THE TWINS: After completing their nine-game, 10-day homestand with a record of 3-6 (1-2 vs. St. Louis, 0-3 vs. Atlanta and 2-1 vs. Toronto), the Twins began their seven-game roadtrip with a win over the Rays last night...tonight, the Twins will play the second of four at Tropicana Field and finish the series on Thursday afternoon...after this series, Minnesota will travel to Kansas City for three games against the Royals over the weekend.

♣ Twins have posted a .529 winning percentage (36-32) on the road, the ninth best road win percentage in baseball and best among AL Central teams.

♣ Minnesota is seeking its third-straight win today, which would be its longest since taking the first three games of its last roadtrip at Globe Life Field, from August 15-17.

♣ Four of the Twins' last eight wins have been decided by one run, dating back to August 15 at Texas.

'PEN HOLDS TAMPA AT BAY: The Twins beat the Rays last night at Tropicana Field by a score of 5-4, their 21st one-run win this season (21-16)...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on six hits in 3.2 innings pitched... Jorge Alcala (1.1), Ronny Henriquez (1.0), Griffin Jax (1.0), Cole Sands (1.0) and Jhoan Duran (1.0) all combined to allow just one run on four hits in 5.1 innings of relief, with no walks... the offense recorded 10 hits and was led by Trevor Larnach, who reached three times, hitting a three-run jimmy jack and walking twice...Brooks Lee added two hits and homered for the third time this season (1st from right side of plate).

♣ Last night marked the club's 35th win in come-from-behind fashion, tied with Kansas City for third-most in baseball, trailing Cleveland (39) and Milwaukee (36).

TAMPA TALK: The Twins and Rays are playing the fifth of seven games in 2024...Twins have gone 2-2 against the Rays this season, going 1-2 at Target Field and 1-0 at the Trop...last night's win was their first at Tropicana Field since May 1, 2022.

■ Twins have homered in eight consecutive games against the Rays, hitting 15 total in that save

♠ Iwins have homered in eight consecutive games against the Rays, hitting 15 total in that span.
♠ Since June 7, 2023, these two teams have played each other nine times...all nine of those games have been decided by three runs-or-fewer...seven have been decided by one run, including six-in-a-row.
♠ In his last 18 games against the Rays, Carlos Santana is hitting .308 (20-for-65) with seven doubles, six home runs, 14 RBI, a .352 on-base percentage, a .692 slugging percentage and a 1.044 OPS.

MIRAND-ANOTHER RUN: Jose Miranda began the last homestand 0-for-10 over the first four games (August 23-26), but has since recorded seven hits in his last 17 at-bats (last 6 games)...in 56 games since June 12, he is hitting .332 (62-for-187) with 17 doubles and an .868 OPS...since that date, he ranks sixth in the AL (min. 150 PA) in batting average and 11th in on-base percentage.

◆ Miranda ranks in the 91st percentile in baseball in strikeout percentage, at 13.9%...more specifically his 13.9 strikeout rate ranks ninth-lowest in the AL and 17th-lowest in baseball (minimum of 350 plate appearances).

◆ He is hitting .343 (12-for-35) against offspeed pitches this season, seventh-best in MLB.

◆ His 26.6 line drive percentage is the highest of his career (24.0 in 2022, 23.7 in 2023).

JEFF AROUND AND FIND OUT: Ryan Jeffers is leading off today for the 10th time this season, first time since May 20 at Washington...he is hitting .257 (9-for-35) in those nine previous games. 
◆In his last 14 games overall, he is hitting .311 (14-for-45) with two doubles, four home runs, seven RBI, a .380 on-base percentage, a .622 slugging percentage and a 1.022 OPS.

GET ROYCE ROLLIN': Royce Lewis has hit safely in each of his last four games, going 5-for-15 (.333) with two doubles, one home run and four RBI.

After driving in one run last night and three runs on Sunday afternoon, Royce Lewis now has 23 RBI since August 1, the fifth-most in the AL since that date, trailing Josh Naylor (26), Aaron Judge (25), Vinnie Pasquantino (25) and Corey Seager (24).

