THE TWINS: Are returning home after a short three-game roadtrip in Chicago at Wrigley Field as Minnesota went 1-2, winning just game one on Monday night...today, the Twins will begin a seven-game homestand with four against the Guardians this weekend...they will play a doubleheader today with Game 1 being a rain-postponed game from April 7...after this series, the Twins will host the Royals for three games from Monday-Wednesday.

Despite losing the last two games, the Twins have gone 5-2 in their last seven games and 8-5 in their last 13 games.

Twins are 32-21 at home this season, winning each of their last four...since June 12, they have gone 15-7 at Target Field — tied for third-most home wins in baseball since that date.

Twins have gone 56-37 in their last 93 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date.

THE CONFINES...NOT SUPER FRIENDLY: The Twins lost to the Cubs on Wednesday afternoon by a score of 8-2, dropping the three-game series 1-2...Joe Ryan was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on one hit in 2.0 innings pitched...Ryan left the game in the third inning after experiencing right triceps tightness...Trevor Richards (2-2) was issued the loss, allowing three runs on one hit and five walks in 0.2 innings of relief...the offense recorded six hits, two going for extra-bases — doubles by Matt Wallner (9) and Jose Miranda (24).

GREAT SCOTT: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Scott Blewett from Triple-A St. Paul and returned infielder Kyle Farmer from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day Injured List...Blewett, who signed with the Twins as a minor league free agent in January, has gone 5-2, 3.66 ERA (51.2 IP, 21 ER), 17 walks, 52 strikeouts and a 1.37 WHIP in 36 games (3 starts) for the Saints this season...Farmer has missed the Twins' last 18 games with a right shoulder strain. He played in three games on rehab assignment with the Saints, going 3-for-11 with two doubles, one RBI and one walk.

To make room for Blewett on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed right-handed pitcher Joe Ryan on the 15-day Injured List with a right shoulder strain...Ryan was removed from his start on Wednesday in the bottom of the third inning with the injury.

To make room on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Brock Stewart (right shoulder strain) to the 60-day Injured List.

To make room for Farmer on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed infielder Brooks Lee on the 10-day Injured List with right bicep tendinitis (retroactive to August 8).

GUARD PLAY: The Twins are playing the Guardians for the sixth of 13 times in 2024...the Twins have gone 0-5 against Cleveland this season, going 0-2 at Target Field from April 4-6 and 0-3 at Progressive Field from May 17-19.

The Twins have lost six straight to Cleveland, dating back to September 6, 2023, their longest streak since dropping eight straight to the Guardians from June 29-September 17, 2022...their last win came on September 5, 2023 at Cleveland, an 8-3 victory.

Over the six-game losing streak the Twins have scored just 12 runs, scoring one run twice, two runs three times and four runs once.

Royce Lewis has five homers and 17 RBI in 13 career games vs. CLE...no games played in 2024.

STARTER STRENGTH: In 17 games since the All-Star break, the Twins' starting staff has combined to go 7-4, 3.26 ERA (91.0 IP, 33 ER) with 10 home runs allowed, 26 walks and 96 strikeouts, holding opponents to a .194 batting average.

Since allowing eight runs on nine hits in 1.1 innings pitched in his first start on March 31 at Kansas City, Bailey Ober has gone 11-4, 3.13 ERA (120.2 IP, 42 ER) with 28 walks, 127 strikeouts, a 0.91 WHIP and a .191 opponent batting average in 20 starts since April 8...chart to lower right are his AL rankings since that date (minimum of 110.0 innings pitched).

Louie Varland has gone 2-2, 1.48 ERA (30.1 IP, 5 ER) with three home runs allowed, 14 walks, 35 strikeouts and a .193 opponent average in his last six starts at Triple-A (since June 29).

NOTE: The Twins last doubleheader vs. Cleveland came September 17, 2022 at Progressive Field as the Guardians swept...game two was a walk-off 15-inning 6-7 defeat.

FOREST LAKE, STAND UP!!! Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on July 7, Matt Wallner has hit .357 (20-for-56) with eight doubles, five home runs, 11 RBI, a .471 on-base percentage, an .804 slugging percentage and a 1.274 OPS in 19 games.

He has reached safely in nine consecutive starts...his only 0-fer coming on July 29 at New York-NL, when he entered late off the bench and pitched.

Additionally, since that July 7 date, he ranks third in baseball in average exit velocity (minimum of 300 pitches seen) at 98.6 mph and barrels-per-plate appearance percentage (31.0%), fifth in slugging percentage (.804), and sixth in bat speed (77.3 mph)...he also ranks second in average distance of hits (272 ft).

