TWINS AND JAYS: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing the fourth of six meetings in 2024...
Minnesota visited Toronto for a three-game series at the Rogers Centre from May 10-12, going 2-1 and winning the bookend games.

♣ Including the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 6-2 in their last eight games against the Blue Jays, dating back to June of 2023.

♣ Notable numbers from the three-game series in Toronto earlier this season: Edouard Julien went 4-for-8 (.500) with one walk...Carlos Santana went 5-for-12 (.417) with one double, three home runs and seven RBI...Max Kepler went 4-for-10 (.400) with two doubles and three RBI...Twins starters (Joe Ryan, Simeon Woods Richardson and Bailey Ober) went 2-0, 3.06 ERA (17.2 IP, 6 ER) with one walk, 19 strikeouts and a .224 opponent batting average.

♣ Québec City native Edouard Julien is 10-for-25 (.400) with four doubles, one home run, six walks, a .516 on-base percentage and a 1.196 OPS in eight career regular season games against Toronto...Julien grew up a Blue Jays fan.

SPLIT OPEN AND MELT: The last time these two teams met in Minneapolis was in the 2023 AL Wild Card Series as the Twins swept in two, taking Game 1 on October 3 by a score of 3-1 and Game 2 on October 4 by a score of 2-0...the Game 1 win snapped an MLB record 18-game playoff losing streak...the series win marked Minnesota's first since the 2002 ALDS series victory over Oakland...Minnesota moved on to lose 3-1 to Houston in the ALDS.

◆ Tonight's pitching matchup was the same for Game 1 of the that series as Pablo López earned the win, allowing one run on five hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts; his only run allowed came in the sixth inning on a Kevin Kiermaier RBI single...Kevin Gausman was dealt the loss, allowing three runs on three hits in 4.0 innings pitched, including a two-run homer to Royce Lewis in the first inning and a solo shot to Royce in the third inning.

LATE ARRIVALS: The Twins have scored 11 of their 22 runs on this homestand after the sixth inning...on the season, they have scored 244 runs in the seventh inning-or-later, the most in MLB, ahead of second-place Arizona (243)...Minnesota has scored 87 runs in the seventh (4th in MLB), 71 in the eighth (T-10th in MLB), 63 in the ninth (2nd in MLB) and 23 in extras (T-5th in MLB).

JEFF AROUND AND FIND OUT: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .325 (13-for-40) with two doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, a .372 on-base percentage, a .675 slugging percentage and a 1.047 OPS in his last 12 games.

◆ With two hits on Wednesday night vs. Atlanta, he now has 81 hits on the season, setting a new single-season career-high (previous high of 79 in 2023)...additionally this season, he has set career-highs in games (100), runs (48), doubles (20), home runs (20) and RBI (59).

THE BOOK ON BROOKS: Brooks Lee has played four games on rehab assignment for Triple-A St. Paul, going 4-for-15 with three extra-base hits and three RBI...St. Paul plays two today at Omaha...Brooks has been on the IL since August 9 with right biceps tendinitis.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1987**, Kirby Puckett set a club record with six hits at Milwaukee, recording two home runs, two doubles and two singles...Puckett tied his own record May 23, 1991 in 11 innings vs. Texas...in **2007**, the Twins held a ceremony to break ground on Target Field...Target Field's first official game was on April 12, 2010 vs. Boston (5-4 win).

SO MUCH DRIP, WE MIGHT MAKE ANOTHER LAKE: Tonight, the Twins are wearing their 2024 Nike MLB City Connect Series uniform, a look that embodies this majestic and "where the water reflects the sky" and celebrates the 10,000 lakes that shape and unite us... remaining tentative dates these will be worn: tonight against Toronto, September 13 vs. Cincinnati and September 27 vs. Baltimore.

TWINS ON A STICK: The Twins are at the 2024 Minnesota State Fair, with interactive games, giveaways and special appearances all part of the team's daily lineup...the Minnesota Twins Experience is located on the south end of Cooper Street at Judson Avenue, next to the International Bazaar, and is open from 9:00 am to 9:00 pm daily, rain or shine, throughout the State Fair's duration (through Monday, September 2).
