CALLING ALL ANGELS: The Twins beat the Angels on Wednesday night by a score of 6-4, winning their 26th series of the season...Zebby Matthews was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 3.1 innings pitched, with two walks and five strikeouts...Griffin Jax pitched 2.0 scoreless innings of relief to hold a 6-3 lead, then Jhoan Duran allowed a run but earned his 23rd save of the season...the offense recorded 11 hits, five going for extra-bases, including a Matt Wallner home run, his 13th of the season... Christian Vázquez added two hits, one being a double, the 150th of his career.

AND WE WERE SWINGIN': In their final two games against the Angels, the Twins went 21-for-66 (.318) with five doubles, four home runs and a .962 OPS, while scoring 8.0 runs-per-game... additionally, they hit .273 (6-for-22) with runners in scoring position (league avg .253).

SEEING RED AGAIN: Minnesota and Cincinnati are playing each other for the 35th, 36th and 37th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 17-17 all-time against the Reds, going 7-10 in Cincinnati (6-5 at Great American Ball Park and 1-5 at Cinergy Field) and 10-7 in Minnesota (3-5 at Target Field and 7-2 at the Metrodome).

◆ These two teams last met for three games at Great American Ball Park from September 18-20, 2023, as the Twins took the final two games.

◆ The Twins last hosted the Reds at Target Field for two games from June 21-22, 2021 as the Twins split.

Kyle Farmer played parts of four seasons with the Reds from 2019-22, playing in 421 games...Farmer was acquired by the Twins in a trade on November 18, 2022, in exchange for right-handed pitcher Casey Legumina.

NATIONAL NEWS: The Twins are 16-24 in Interleague Play this season, going 1-3 against Milwaukee, 1-2 vs. Los Angeles, 2-1 at Washington, 1-2 at Pittsburgh, 2-1 vs. Colorado, 2-1 at Arizona, 1-2 at San Francisco, 2-1 vs. Philadelphia, 1-2 at New York-NL, 1-2 at Chicago, 1-2 at San Diego, 1-2 vs. St. Louis and 0-3 vs. Atlanta...Twins are just 6-15 against NL opponents since July 14.

◆ By comparison, the Twins have gone 62-44 against American League opponents.

◆ Minnesota has one more series against an NL opponent after this series, three against the Marlins at home from September 24-26.

◆ Byron Buxton is hitting .316 (30-for-95) with three doubles, eight home runs, 17 RBI, a .600 slugging percentage and a .971 OPS in 26 games against the NL this season...he ranks 10th in baseball in OPS in IL Play this season and 13th in batting average (min. 100 PA).

RETURN OF THE MACK: The Twins have reinstated centerfielder Byron Buxton from the 10-day Injured List... Buxton, who has missed the Twins' last 28 games with right hip inflammation, has been taking live batting practice at Target Field this week... prior to landing on the IL, the 30-year-old played in 90 games for the Twins this season, hitting .275 (84-for-305) with 23 doubles, three triples, 16 home runs, 49 RBI, 54 runs scored and an .862 OPS; this includes 22 games (75 starts) in centerfield, his most since 2019 (86 games, 76 starts)...to make room on the 28-man roster, the Twins optioned utility player Austin Martin to Triple-A St. Paul after Wednesday night's game against the Angels...Martin played in 89 games over three separate stints for the Twins this season, hitting .252 (55-for-218) with 16 doubles, one triple, one home run, 16 RBI, 41 runs scored and seven stolen bases.

BUCK SZN: In his last 43 games leading up to the IL stint, Byron Buxton hit .331 (49-for-148) with a .394 on-base percentage, a .709 slugging percentage and a 1.103 OPS...since that date, he leads baseball (min. 150 PA) in slugging, ranks second in OPS, fifth in batting average, and 11th in on-base percentage.

THE GREAT WALL: Matt Wallner has homered twice in his last two games, three times in his last seven games and six times in his last 20 games...since re-joining the Twins from St. Paul on July 7, Wallner is hitting .289 (46-for-159) with 15 doubles, 12 home runs, 30 RBI, a .623 slugging percentage and a 1.018 OPS...since that date, he ranks sixth in baseball in hard hit percentage (57.3%), seventh in OPS, ninth in average exit velocity (94.6 mph) and 10th in slugging.

TRAINING DAY: Professional Baseball Athletic Trainers Society (PBATS) recently announced the winners of the Minor League Athletic Trainers of the Year Awards for the 2024 baseball season...the PBATS Minor League Baseball awards are given annually to one member of each of the 14 leagues in Minor League Baseball...two additional awards are given to the Minor League Coordinator and Latin American Coordinator of the Year as Twins minor league medical coordinator Bryan Housand is the 2024 winner of the award.

TARGET FIELD'S FAMOUS FRIENDS: Country singer Chris Young will perform a postgame concert tonight...Young, a member of the Grand Ole Opry and a GRAMMY-nominated, Multi-Platinum artist who has notched 13 career Number Ones and more than two dozen R.I.A.A. certified projects, will take the on-field stage approximately 15 minutes after the game concludes and will play a 75-minute set.
