THE TWINS: Completed their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a record of 3-6, going 1-2 vs. St. Louis, 0-3 vs. Atlanta and 2-1 vs. Toronto...tonight, the Twins will begin a seven-game roadtrip with the first of four against the Rays at Tropicana Field through Thursday...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Kansas City for three games against the Royals over the weekend. Despite going 4-9 in their last 13 games, the Twins are 67-49 in their last 116 games since April 22, tied with Philadelphia (67-48) for third-most wins in baseball since that date, trailing Los Angeles-NL (69-44) and Houston (68-46).
 The Twins have posted a .522 winning percentage (35-32) on the road, the 10th best road win percentage in baseball and best among AL Central teams.

COME ON BARBIE, LET'S GO PARTY: The Twins celebrated Barbie Game Day with a 4-3 victory over the Blue Jays at Target Field yesterday afternoon...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run (Clement HR) on one hit in 6.0 innings pitched, with three walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, two from Jose Miranda...Royce Lewis hit the go-ahead three-run jimmy jack in the bottom of the eighth with the Twins down 3-1...Jhoan Duran earned the save, his 20th of the season (22nd chance).

I WANT TO SPEAK TO YOUR MANAGER: Rocco Baldelli is one win away from 450 career managerial victories, entering today with 449...below are the Twins' all-time managerial wins leaders (left) and Baldelli's milestone victories (right):

FLORIDA MEN: The Twins and Rays are playing the fourth of seven games in 2024...these two last met for a three-game series at Target Field from June 18-20 as the Twins won the first game and lost games two and three...in game one, Twins walked-off Pete Fairbanks in the bottom of the ninth inning with the score tied at 6-6, Carlos Santana drove in Manny Margot with a pinch-hit RBI-single.

The Twins' last trip to Tropicana Field came June 6-8, 2023, getting swept in three games...their last win in this ballpark came on May 1, 2022.

In his last 17 games against the Rays, Carlos Santana is hitting .328 (20-for-61) with seven doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, a .373 on-base percentage, a .738 slugging percentage and a 1.111 OPS.

Christian Vázquez has 37 hits in this ballpark, his second most in any opposing park (40 at Camden Yards).

Twins have homered 13 times in their last seven games against the Rays.

Rays starter Zack Littell made his debut with the Twins in 2018 and pitched parts of three seasons with Minnesota, from 2018-20, going 6-2, 4.52 ERA (63.2 IP, 32 ER) with 23 walks and 49 strikeouts in 43 games...Littell was acquired by the Twins via trade with the Yankees at the 2017 trade deadline along with Dietrich Enns, in exchange for Jaime García...Zack left the Twins via free agency after the 2020 season.

HITTIN' JOSE: Jose Miranda began the last homestand 0-for-10 over the first four games, but finished with five hits in 10 at-bats in the final five games...in 55 games since June 12, he is hitting .330 (60-for-182) with 17 doubles and an .870 OPS...since that date, he ranks sixth in the AL (min. 150 PA) in batting average, 10th in on-base and 16th in OPS.

CHRISTIAN MINGLE: Christian Vázquez is hitting .302 (16-for-53) with a .793 OPS in 16 games since August 1 and .309 (29-for-94) with four doubles, five home runs, 16 RBI, a .511 slugging percentage and an .844 OPS since July 1...among all AL players with a minimum of 90 plate appearances since July 1, he ranks 13th in batting average.

Vasky needs one double to reach 150 for his career.

GET ROYCE ROLLIN': Royce Lewis hit his 16th home run of the season yesterday afternoon, passing his previous single-season career-high of 15, done last season...it was his first home run since August 12...after homering 10 times in his first 16 games of the season, he has six in his last 41 games.

His 12.56 at-bat-per-home run ratio ranks fifth in baseball among players with a minimum of 200 plate appearances, trailing Aaron Judge (9.41), Kyle Tucker (11.26), Shohei Ohtani (12.11) and Kyle Higashioka (12.50).

