DID ROYCE HOMER YESTERDAY?

-N0- *YES. OF COURSE* THE TWINS: Finished their three-game homestand with a sweep of the White Sox over the weekend...tonight, the Iwins will begin a short three-game roadtrip with three games against the Cubs at Wrigley Field through Wednesday afternoon...after this series, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then begin a six-day, seven-game homestand with four against the Guardians this weekend (split doubleheader on Friday), followed by three against the Royals from next Monday-Wednesday.

◆ Minnesota has gone 55-35 in its last 90 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date, ahead of second-place Baltimore at 53-39...90 games is 82% of their schedule played so far this season.

◆ Yesterday's win moved the Iwins to a season-high 14 games over .500...the last time they were 14 games over was through games of September 28, 2019, when they were 41 games over (101-60).

TWINS FLEX ON THE SOX: The Twins beat the White Sox yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 13-7, sweeping their fifth series of the season and winning their fourth-straight game...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits in 4.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded 13 hits, added nine times and went 5-for-15 with runners in scoring position...Willi Castro and Jose Miranda each had three hits, as Castro hit his team-leading 25th double and finished with three RBI...Royce Lewis added a home run (13) and drove in three runs on the afternoon.

WHAT HAD TO BE DONE: A brief look inside the three-game weekend series with the White Sox:

◆ Yesterday marked the fifth Twins sweep this season and third of Chicago-AL...the only previous time they have ever swept the Sox three times in one season came in 1966.

◆ Minnesota outscored Chicago-AL 29-11 and outhit them 31-18.

◆ Twins hit .313 (31-for-99), posted a 1.050 OPS and scored 9.7 runs-per-game...they also walked 22 times in the series, their most in one series this season.

◆ Twins hit .355 (11-for-31) with RISP.

◆ Started series 6.5 games back of Cleveland and narrowed the Guardians' lead to 4.5 games.

 MINNESOTA NICE FRIENDLY CONFINES: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 41st, 42nd and 43rd time in their history this week...the Twins are 19-21 all-time against the Cubs, going 5-6 at Target Field, 8-12 at Wngley Field and 6-3 at the Metrodome...Minnesota has gone 4-1 in their last five against the Cubs (since '21) and 6-3 in their last nine (since '20).
 ◆ 40 games against the Cubs are the Twins' second-most against any National League opponent, trailing Pittsburgh (45)...that excludes Milwaukee, which was in the AL from 1969-97.
 ◆ The last time these two met was for a three-game series at Target Field from May 12-14, 2023 as the Twins won games two and three...the Twins won by scores of 11-1 in game two and 16-3 in game three...they outscored the Cubs 29-10 over the three-game series; 29 runs scored in the series marked a Target Field high over a three-game series...the Twins tied that this last weekend vs. the White Sox.
 ◆ This marks the eighth series the Twins have played at Wrigley and first since sweeping a two-game series here from September 21-22 2021...Minnesota has won four-straight games on the North Side, their last loss here coming on September 18, 2020.
 ◆ Max Kepler is hitting, 406 (13-for-32) with three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, a .781 slugging percentage and a 1.205 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Cubs...he homered twice in his last game here on September 22, 2021, both off Hendricks.
 ◆ Bally Sports North TV stud (and sneaky great athlete) and Chicago native Cory Provus began his MLB broadcast career in 2007 as the Cubs pre- and post-game show host...he also handled play-by-play duties, backing up Hall of Famer Pat Hughes during games and anchored the morning and afternoon drive sportscasts as a reporter for WGN-AM in Chicago.

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 13-15 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia and 1-2 at New York-NL.

◆ Byron Buxton is hitting .316 (30-for-95) with three doubles, eight home runs, 17 RBI, a .600 slugging percentage and a .971 OPS in 26 games against the NL this season...his batting average ranks 11th and his OPS ranks 12th among all MLB players (min. 100 PA).

LOUD ROYCES!: Royce Lewis is hitting .357 (5-for-14) with two doubles, two home runs, eight RBI, five walks, a .526 on-base percentage, a .929 slugging percentage and a 1.455 OPS in his last four games...he was reinstated from the IL on July 26 and hit just .200 (3-for-15) with two extra-base hits, two walks, a .294 on-base percentage and a .761 OPS in his first five games from July 26-30.

4 Lewis' 9.08 at-bat-per-home run ratio this season leads baseball (minimum of 100 at-bats)...Royce (13 homers) is already two homers away from his single-season career high, playing in his 34th game tonight...he hit 15 in just 58 games last season.

KINGS OF THE HILL: In 14 games since the All-Star break, the Twins starting staff has combined to go 6-3, 3.19 ERA (79.0 IP, 28 ER) with eight home runs allowed, 23 walks and 83 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .189 average — the third-lowest opponent batting average in baseball in that span, behind only San Diego (.160) and San Francisco (.179).

THE GREAT WALL OF FOREST LAKE: Matt Wallner began the season hitting .080 (2-for-25) with a .513 OPS in 13 games from March 28-April 15 before being optioned to Triple-A St. Paul...since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on July 7, he has hit .347 (17-for-49) with five doubles, five home runs, 10 RBI, a .467 on-base percentage, a .796 slugging percentage and a 1.263 OPS in 17 games.

◆ Additionally, since that July 7 date, he ranks fourth in baseball in average exit velocity (minimum of 300 pitches seen) at 98.0 mph and fifth in slugging percentage (.796).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2001, Kirby Puckett and Dave Winfield, along with Bill Mazeroski and Hilton Smith, were inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame...in 2023, the Twins inducted Joe Mauer into their Hall of Fame, making him the 38th member of the club...Mauer was recently inducted into the National Baseball Hall of Fame on July 21.
