THE TWINS: Have gone 2-6 through eight games on their nine-game, 10-day homestand, going 1-2 vs. St. Louis, 0-3 vs. Atlanta and 1-1 vs. Toronto...this afternoon, the Twins will complete the homestand with the three-game series finale against the Blue Jays...after today's game, the Twins will travel to St. Petersburg to begin a seven-game roadtrip with four games against the Rays (Monday-Thursday) and three games against the Royals (Friday-Sunday).

BLACK AND BLUE JAYS: The Twins lost to the Blue Jays last night at Target Field by a score of 15-0, their largest margin of defeat since an 18-3 loss on September 11, 2013 vs. Oakland...marked their eighth time being shut out this season and fourth time at home...Zebby Matthews (1-2) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing nine runs on 10 hits in 2.0 innings pitched...Twins pitchers combined to allow a season-high 23 hits, their most since allowing a club-record 27 on July 25, 2011 against Texas...the offense recorded just four hits, their only extra-base hit being a Royce Lewis double.

FALL BALL: The Twins finished August last night with a record of 14-14, marking their first non-winning month of 2024...below are the monthly hitting (top) and pitching (bottom) comparisons this season:

SEPTEMBER ADDS: The Twins have returned infielder Brooks Lee from his rehab assignment and reinstated him from the 10-day IL... additionally, the Twins have selected the contracts of right-handed pitcher Diego Castillo and utility player Michael Helman from Triple-A St. Paul. Lee, who missed the Twins' last 22 games with right bicep tendinitis, appeared in five games on rehab assignment with the Saints, hitting .211 (4-for-19) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI, one walk and two runs scored...prior to going on the IL, he hit .253 (25-for-99) with two doubles, two home runs, 15 RBI, nine walks, eight runs scored and a .642 OPS in 26 games for the Twins between July 3-August 7. Castillo will be making his second stint with Minnesota this season, after posting a 2.57 ERA (7.0 IP, 2 ER) with seven walks and three strikeouts in five games between May 29-June 10...he has also gone 0-4, 4.73 ERA (32.1 IP, 17 ER), 21 walks, 38 strikeouts and eight saves in 35 games for St. Paul this season. Helman, 28, has hit .283 (68-for-240) with 15 doubles, 13 home runs, 43 RBI, 27 walks, 45 runs scored, 10 stolen bases and an .875 OPS in 63 games for the Saints this season...he made at least one start at five different defensive positions with St. Paul including one start at second base, 10 starts at third base, 28 starts at shortstop, four starts in leftfield and 17 starts in centerfield...the Lincoln, NE native was originally selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas A&M University and has hit .261 (452-for-1730) with 89 doubles, 12 triples, 66 home runs, 247 RBI, 176 walks, 92 stolen bases, 302 runs scored and a .776 OPS in 468 career minor league games. To make room on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed outfielder Manny Margot on the 10-day Injured List with a right groin strain...Margot sustained the injury last night. To make room for Castillo and Helman on the 40-man roster, the Twins have transferred right-handed pitcher Chris Paddock (right forearm strain) to the 60-day Injured List and designated right-handed pitcher Caleb Boushley for release or assignment.

TWINS AND JAYS: The Twins and Blue Jays are playing each other for the sixth and final time in 2024...Minnesota is 3-2 against the Jays this season, going 2-1 at Rogers Centre and 1-1 at Target Field...a win today and the Twins will take the season series against Toronto for the first time since 2022 (4-3) after going 3-3 in 2023.

Including the 2023 Postseason, the Twins have gone 7-3 in their last 10 games against the Blue Jays, dating back to June of 2023. Québec City native Edouard Julien is 11-for-30 (.367) with four doubles, one home run, seven walks, a .486 on-base percentage, a .600 slugging percentage and a 1.086 OPS in 10 career regular season games against Toronto. These two teams will meet in 2025 for three games at Target Field from June 6-8 and three games at Rogers Centre from August 25-27.

SERIES CONVERSATIONS: A win today and the Twins will secure their 25th series win of the season...they enter today 24-16-3 in series play this season, going 12-8-1 at home and 12-8-2 on the road...the Twins haven't won a series since taking three of four at Globe Life Field against the Rangers from August 15-18...since that series, they have gone 1-2 at San Diego, 1-2 vs. St. Louis and 0-3 vs. Atlanta. Minnesota is seeking their third-consecutive regular season series win over the Blue Jays, taking two of three at Rogers Centre from June 9-11, 2023 and two of three from May 10-12, 2024. Twins are 12-5 in rubber games this season, including a record of 8-3 in their last 11 chances.