ROYCE OF SUMMER: Royce Lewis came off the IL hitting just .200 (3-for-15) with two extra-base hits, two walks, a .294 on-base percentage and a .761 OPS in his first five games, but has since hit .286 (6-for-21) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, five walks, a .407 on-base percentage, an .810 slugging percentage and a 1.217 OPS in his last six games.

Royce's 8.93 at-bat-per-home run ratio leads baseball (minimum of 100 PA), ahead of Aaron Judge (9.88)...his slugging percentage (.680) ranks second on that same list, trailing Judge (.691).

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on August 3 vs. Chicago-AL...earned the win, allowing two runs on two hits (1 HR) in 7.0 innings, with two walks and seven strikeouts...allowed zero baserunners through 2.2 innings and zero hits through 4.2 innings; Corey Lee's RBI triple tied the game 1-1 in the fifth... has thrown 7.0-or-more innings in three-straight starts for the first time in his career...tied a career high (set in 2023) with his 12th quality start of the season.

- ☞ Recorded his 12th quality start of the season, second behind Joe Ryan with (13) for most on the Twins.
- ☞ Recorded his team-leading 11th win of the season.
- ☞ Has recorded a quality start in each of his last eight starts, now the longest such streak of his career...had seven-straight quality starts from June 14-July 23, 2023.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on July 28 at Detroit...earned his 10th win of the season, tossing 8.0 scoreless innings with one hit, two walks and 11 strikeouts – 11 strikeouts set a new career high... did not allow a base runner until a fourth-inning leadoff single to Matt Vierling – the only base hit he allowed in the outing...marked his first career start allowing no runs while pitching 8.0-or-more innings.

LAST EIGHT STARTS: In his last eight starts, Ober has gone 6-1, 1.95 ERA (55.1 IP, 12 ER), 11 walks, 63 strikeouts, a 0.74 WHIP and a .158 (30-for-190) opponent batting average...in four July starts, he went 3-1, 2.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 6 ER), four walks, 29 strikeouts, a 0.74 WHIP and a .168 (16-for-95) opponent batting average.

- ☞ All eight starts have been quality starts, setting a new career-best streak.

VS. CLEVELAND: Making his second start this season and seventh of his career vs. Cleveland.

- ☞ Started in Cleveland on May 18, allowing five runs on eight hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 4.0 innings; Twins lost, 11-4.
- ☞ In six career matchups, he is 1-2, 2.53 ERA (32.0 IP, 9 ER), three walks, 25 strikeouts, a 0.94 WHIP and a .233 (27-for-116) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Making his third career start at Target Field vs. Cleveland...in previous two, he is 0-1, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 9 ER), no walks, six strikeouts, a 0.75 WHIP and a .209 (9-for-43) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Owns a career 2.53 ERA vs. Cleveland, his lowest against any AL Central opponent.

BACK AT HOME: Making his 10th home start of the season today...in previous nine, he's gone 6-1 with a 3.10 ERA (52.1 IP, 18 ER), 12 walks, 56 strikeouts, a 0.99 WHIP and a .208 (40-for-192) opponent batting average...in 12 road starts, he is 5-4, 4.13 ERA (69.2 IP, 32 ER), 17 walks, 72 strikeouts, a 0.98 WHIP and a .204 (51-for-250) opponent batting average.

- ☞ Has gone 13-5 with a 3.45 ERA (200.2 IP, 75 ER) in 38 career home starts compared to 11-12 with a 3.83 ERA (214.0 IP, 91 ER) in 40 career road starts.
- ☞ The Twins are 6-3 in Ober's nine home starts this season.
- ☞ Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is second on the Twins in home wins with 13, trailing only Joe Ryan (18).

REVERSE SPLITS: On August 2, Chicago-AL left-handed hitters went 1-for-11 with a home run and four strikeouts against Ober, while righties went 1-for-12 with two walks, a triple and three strikeouts.

- ☞ Lefties have a 27.4 percent whiff rate and 86.8 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 30.3 percent whiff rate and 88.5 mph average exit velocity.
- ☞ Through 21 games vs. Ober this season, lefties have hit .191 (37-for-194) with a .612 OPS and 25.0 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .218 (54-for-248) with a .685 OPS and 28.1 percent strikeout rate.
- ☞ Over his career, lefties are batting .235 (168-for-715) with 38 doubles, three triples, 23 home runs and a .681 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .226 (188-for-833) with 33 doubles, seven triples, 41 home runs and a .695 OPS.
- ☞ On May 18 vs. Ober, Cleveland left-handed hitters are hitting went 5-for-14 with one double, one home run and three strikeouts...right-handed hitters went 3-for-4, with one double, one walk and one strikeout.

THE ARSENAL: Has used a five-pitch mix thus far in 2024, per Baseball Savant...uses 4-seam fastball and cutter against both left- and right-handed hitters...predominantly throws changeup and curveball to lefties, slider to righties. Here's his pitch usage through 21 starts:
