ROYALS SNEAK UP ON TWINS LATE: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 4-2...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, pitching 7.0 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, no walks and seven strikeouts, retiring each of his final 15 batters faced...Jhoan Duran (6-9) was issued the loss, allowing three runs in the eighth inning as Griffin Jax followed by allowing a fourth Royals run to cross in the inning...the offense recorded five hits and were led by Edouard Julien, who went 2-tor-3 with a double...the loss secured the series victory for the Royals, giving the Twins their fourth series loss in their last six chances (1-3-1), since their August 19-21 series in San Diego.

WHAT MORE CAN I 'SE: Jose Miranda has hit safely in nine of his last 11 games, hitting .324 (12-for-37) in that span.

◆In 61 games since June 12, he is hitting .324 (67-for-207) with 18 doubles, three triples, three home runs, 28 RBI and an .848 OPS...since that date, he ranks eighth in baseball in batting average (min. 200 PA).
