**THE TWINS:** Began their seven-game roadtrip with a split of the first two games in St. Petersburg, winning on Monday night, followed by a loss last night...tonight, the Twins continue the trip with the third of four at the Trop and finish the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, Minnesota will travel to Kansas City for three games against the Royals over the weekend.

☞ Twins are on game six of a 13-game stretch with no off-days...their next off-day will be a week from tomorrow on September 12.

☞ Twins have gone 77-59 in September under Rocco, since 2019...only Dave Roberts (91-42), Brian Snitker (80-53), Craig Counsell (80-58), Aaron Boone (77-63) and Kevin Cash (77-57) have as many September managerial wins in that span.

**POWER GOES OUT FOR TWINS BATS:** The Twins lost to the Rays last night at Tropicana Field by a score of 2-1, making them 21-17 in one-run games this season...David Festa (2-5) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched...the offense recorded six hits, walked twice, struck out nine times, went 0-for-5 with runners in scoring position and left seven men on base...Minnesota's only run came on a Carlos Santana second inning solo homer (19), one of his three times reaching base last night (also 1B, BB).

**FIFTY SHADES OF RAY:** The Twins and Rays are playing the sixth of seven games in 2024...Twins have gone 2-3 against the Rays this season, going 1-2 at Target Field and 1-1 at the Trop.

☞ Twins have homered in nine consecutive games against the Rays, hitting 16 total in that span...five of those 16 have come at Tropicana Field (3 games).

☞ Since June 7, 2023, these two teams have played each other 10 times...all 10 of those games have been decided by three runs-or-fewer...eight have been decided by one run, including seven in a row.

☞ In his last 19 games against the Rays, Carlos Santana is hitting .324 (22-for-68) with seven doubles, seven home runs, 15 RBI, a .373 on-base percentage, a .735 slugging percentage and a 1.109 OPS...in five games this season, he is 7-for-16 (.438) with a 1.375 OPS vs. TB.

☞ Christian Vázquez has 37 hits in this ballpark (57 career games), his second most in any opposing park (40 at Camden Yards).

**WITH ARMS WIDE OPENER:** Tonight marks Ronny Henriquez's first career start...the Twins used an Opener one other time this season when Steven Okert started the game on July 24 vs. Philadelphia, pitching 0.1 scoreless inning with one hit and one walk...David Festa relieved Okert and allowed one run on four hits in 4.1 innings, walking two and striking out seven...Twins won that game 5-4, using six total pitchers.

**ROSTER MOVE:** The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Louie Varland from Triple-A St. Paul...Varland, who will be making his sixth stint with the Twins this season, has gone 5-8, 4.75 ERA (83.1 IP, 44 ER), 32 walks and 96 strikeouts in 17 games (16 starts) for the Saints this season, including a record of 3-2, 2.01 ERA (40.1 IP, 9 ER) and a .193 BAA in his last eight games (7 starts) for St. Paul, since June 29...in eight games (7 starts) for the Twins this season, Varland has gone 0-5, 6.14 ERA (36.2 IP, 25 ER), 11 walks and 32 strikeouts.

☞ To make room for Varland on the 28-man roster, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher Diego Castillo to St. Paul...Castillo, who had his contract selected by Minnesota on Sunday, made one appearance during his most recent stint, pitching 1.0 scoreless inning with one strikeout last night at Tampa Bay.

**LOUIE V, THE TRUTH:** Louie Varland has appeared in eight career games in relief at the major league level, going 1-0, 2.20 ERA (16.1 IP, 4 ER) with one walk, 21 strikeouts and a .190 opponent average...the Twins recalled Varland on September 4 of last season and put him in the 'pen for the remaining September games, as he made seven appearances, six of which were scoreless...Louie averaged 94.6 mph on his fastball in relief last season, compared to 92.4 mph as a starter...he threw 97.0+ mph 54 times in relief and 98.0+ mph 35 times...he topped out at 100.4 mph, striking out Daniel Vogelbach on September 9.

☞ Varland's only relief appearance for the Saints this season came in his last appearance on August 28 at Omaha, pitching 5.0 shutout innings with one hit allowed, two walks and nine strikeouts.

**HARD 'NACHS:** In his last 11 games, since August 21, Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with three doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, four walks, a .405 on-base percentage, a .697 slugging percentage and a 1.102 OPS...since that date, he has posted a 93.0 mph average exit velocity, 11th-best in the AL...additionally, he ranks 17th in hard hit percentage at 52.6%.

**TREVOLUTION:** Trevor Larnach ranks in the 92nd percentile in baseball in avg exit velo (92.3 mph), the 90th percentile in xSLG (.495), the 87th percentile in xwOBA (.359) and the 80th percentile in xBA (.270)...below are a few of his year-to-year changes in several offensive categories:

**GET ROYCE ROLLIN':** Royce Lewis has hit safely in each of his last five games, going 6-for-19 (.316) with two doubles, one home run and four RBI...his season-high for a hitting streak is eight games, from June 8-16...his career-high for a hitting streak is nine, from September 14, 2023-June 5, 2024.

☞ Lewis has 23 RBI since August 1, the fifth-most in the AL since that date, trailing Josh Naylor (26), Aaron Judge (25), Vinnie Pasquantino (25) and Corey Seager (24).

☞ Royce is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with two doubles, five home runs, eight RBI and a 1.234 OPS in 10 games against AL East opponents this season.

**SOLID 'PENMANSHIP:** Through two games in this series, the Twins bullpen has faced 31 batters, retiring 25 of them...they have allowed one run (DeLuca HR off Sands on Monday) on five hits with no walks, one hit-by-pitch and 13 strikeouts, while posting a .167 opponent batting average and a 14.0 strikeouts-per-9.0 innings pitched ratio.

**BUCK ON REHAB:** Byron Buxton, who has been on the 10-day IL with right hip inflammation since August 15, played in his first rehab game with Triple-A St. Paul Monday afternoon, going 1-for-3 with a walk and a strikeout...St. Paul hosts Iowa tonight with first pitch at 6:37 pm (CT).
