THE TWINS: After completing their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5 (2-2 at Tampa Bay and 0-3 at Kansas City), the Twins began their six-game, seven-day homestand with a split of the first two games against the Angels this week...tonight, they will play the three-game series finale against Anaheim...the Twins will enjoy an off-day tomorrow, then host the Reds for three games over the weekend.

◆ Twins are on their final game of 13 games in 13 days...after tomorrow's off-day, they will finish with 16 games in 17 days.

◆ Despite going 4-8 in their last 12 at home, the Twins have gone 40-31 at Target Field.

★ The Twins began the season by going 7-13 in their first 21 games through April 21...from April 22-August 17, they went 63-40 — the most wins in baseball during that span...since August 18, they have gone 7-15 and have been outscored 112-80 (-32).

★ Twins are 13-5 in rubber games, including a record of 9-3 in their last 12 chances.

"THERE'S NO DOUBT WE ARE CARRYING AROUND SOMETHING THAT IS VERY UNHEALTHY TO THE HUMAN BODY": The Twins beat the Angels last night at Target Field by a score of 10-5... Pablo López (15-8) was the starter and winner, allowing four unearned runs on eight hits in 7.0 innings pitched, including one walk and 10 strikeouts...the offense recorded 10 hits and struck out just five times...the 10 runs scored were their most since scoring 11 on August 21 at San Diego...additionally, they entered the night having scored just four runs in their previous four games combined...Minnesota got home runs from Matt Wallner (12), Carlos Santana (21) and Kyle Farmer (5).

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have reinstated catcher Christian Vázquez from the Paternity List and outfielder Manny Margot from the 10-day Injured List.

♣ Vázquez missed the Twins' last two games as he and his wife welcomed their third child last Monday night...he has played in 84 games for the Twins this season, hitting .228 (60-for-263) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 27 RBI and 26 runs scored.

♣ Margot, who missed the club's last 10 games with a right groin strain, has hit .250 (70-for-280) with 14 doubles, one triple, four home runs, 30 RBI, 19 walks, five stolen bases and a .652 OPS in 116 games for Minnesota this season.

♣ To make room for Vázquez and Margot on the 28-man roster, the Twins have optioned catcher Jair Camargo and utility player Michael Helman to Triple-A St. Paul...Camargo, who was recalled on Monday, did not appear in a game during his most recent stint...Helman appeared in seven games, hitting .375 (3-for-8) with two doubles and two runs scored.

TWINS AND HALOS: The Twins and Angels are playing for the sixth and final time this season...

Minnesota has gone 4-1 vs. Anaheim this season, going 3-0 at Angel Stadium from April 26-28 and 1-1 at Target Field this week.

The Last night's win secured the season series over the Angels for the first time since 2019 (5-1).

Willi Castro has hit safely in his last 16 games vs. the Angels (with an at-bat) since August 17, 2021, batting .348 (23-for-66) with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI, 12 runs scored and a .992 OPS in that span...it's Castro's longest of his career against any opponent and ties Chuck Knoblauch (June 7, 1994-May 3, 1996) for the longest in Twins history against the Angels.

Carlos Santana is hitting .320 (16-for-50) with four doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBI and a 1.178 OPS in his last 12 games against the Angels...he has recorded at least one RBI in seven consecutive games against Anaheim.

The Twins will play the Angels six times in 2025 including a three-game series at Target Field from April 25-27 and three games at Angel Stadium from September 8-10.

WINNING THE WEST: Twins have gone 24-8 against AL West opponents this season, going 5-2 vs. Texas, 4-1 vs. Los Angeles, 5-2 vs. Seattle, 4-2 vs. Houston and 6-1 vs. Oakland... their .750 winning percentage against the AL West would be their highest since the current divisional format began in 1994; 2019 is currently second best at .676 (23-11).

■ 24 wins against the AL West this season are tied for their second most in the divisional era...27-22 in 1996 and 24-12 in 2010... tonight marks the final games against the AL West this season.

SERIES DISCUSSIONS: Twins enter today 25-17-4 in series play this season, going 13-8-1 at home and 12-9-3 on the road...their last series win at home came in their last series here, taking two of three from Toronto from August 30-September 1.

◆ Minnesota began the season by going 24-13-3 in their first 40 series' through August 18, but have gone 1-4-1 in series play since their San Diego series from August 19-21.

◆ A win tonight would give the Twins their third consecutive series victory over the Angels, dating back to September of 2023.

**THE GREAT WALL OF FOREST LAKE:** Matt Wallner has homered twice in his last six games and five times in his last 19 games...since re-joining the Twins from St. Paul on July 7, Wallner is hitting .290 (45-for-155) with 15 doubles, 11 home runs, 29 RBI, a .613 slugging percentage and a 1.012 OPS...since that date, he ranks third in baseball in hard hit percentage (58.1%), eighth in slugging and average exit velocity (94.8 mph), and ninth in OPS (min. 175 plate appearances).
