the weekend, the Twins began their three-game Wrigley Field roadtrip with a win over the Cubs last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of three on the North Side...after tomorrow afternoon's game, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then begin a six-day, seven-game homestand with four against the Guardians this weekend (split doubleheader on Friday), followed by three against the Royals from next Monday-Wednesday.

Minnesota has gone 56-35 in its last 91 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...91 games is 82% of their schedule played so far this season.

SLIM REAPER PAYS VISIT TO NORTH SIDE: The Twins shut out the Cubs last night at Wrigley Field by a score of 3-0...it marked Minnesota's sixth shutout of the season and fourth on the road...David Festa (2-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 5.0 scoreless innings, with two hits allowed, two walks and a career-high nine strikeouts (19 batters faced)...Caleb Thielbar (1.0), Jorge Alcala (1.0), hoan Duran (1.0) and Griffin Jax (1.0) all combined to pitch 4.0 scoreless innings of relief with two hits allowed, no walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two each from Trevor Larnach, Matt Wallner and Manny Margot...Wallner hit two doubles (7, 8), while Margot hit his fourth home run of the season.

PABLO LÓP-ACE: Pablo López has gone 4-1, 2.86 ERA (44.0 IP, 14 ER) with 10 walks, 55 strikeouts and a .196 opponent batting average in his last seven starts since June 23...below are López's ranks among AL starters in a few categories since June 23:

RIGHT FROM THE START: In 15 games since the All-Star break, the Twins starting staff has combined to go 7-3, 3.00 ERA (84.0 IP, 28 ER) with eight home runs allowed, 25 walks and 92 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .185 average — the third-lowest opponent batting average in baseball in that span, behind only San Diego (.160) and San Francisco (.180).

AND WHY IS THE CARPET ALL WET TODD?! I DON'T KNOW, MARGOT!!: Manny Margot is leading off today for the 22nd time this season (typically vs. LHS), third-most on the team (Castro - 29, Julien - 29)...on the season, he is hitting .318 (28-for-88) with an .848 OPS from the leadoff spot...in his last 31 games overall, since June 22, Manny Margot is slashing .286/.307/.452 (.759 OPS)...below are his numbers through games of June 21 and since June 22:

GO TWINS GO: The Twins and Cubs are playing each other for the 41st, 42nd and 43rd time in their history this week...the Twins are 20-21 all-time against the Cubs, going 5-6 at Target Field, 9-12 at Wrigley Field and 6-3 at the Metrodome...Minnesota has gone 5-1 in its last six against the Cubs (since '21) and 7-3 in its last 10 (since '20).

◆ Twins have now won three-straight games against the Cubs, their longest streak since taking five-straight from them June 23, 2006-June 13, 2009.

◆ Minnesota has now won five-straight games at Wrigley Field, its last loss here coming on September 18, 2020.

◆ Max Kepler is hitting .389 (14-for-36) with three doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, a .722 slugging percentage and a 1.128 OPS in 11 career games vs. the Cubs.

◆ Twins will host the Cubs for three games in 2025 from July 8-10 (Tuesday-Thursday).

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 14-15 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL and 1-0 vs. Chicago.

◆ Byron Buxton is hitting .316 (30-for-95) with three doubles, eight home runs, 17 RBI, a .600 slugging percentage and a .971 OPS in 26 games against the NL this season...his batting average ranks 11th and his OPS ranks 12th among all MLB players (min. 100 PA).

MIRANDA WATCH!: Jose Miranda is hitting an MLB-best .395 (45-for-114) since June 9 among players with at least 100 plate appearances...since that date, he also has 14 doubles, three home runs, 24 RBI, a .445 on-base percentage, a .596 slugging percentage and a 1.042 OPS over the 33-game stretch.

ICE CREAM IN HIS VEINS: Royce Lewis came off the IL hitting just .200 (3-for-15) with two extra-base hits, two walks, a .294 on-base percentage and a .761 OPS in his first five games, but has since hit .294 (5-for-17) with two doubles, two home runs, nine RBI, five walks, a .435 on-base percentage, a .765 slugging percentage and a 1.199 OPS in his last five games.

SERIES DISCUSSIONS: The Twins enter today 23-12-2 in series play this season, going 12-6-0 at home and 11-6-2 on the road...after starting their season 1-4-2 in their first seven series, the Twins have gone 21-8-0 since April 22.

◆ Twins have gone 4-5-1 in series play vs. NL opponents, their four wins coming against Washington (May 20-22), Colorado (June 10-12), Arizona (June 25-27) and Philadelphia (July 22-24).

◆ Twins are 7-7-0 all-time in series play against the Cubs, including a record of 3-4-0 at Wrigley Field...their last series win over the Cubs was May 12-14, 2023, taking two of three at Target Field...their last series win at Wrigley was September 21-22, 2021, sweeping in two.