ED TALKS: Since being recalled from Triple-A St. Paul on August 15, Edouard Julien is hitting .303 (10-for-33) with two doubles, five walks, a .395 on-base percentage and a .758 OPS in 13 games...additionally, he has struck out just three times in his last six games (18 plate appearances).

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Walker Jenkins and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Louie Varland have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week. Jenkins, 19, played in six games for theernels, hitting .375 (9-for-24) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, five RBI, two walks, a .423 on-base percentage, an .833 slugging percentage and a 1.256 OPS...the Wilmington, NC native was selected by the Twins fifth overall in the 2023 First-Year Player Draft out of South Brunswick High School in Southport, NC...he is ranked as Minnesota's top prospect (MLB.com) and the third-best prospect in all of baseball, behind Tampa Bay's Junior Camerero and Washington's Dylan Crews. Varland made one appearance in relief on Wednesday at Omaha, pitching innings 3-7, tossing 5.0 scoreless, with one hit allowed, two walks and nine strikeouts...it marked Varland's first appearance out of the bullpen this season for the Saints...Varland was a starter most of last season until making his first appearance in relief for St. Paul on August 31...he was promoted to Minnesota for September and made seven relief appearances (6 scoreless) for the Twins down the stretch, including two games in the AL Wild Card Series.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on August 26 vs. Braves...took the loss, allowing a career-high nine runs on seven hits (2 HR) in 2.0 innings...

Snapped a career-best streak of 11-straight quality starts since gaJune 16 (1); was tied for the fourth-longest streak in Twins history (1961-present) and was the longest in baseball since Shane Bieber (11 G, 7/29-9/22/22).

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on August 20 at San Diego...did not factor into the decision despite tossing a career-best 11th consecutive quality start...

Recorded his 15th quality start of the season, tops on the Twins.

VS. TORONTO: Making his fifth career start and second of the season vs. Toronto Blue Jays.

- Making his fifth start of his career vs. Toronto; in his previous four he is 2-2, 3.05 ERA (20.2 IP, 7 ER), three walks, 26 strikeouts, an 0.82 WHIP and a .189 (14-for-74) opponent batting average.
Has made one start this season at Toronto on May 12, tossing 6.1 scoreless innings on one hit, no walks and 10 strikeouts; earned the win in a 5-1 Twins victory.
Making third career start vs. Toronto at Target Field...in his previous two starts he is 1-1, 2.61 ERA (10.1 IP, 3 ER), one walk, 13 strikeouts, a 0.97 WHIP and a .237 (9-for-38) opponent batting average.

BACK AT HOME: Making his 12th home start of the season today...in the previous 11, he's gone 7-2 with a 4.03 ERA (60.1 IP, 27 ER), 16 walks, 67 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP and a .217 (49-for-226) opponent batting average...

- Has gone 14-6 with a 3.71 ERA (208.2 IP, 86 ER) in 40 career home starts compared to 11-12 with a 3.82 ERA (226.2 IP, 96 ER) in 42 career home starts.
The Twins are 7-4 in Ober's 11 home starts this season.
Since making his debut in 2021, Ober is second on the Twins in home wins with 14, trailing only Joe Ryan (19).

REVERSE SPLITS: On August 26, Matt Olson the only left-handed hitter in the Braves line up went 2-for-3 with one double and a home run against Ober...right-handed hitters went 5-for-10 with one home run and two strikeouts.

- Lefties have a 26.9 percent whiff rate and 86.5 mph average exit velocity vs. Ober, while righties a 29.8 percent whiff rate and 89.1 mph average exit velocity.
Through 25 games vs. Ober this season, lefties have hit .158 (45-for-243) with a .592 OPS and 25.7 percent strikeout rate, while righties have hit .237 (66-for-279) with a .729 OPS and 26.2 percent strikeout rate.
Over his career, lefties are batting .230 (176-for-764) with 41 doubles, three triples, 24 home runs and a .670 OPS...right-handed hitters are batting .231 (200-for-864) with 35 doubles, seven triples, 43 home runs and a .709 OPS.

- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
Set career highs in innings pitched (7.1) and strikeouts (10) in 4-0 win over Chicago-AL on September 27, 2022.
Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
In 2020, spent spring training on minor league side of Lee County Sports Complex in Fort Myers, FL...was not part of Twins' 60-man Player Pool for season.
Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Knights, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
Attended College of Charleston from 2014-17, missing the 2015 season recovering from Tommy John surgery on right elbow...compiled a 24-9 record with a 2.91 ERA and 254 strikeouts in 259.2 innings over the course of his collegiate career.
