THE TWINS: After completing their six-game, seven-day roadtrip with a record of 3-3 (2-1 at DET and 1-2 at NYM), the Twins began their weekend series/homestand against the White Sox with consecutive wins over the last two nights...

MINNESOTA HAS GONE 54-35 IN ITS LAST 89 GAMES SINCE APRIL 22, THE MOST WINS IN BASEBALL SINCE THAT DATE.

JOE MAUER THOUGHT THAT WIN WAS A PRETTY NIFTY LITTLE DEAL: The Twins beat the White Sox at Target Field last night by a score of 6-2... Bailey Ober (11-5) was the starter and winner, allowing two runs on two hits in 7.0 innings pitched...

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins and White Sox are playing for the final time in 2024 today... the Twins are 11-1 vs. the Sox this season, going 6-0 at Target Field and 5-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field...

TWINS HAVE WON 11-STRAIGHT AT HOME AGAINST THE WHITE SOX, THEIR LONGEST STREAK AGAINST THE SOX IN MINNESOTA... IT IS THE THIRD-LONGEST TWINS WINNING STREAK AT HOME AGAINST A SINGLE OPPONENT IN THEIR HISTORY (SINCE 1961): 17 vs. Boston at Met Stadium from August 4, 1964-May 7, 1966; and 12 vs. Baltimore at Target Field from July 5, 2018-July 2, 2022.

MINNESOTA'S .917 WINNING PERCENTAGE AGAINST THE SOX THIS SEASON IS THE HIGHEST IN THEIR HISTORY, AHEAD OF THEIR 1966 TOTAL OF .778 (14-4) AND THEIR 2001 TOTAL OF .737 (14-5).

SINCE 2015, THE TWINS HAVE GONE 98-70 AGAINST THE SOX, THEIR MOST WINS AGAINST ANY OPPONENT IN THAT SPAN.

BYRON BUXTON IS HITTING .352 (44-for-125) WITH 10 DOUBLES, ONE TRIPLE, 14 HOME RUNS, 27 RBI, A .784 SLUGGING PERCENTAGE AND A 1.210 OPS IN HIS LAST 35 GAMES AGAINST THE SOX.

CARLOS SANTANA IS THE ALL-TIME LEADER AMONG ACTIVES IN CAREER WALKS (118) AND GAMES (191) AGAINST THE WHITE SOX... ALSO, ON THAT LIST, HE RANKS SECOND IN RUNS (92), TIED FOR SECOND IN HOME RUNS (26), AND THIRD IN HITS (151) AND RBI (82).

SINCE THE START OF LAST SEASON, RYAN JEFFERS IS HITTING .375 (21-for-56) WITH A 1.078 OPS IN 17 GAMES VS. THE WHITE SOX.

ROYCE MAKING NOISE: Royce Lewis is hitting .300 (3-for-10) with two doubles, one home run, five RBI, four walks, a .500 on-base percentage, an .800 slugging percentage and a 1.300 OPS in his last three games... he was reinstated from the IL on July 26 and hit just .200 (3-for-15) with two extra-base hits, two walks, a .294 on-base percentage and a .761 OPS in his first five games from July 26-30.

LEWIS' 9.50 AT-BAT-PER-HOME RUN RATIO THIS SEASON LEADS BASEBALL (MINIMUM OF 100 AT-BATS), AHEAD OF AARON JUDGE (9.59) AND MIKE TROUT (10.90)... ROYCE (12 HOMERS) IS ALREADY THREE HOMERS AWAY FROM HIS SINGLE-SEASON CAREER HIGH, PLAYING IN HIS 33RD GAME TODAY... HE HIT 15 IN JUST 58 GAMES LAST SEASON.

LEWIS' 162-GAME AVERAGES ARE: .299 BATTING AVERAGE, 30 DOUBLES, 46 HOME RUNS, 130 RBI, 98 RUNS SCORED, 57 WALKS AND A .948 OPS.

STARTER STUFF: In 13 games since the All-Star break, the Twins starting staff has combined to go 6-3, 3.00 ERA (75.0 IP, 25 ER) with eight home runs allowed, 20 walks and 77 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .179 average - the second-lowest opponent batting average in baseball in that span, behind only San Diego's starting pitchers (.164).

THE MOOSE IS LOOSE: Matt Wallner began the season hitting .080 (2-for-25) with a .513 OPS in 13 games from March 28-April 15 before being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul... since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on July 7, he has hit .340 (16-for-47) with five doubles, five home runs, nine RBI, a .436 on-base percentage, a .766 slugging percentage and a 1.202 OPS in 16 games.

IN HIS LAST 35 GAMES BETWEEN ST. PAUL AND MINNESOTA COMBINED, HE HAS SLASHED .357/.434/.754 (1.188 OPS).