DOING MAJOR WORK ON LABOR DAY: The Twins are 44-26 on Labor Day since 1961, including a 21-13 record at home and 23-13 record on the road...the Twins have won four of their last five Labor Day games and are 7-4 in their last 11...last season, they beat the Guardians at Progressive Field by a score of 20-6.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched August 27 vs. Atlanta, opposite Spencer Schwellenbach, and didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 10-inning, 8-6 loss...allowed four runs on three hits (1 HR) in 4.2 innings, with three walks and three strikeouts...allowed second-inning two-run home run to Michael Harris...exited with bases loaded and two outs in the fifth; Jorge Alcalá entered and allowed two inherited runners to score.

- ☞ Induced nine whiffs on 41 swings (22.0%)...ranks in MLB's 27th percentile with a 22.3 percent whiff rate this season.
- ☞ Six of 14 balls in play were hard-hit (95.0+ mph)...ranks in MLB's 66th percentile with a 36.6 percent hard-hit rate.
- ☞ Minnesota is 15-8 in his starts this season.
- ☞ In 16 of 23 starts, has thrown 4.0-or-more innings and allowed four-or-fewer hits; only Freddy Peralta and Bailey Ober (17) have made more such starts this season.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started August 21 at San Diego, opposite Matt Waldron, and earned the win in Minnesota's 11-4 victory...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR) in 5.0 innings, with two walks and seven strikeouts...stranded the bases loaded in a 29-pitch first inning...retired eight-straight batters from innings 2-4...only run came on Donovan Solano's fifth-inning home run.

- ☞ Induced 13 whiffs on 49 swings (26.5%) and allowed only three hard-hit balls.

RAYS REMATCH: Only career appearance vs. Tampa Bay came June 20 at Target Field; didn't factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 loss...allowed two runs on four hits in 6.0 innings, with two walks and six strikeouts...allowed three extra-base hits: doubles by Yandy Díaz, Josh Lowe and Alex Jackson.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making 13th road start of 2024...has gone 4-2 with a 4.06 ERA (57.2 IP, 26 ER), 7.02 K/9, 2.65 BB/9 and 1.25 HR/9 on the road, compared to 1-1 with a 3.64 ERA (59.1 IP, 24 ER), 8.65 K/9, 3.19 BB/9 and 0.91 HR/9 in 11 home starts...has allowed a .260 (58-for-223) batting average and .730 OPS on the road, compared to .195 (42-for-215) BAA and .580 OPS at home.

REVERSE SPLITS: Through 23 games vs. Woods Richardson, left-handed hitters have hit .213 (39-for-183) with a .311 slugging percentage, .598 OPS, 20.4 percent strikeout rate and 8.3 percent walk rate, while righties have hit .239 (61-for-255) with a .404 SLG, .698 OPS, 21.4 percent strikeout rate and 7.5 percent walk rate.

- ☞ Hard-hit rate vs. Woods Richardson: 33.6 percent by lefties, 39.4 percent by righties.
- ☞ Whiff rate: 19.4 percent vs. lefties, 24.4 percent vs. righties.
- ☞ Among right-handed pitchers, Woods Richardson has allowed the sixth-lowest SLG (.311) and seventh-lowest OPS (.598) to left-handed hitters (min. 200 LHB faced).

- ☞ Ranks in MLB's 91st percentile with a breaking ball run value of seven.
- ☞ Over his last six starts since July 23, batters have gone 1-for-13 with three strikeouts vs. his curveball.
- ☞ Slider ranks eighth in baseball (min. 150 PA) in opponent batting average (.191), eighth in SLG (.299), fifth in wOBA (.244) and third in hard-hit rate (25.4%).

WALK RATE RISING: Has issued multiple walks in five of his last six outings...has a 9.5 percent walk rate and 3.60 BB/9 in seven starts since the All-Star break, compared to 7.1 percent and 2.63 BB/9 before the break...for the season, ranks in MLB's 53rd percentile with a 7.8 percent walk rate.

- ☞ Has a 5.23 ERA (62.0 IP, 36 ER) in 13 starts with two-or-more walks, compared to 2.29 ERA (55.0 IP, 14 ER) in 10 starts with one-or-fewer.