Tonight marks Royce's 59th game of the season, which will mark a single-season career-high.

Royce is hitting .344 (11-for-32) with two doubles, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.322 OPS in nine games against AL East opponents this season.

TO THE LEFT, TO THE LEFT: The Twins are slashing .260/.315/.434 (.749 OPS) against left-handed pitching, compared to .249/.323/.422 (.745 OPS) against right-handers.

♣ Minnesota's .260 average against lefties leads the AL and ranks fifth-best in baseball...its .434 slugging percentage ranks second in the AL and seventh in baseball.

♣ In his last 34 games against lefties, Carlos Santana is slashing .314/.392/.643 (1.035 OPS).

♣ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .444 (8-for-18) with one double, four home runs, a .450 on-base, a 1.167 slugging and a 1.617 OPS in his last 10 games against left-handed pitching.

THE BIG MAYONNAISE: Michael Helman is making his major league debut today...he joins Austin Martin, Brooks Lee, David Festa, Zebby Matthews and Jair Camargo as the sixth Twin to debut this season...the Lincoln, NE native was selected by the Twins in the 11th round of the 2018 First-Year Player Draft out of Texas A&M...defensively for Triple-A St. Paul this season, he played 28 games at short, 17 in center, 10 at third base, four in left and one at second; his last professional game in rightfield was on September 24, 2023 with the Saints...additionally, he has played 28 professional games in right, most of them coming in 2021 with High-A Cedar Rapids.

**BUCK ON REHAB:** Byron Buxton, who has been on the 10-day IL with right hip inflammation since August 15, played in his first rehab game with Triple-A St. Paul yesterday afternoon, going 1-for-3 with a walk and a strikeout...St. Paul has the day off today.

TWINS MILB MONTHLYS: High-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Walker Jenkins and Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Travis Adams have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Month for August.

Flenkins, 19, played in 25 games for the Kernels, hitting .310 (31-for-100) with 10 doubles, two triples, three home runs, 14 RBI, 18 runs scored, nine walks and a .909 OPS.

Adams, who was recently promoted to Triple-A St. Paul, appeared in five games (4 starts) for the Wind Surge, going 1-0, 0.70 ERA (25.2 IP, 2 ER) with a 30.1% strikeout rate and a 7.5% walk rate.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched August 28 vs. Atlanta...took the 5-1 loss, allowing two runs on two hits in a career-high 6.0 innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts...first-inning Jorge Soler home run was the first home run (3rd XBH) he's allowed first time through the order...struck out the side in a 1-2-3 fifth inning...second time through the order. Atlanta went 0-for-9 with five strikeouts: entering the game, Festa had allowed a .393 (24-for-61) average and 1.243 OPS the second time through opposing lineups...was pulled after walking Marcell Ozuna to lead off the seventh; Caleb Thielbar entered and allowed the run to score.

- ◆ Recorded the first quality start of his career.

  ◆ His seven strikeouts matched the second-highest total of his MLB career (high is 9 K).
- ₱88 pitches also set a new MLB career high.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on August 23 vs. St. Louis...took his third loss of the season in his eighth career appearance (7th start)...tossed two scoreless innings before allowing an RBI to Masyn Winn in the third inning...later allowed a two-run double to Willson Contreras; exited after retiring Paul Goldschmidt in the fourth inning and was relieved by Caleb Thielbar...allowed three runs on three hits, two walks and five strikeouts in 3.2 innings – had not allowed more than two runs since July 3 vs. Detroit, his second career start.

₱ Induced nine whiffs on 32 swings (28.1%)

♠ Making his fourth start against American League opponents; he is 0-1, 6.75 ERA (13.1 IP, 10 ER), three walks, 15 strikeouts, a 1.58 WHIP and a .310 (18-for-58) opponent batting average.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making fifth start on the road...is 2-1 with a 4.05 ERA (20.0 IP, 9 ER), four walks, 23 strikeouts and a .644 opponent OPS in four road starts, compared to 0-3 with a 5.64 ERA (22.1 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 28 strikeouts and a .859 OPS in four home starts (5 appearances).
