TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing their final series of the season this weekend...the I wins are 10-1 vs. the Sox this season, going 5-0 at Target Field and 5-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Minnesota has gone 17-2 in its fast 19 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

♣ Twins have won 10-straight at home against the White Sox, their longest streak against the Sox in Minnesota...it is tied for third-longest Twins winning streak at home against a single opponent in their history (since 1961): 17 vs. Boston at Met Stadium from August 4, 1964-May 7, 1966; 12 vs. Baltimore at Target Field from July 5, 2018-July 2, 2022; and 10 vs. Tampa Bay at the Metrodome from July 21, 2004-April 12, 2007.

♣ Minnesota's .909 winning percentage against the Sox this season is the highest in their history, ahead of their 1966 total of .778 (14-4) and their 2001 total of .737 (14-5).

♣ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 97-70 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

I'M NOT IN A SLUMP, BRO: Royce Lewis went 2-for-4 with a double, a home run and four RBI last night...he entered the game 4-for-19 (.211) with a .792 OPS in six games (from July 26-31) since returning from the 10-day IL.

◆ Last night marked his eighth career game with four-plus RBI; eight games with four-plus RBI through a player's first 101 career games is the most such games in MLB history.

◆ Lewis' 9.33 at-bat-per-home run ratio this season leads baseball (minimum of 100 at-bats), ahead of Aaron Judge (9.75) and Mike Irout (10.90)...Royce (12 homers) is already three homers away from his single-season career high, playing in his 32nd game tonight... he hit 15 in just 58 games last season.

THE LEFTORIUM: Minnesota enters today with a .270 batting average vs. left-handed pitching, the best in the AL and second-best mark in baseball, trailing Philadelphia (.281).

♣ Willi Castro is hitting .304 (31-for-102) with an .833 OPS vs. left-handed pitching.

♣ Manny Margot is slashing .314/.355/.457 in his last 33 games against southpaws.

♣ Byron Buxton is hitting .382 (13-for-34) with a .991 OPS in his last 17 games against lefties.

♣ Carlos Santana is slashing .378/.440/.667 (1.107 OPS) in last 23 vs. lefties.

♣ Royce Lewis is hitting .364 (12-for-33) with a 1.147 OPS against lefties this season.

MAKING A TARGET RUN: Last night the Twins drew 30,801 in attendance, marking the 11th time the Twins have drawn at least 30K this season...their high for 2024 is 41,679 on July 20 vs. Milwaukee, their only sellout of the season so far.

TWINS Milb MONTHLYS: Double-A Wichita infielder Luke Keaschall and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Charlee Soto have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the month for July.

Fixeaschall, 21, played in 20 games for the Wind Surge, slashing .290/.426/.513 (.939 OPS) with five home runs, 12 RBI, 12 walks and 15 runs scored in 20 games.

Fixeaschall, 21, played in 20 games for the Mighty Mussels, allowing just four earned runs in 13.0 innings pitched (2.77 ERA), while holding opponents to a .192 average with three walks and 16 strikeouts.

BASEBALL IM-MAUER-TALITY: In a special pregame ceremony beginning at 5:45 pm tonight, the Twins will honor 2024 National Baseball Hall of Fame inductee Joe Mauer, who was inducted on July 21...the 2009 American League Most Valuable Player spent his entire 15-season career with his hometown Twins...some notes about Mauer's career and induction, courtesy of MLB Network.

The Mauer is the third catcher elected to HOF on first ballot (Johnny Bench, Ivan Rodriguez)...he is also the fourth player to make HOF after being drafted first overall (Ken Griffey Jr., Chipper Jones, Harold Baines).

Mauer made his major league debut in 2004 and is the first Hall of Famer to play his entire career in the 2000s (debuted in 2004)... he is also the first player born in the 1980s to enter Cooperstown (born in 1983).

Mauer is one of just eight single-team HOFers to play entire career in home state, joining Whitey Ford (New York), Lou Gehrig (New York), Charlie Gehringer (Michigan), Tony Gwynn (California), Barry Larkin (Ohio), Cal Ripken Jr. (Maryland) and Phil Rizzuto (New York)...only Harmon Killebrew (1,329) played more games in a Minnesota Twins uniform than Mauer (1,858).

Mauer is also one of 22 retired MVPs to play their entire career of 15-plus seasons with one franchise — all are in the HOF.

BACK AT HOME: Making his ninth home start of the season today...in previous eight, he's gone 5-1 with a 3.18 ERA (45.1 IP, 16 ER), 10 walks, 49 strikeouts, a 1.06 WHIP and a .225 (38-for-169) opponent batting average...in 12 road starts, he is 5-4, 4.13 ERA (69.2 IP, 32 ER), 17 walks, 72 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and a .204 (51-for-250) opponent batting average.

The Has gone 12-5 with a 3.49 ERA (193.2 IP, 75 ER) in 37 career home starts compared to 11-12 with a 3.83 ERA (214.0 IP, 91 ER) in 40 career road starts.

The Twins are 5-3 in Ober's eight home starts this season

Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is second in home wins on the Twins with 12, trailing and the Pure (118), has five hore wires this season

- REVERSE SPLITS: On July 22, Detroit left-handed hitters went 0-for-11 with four strikeouts against Ober, while righties went 1-for-14 with two walks and seven strikeouts.
