THE TWINS: Have gone 2-2 through four games on their seven-game roadtrip, taking the book-end games of the four-game series in St. Petersburg this week...tonight, the Twins will continue the trip with the first of three against Kansas City through the weekend.

♣ Twins are on game eight of a 13-game stretch with no off-days...their next off-day will be Thursday, September 12.

♣ Twins have gone 78-60 in September under Rocco Baldelli, since 2019...only Dave Roberts (91-43), Brian Snitker (81-54), Craig Counsell (81-58), Aaron Boone (77-64) and Kevin Cash (78-58)have as many September managerial wins in that span.

PABLO DOES WHAT NEEDED TO BE DONE: The Twins beat the Rays yesterday afternoon at Tropicana Field by a score of 4-3, improving to 22-17 in one-run games while leaving St. Petersburg with a 2-2 split...Pablo López (14-8) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on seven hits in 6.2 innings pitched, with one walk and nine strikeouts...Griffin Jax earned his 23rd hold and Jhoan Duran earned his 22nd save...the offense recorded seven hits, scoring all four runs in the second and third inning on a three-run jimmy jack from Edouard Julien (8) in the third and a solo home run from Matt Wallner (11) in the fourth.

ROYALTY CHECKS: The Twins and Royals are playing their final three games of the 2024 season this weekend...Minnesota has gone 7-3 vs. the Royals in 2024, going 2-1 at Kauffman Stadium and 5-2 at Target Field...Twins have gone 23-10 in their last 33 against the Royals. 
₱ These two last met for three games at Target Field from August 12-14 as the Twins took two of three, outscoring the Royals 22-10 in the series...the last time these two met at Kauffman was to open the season as the Twins took the first two of three games. 
₱ Minnesota's 13-3 win on August 13 at Target Field sealed the season-series against Kansas City, securing a winning record for the third-straight season over the Royals (9-4 in 2023 and 12-7 in 2022).