SWEEPING SUCCESS: Minnesota is seeking its fifth sweep of the season today... their other four sweeps were four games against Chicago-AL from April 22-25, three games at Los Angeles-AL from April 26-28, three games at Chicago-AL from April 29-May 1 and four games vs. Oakland from June 13-16... Twins had six sweeps in 2023.

THEY ARE LOOKING TO SWEEP THE WHITE SOX FOR THE THIRD TIME THIS SEASON... THE ONLY TIME THEY HAVE EVER SWEEPED THE SOX THREE TIMES IN ONE SEASON CAME IN 1966, SWEEPING IN THREE GAMES TWICE AND TWO GAMES ONCE.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul outfielder DaShawn Keirsejy Jr. and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Tanner Hall have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of Week.

KEIRSEJY, 27, PLAYED IN SIX GAMES FOR THE SAINTS, HITTING .320 (8-for-25) WITH ONE DOUBLE, ONE HOME RUN, THREE RBI, SIX RUNS SCORED AND AN .850 OPS... THE SAN DIEGO, CA NATIVE WAS SELECTED BY THE TWINS IN THE FOURTH ROUND OF THE 2018 FIRST-YEAR PLAYER DRAFT OUT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF UTAH.

HALL, 22, STARTED ON THURSDAY VS. ST. LUCIE, ALLOWING TWO RUNS ON FOUR HITS IN 6.0 INNINGS PITCHED, WITH ONE WALK AND NINE STRIKEOUTS... THE BATON ROUGE, LA NATIVE WAS SELECTED BY THE TWINS IN THE FOURTH ROUND OF THE 2023 FIRST-YEAR PLAYER DRAFT OUT OF THE UNIVERSITY OF MISSISSIPPI.

THE BRONZED MAN: The Twins announced last night that St. Paul native, franchise legend and 2024 National Baseball Hall of Fame inductee Joe Mauer will have a statue in his honor placed outside of Target Field at a to-be-determined date during the 2025 major league season... Mauer will join Rod Carew (April 2010), Harmon Killebrew (April 2010), Kirby Puckett (April 2010), Carl and Eloise Pohlrad (October 2010), Tony Oliva (April 2011), Kent Hrbek (April 2012) and Tom Kelly (June 2017) as Minnesota Twins legends immortalized with a statue outside Target Field... all previous statues are the work of Minnesota-based artist Bill Mack.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1985, Rod Carew became the 16th player ever to collect 3,000 career hits as he recorded it off Minnesota's Frank Viola, singling in the third inning at Anaheim Stadium.

- Making 19th MLB start of 2024 and 20th of career (21st appearance)...last pitched July 29 at New York-NL and took the loss in Minnesota's 15-2 defeat; allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 3.1 innings, with three walks and two strikeouts.
Has faced Chicago-AL twice this season, posting a 3.12 ERA (8.2 IP, 3 ER) with three walks and eight strikeouts...Minnesota won both games.
Ranks eighth among MLB rookies (min. 60.0 IP) with a 3.74 ERA.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched July 29 at New York-NL, opposite Jose Quintana, and took the loss in Minnesota's 15-2 defeat...allowed six runs on seven hits (1 HR) in 3.1 innings, with three walks and two strikeouts...all six runs came in the fourth, when he threw 36 pitches, allowed five hits and two walks and was pulled with one out; first seven Mets reached base in the inning...Cole Sands entered with runners on first and third and allowed one inherited run.
Induced nine whiffs on 42 swings (21.4%)...ranks in MLB's 22nd percentile with a 21.7 percent whiff rate.
Allowed three hard-hit balls (95.0+ mph)...allowed three singles with an exit velocity less than 76.0 mph...ranks in MLB's 69th percentile with a 36.2 percent hard-hit rate.
Six runs allowed set a new career high, 3.1 innings a new career low.

PHANTASTIC VS. PHILLY: Made the start July 23 vs. Philadelphia, opposite Zack Wheeler, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-0 loss...threw 6.0 scoreless innings with three hits, one walk and five strikeouts...only one runner reached scoring position - Bryson Stott, with a third-inning stolen base...recorded first career pickoff in the sixth, throwing out Johan Rojas at first.
For the second-straight start, induced 10 whiffs on 45 swings (22.2%).
Allowed five hard-hit balls; Philadelphia went 2-for-5 on those swings.

SWR VS. CWS: Has faced Chicago-AL twice this season, on April 25 and 30, posting a 3.12 ERA (8.2 IP, 3 ER) with three walks, eight strikeouts, a .368 (14-for-38) opponent batting average and .852 opponent OPS.
April 25 marked his first career start at Target Field; allowed two runs in 5.0-inning no-decision as Minnesota won 6-3.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making ninth home start of the season...has gone 1-0 with a 3.09 ERA (43.2 IP, 15 ER), 8.45 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings, 3.09 walks-per-9.0 innings and 0.62 home-runs-per-9.0 innings at home, compared to 2-2 with a 4.34 ERA (47.2 IP, 23 ER), 6.99 K/9, 2.45 BB/9 and 1.13 HR/9 in 10 road starts...has allowed a .187 (29-for-155) batting average and .538 OPS at home, compared to .273 (51-for-187) BAA and .749 OPS on the road.

