recorded nine hits, three coming from Manny Margot, who singled twice and doubled (13)...Minnesota hit two home runs, one from Kyle Farmer (2) and one from Matt Wallner (10).

TWINS AND BRAVES: The Twins and Braves are playing each other in the regular season for the 23rd, 24th and 25th times in their history this week...the Twins are 8-15 all-time against the Braves in the regular season, going 6-9 in Minnesota and 2-6 in Georgia (4-2 at the Metrodome, 2-7 at Target Field, 2-3 at Turner Field and 0-3 at Truist Park).

The Twins have dropped six-straight against the Braves, dating back to August of 2019... their last win over Atlanta came on August 5, 2019, when Miguel Sanó hit a pinch-hit, 443-foot, two-run, walk-off home run to centerfield against Chris Martin, giving the Twins a 5-3 victory.

INTERLEAGUE, NOT IDEAL: The Twins are 16-22 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL, 1-2 at Chicago, 1-2 at San Diego, 1-2 vs. St. Louis and 0-1 vs. Atlanta.
♣ Twins are just 6-13 against NL opponents since July 14.
♣ By comparison, the Twins have gone 56-37 against American League opponents.
♣ The Twins went 25-21 in Interleague Play in 2023.
♣ Minnesota has two more series against NL opponents after this series: three against the Reds at home from September 13-15 and three against the Marlins at home from September 24-26.

THAT'S WHAT I'M TONKIN ABOUT: The Twins announced today that they have claimed right-handed pitcher Michael Tonkin off waivers from the New York Yankees. To make room for Tonkin on the 40-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Trevor Richards for release or assignment...Richards made 10 appearances for the Twins this season, going 0-1 4.15 ERA (13.0 IP, 6 ER). 11 walks and 13 strikeouts.

♣ Tonkin, 34, appeared in 39 games for the Yankees this season, going 3-2, 3.38 ERA (56.0 IP, 21 ER), 21 walks, 57 strikeouts and a .214 BAA...he was claimed off waivers by the Twins from the New York Mets earlier this season and made one appearance for Minnesota on April 12 at Detroit, allowing two runs on two hits in 2.0 innings, with two walks and five strikeouts...overall this season, he has gone 4-4, 3.74 ERA (65.0 IP, 27 ER), two saves, 25 walks, 68 strikeouts and a .223 BAA in 45 games for the Mets, Twins and Yankees.

♣ Additionally, the Twins have selected the contract of Caleb Boushley, who will join the Twins tonight, taking the vacated 26-man roster spot of Richards...to make room for Boushley on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan to the 60-day Injured List (right shoulder strain).

♣ Boushley (pronounced BOZ-lee), 30, has made 22 starts for the Saints this season, going 9-5, 4.97 ERA (116.0 IP, 64 ER), 20 walks, 94 strikeouts and a 1.30 WHIP...this marks Boushley's third stint with the Iwins this season...he made one appearance for Minnesota on May 20 at Washington, allowing two runs on three hits in 2.0 innings pitched, with one walk and one strikeout.

♣ Tonkin will join Minnesota's active roster when he reports to Target Field.

HOME SECURITY: Despite going 3-6 in their last nine at home, the Twins have gone 37-27 at Target Field this season, fifth-most home wins in the AL and tied for ninth-most in baseball.

₱ Matt Wallner is hitting, 364 (12-for-33) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI, seven walks, a .488 on-base percentage, a .758 slugging percentage and a 1.245 OPS in his last 11 home games.

₱ Royce Lewis is hitting, 329 (28-for-85) with five doubles, nine home runs, 24 RBI, a .706 slugging percentage and a 1.114 OPS in 24 home games this season.

CEMENT BONES: Matt Wallner has five hits (1 2B, 2 HR) and one walk in his last 11 plate appearances for a .636 on-base percentage in his last three games...in his last 36 games, since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul, he is hitting .317 (33-tor-104) with 11 doubles, one triple, nine home runs, 22 RBI, a .437 on-base percentage, a .702 slugging percentage and a 1.138 OPS.

Since that July 7 date, he ranks seventh in average exit velocity (min. 500 pitches seen) at 95.1 mph, trailing Patrick Wisdom (97.4), Martin Maldonado (96.9), Ivan Herrera (95.7), Austin Riley (95.7), Giancarlo Stanton (95.3) and Romy Gonzalez (95.3).

JEFF YEA: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .323 (10-for-23) with four home runs, seven RBI, a .382 on-base percentage, a .710 slugging percentage and a 1.092 OPS in his last 10 games. **▼**Jeffers needs one more hit to match his single-season career high of 79, done in 2023.

Paul, did not play last night as the club had the day off...St. Paul travels to Omaha to play the Storm Chasers at 6:35 pm tonight...

through two games on rehab assignment, Lee has gone 4-for-8 with three extra-base hits and three RBI...Brooks has been on the IL since August 9 with right biceps tendinitis.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1996**, Paul Molitor recorded one of his seven career five-hit games at Toronto — all singles...in **2002**, Cristian Guzmán went 0-for-4 against the Mariners, snapping his 23-game hitting streak — tied for sixth-longest in club history...in **2017**, Byron Buxton hit three home runs at the Rogers Centre in Toronto.

HIM THOME: Hall of Famer Jim Thome is celebrating his 54th birthday today...the last major league game that Thome played on his birthday was in 2011 (with Cleveland) as he hit the 602nd of his 612 career home runs.