REVERSE SPLITS: Through 18 games vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .206 (28-for-136) with a .265 slugging percentage, .553 OPS, 20.5 percent strikeout rate and 9.0 percent walk rate, while righties have hit .252 (52-for-206) with a .422 SLG, .720 OPS, 20.5 percent strikeout rate and 6.1 percent walk rate...righties have hit 20 of the 24 extra-base hits vs. Woods Richardson.
On July 29, New York-NL's lefties went 2-for-7 with two walks and one strikeout vs. Woods Richardson, while its righties went 5-for-9 with one double, one home run, one walk and one strikeout.
Hard-hit rate vs. Woods Richardson: 33.0 percent by lefties, 38.9 percent by righties.
Among right-handed pitchers, Woods Richardson has allowed the third-lowest SLG (.265) and sixth-lowest OPS (.553) to left-handed hitters (min. 150 LHB faced).

THE ARSENAL: Woods Richardson has used a four-pitch mix this season...here's his 2024 repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

Ranks in MLB's 87th percentile with a fastball run value of eight.
His slider ranks 12th in baseball (min. 100 PA) with a .299 opponent SLG, 11th with a .244 wOBA and sixth with a 26.3 percent hard-hit rate.
On July 29 at New York-NL, allowed first home run with his 4-seamer...had thrown the most 4-seamers in baseball without allowing a home run.
At New York-NL, his 4-seamer tied a season high with a 94.0 mph average (also 6/8 at PIT).
At New York-NL, threw 42 sliders (51.9%)...the pitch allowed four hits (4-for-8), after allowing four (4-for-30) in his previous five starts combined.
Opponents are slugging .308 vs. his 4-seamer, fifth lowest in baseball (min. 150 PA).

David Festa is scheduled to make his fourth career start (5th appearance) in tomorrow night's series opener at Chicago-NL...last pitched July 30 at New York-NL and took the loss in Minnesota's 2-0 defeat; allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...has held opponents to a .206 (7-for-34) batting average and .289 on-base percentage over his last two appearances.

CAREER NOTES

- Entered 2024 ranked by Baseball America as Minnesota's No. 29 prospect.
In 2023, finished second on Saint Paul's staff with 113.2 innings and 22 starts.
Was named Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Week on September 10, 2023 after allowing one run in a 6.0-inning, five-strikeout start at Louisville.
In 2023 with Triple-A Saint Paul, went 7-1 with a 3.03 ERA (71.1 IP, 24 ER), 35 walks, 60 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average in his final 14 games (12 starts) from June 20-September 20.
Made only MLB appearance of 2023 on April 22 vs. Washington, allowing five runs on seven hits in 4.2 innings of relief.
Entering 2023, was ranked eighth-best prospect in Minnesota organization by MLB.com and 10th-best by Baseball America.
Posted a 2.72 ERA with 38 walks, 118 strikeouts and a .199 opponent batting average across three levels in 2022.
Made major league debut Oct. 2, 2022 in Detroit, allowing three runs (two earned) on three hits and taking the loss in a 5.0-inning start...at 22 years and five days, was the youngest pitcher to make big league debut in 2022.
Reached Triple-A level for the first time in 2022, pitching 36.2 innings with a 2.21 ERA for St. Paul.
With Wichita, was named Texas League Pitcher of the Month in April 2022, going 2-0 with a 0.00 ERA, seven walks and 18 strikeouts in 21.2 innings.
While in Tokyo, was traded to Minnesota alongside Austin Martin in exchange for Jose Berrios...finished season with Double-A Wichita, posting a 6.75 ERA in four appearances.
Made Team USA's roster for the 2021 Tokyo Olympics but didn't appear in a game for the silver medal-winning Americans.
In 2021, participated in first MLB Spring Training as a non-roster invitee with Toronto.
Finished 2019 with High-A Dunedin as the youngest pitcher in Florida State League, going 3-2 with a 2.54 ERA in six starts.
In 2019, posted 4.25 ERA in 20 starts for Low-A Columbia before being dealt to Toronto in trade that sent Marcus Stroman to the Mets.
Finished 2018 season with Rookie-Kingsport, allowing three runs on six hits with 11 strikeouts in two appearances.
Made professional debut with GCL Mets on July 22, 2018, earning the save in a hitless, one-inning appearance.
Selected by New York-NL in the second round of 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Kempner High School (TX).
