THE TWINS: Completed their seven-game roadtrip with a record of 2-5, going 2-2 at Tampa Bay and 0-3 at Kansas City...tonight, the Twins will begin a six-game, seven-day homestand with the first of three against the Angels through Wednesday night...after this series, the Twins will enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then host the Reds for three games over the weekend.
 ☞ Twins are on game 11 of a 13-game stretch with no off-days...their next off-day will this Thursday.

MISSOURI MISERY: The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon at Kauffman Stadium, by a score of 2-0, suffering their 10th shutout of the season and eighth time being swept in 2024...Simeon Woods Richardson (5-4) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing two runs on three hits in 4.1 innings pitched, with three walks and two strikeouts...the offense recorded just five hits, three coming from Christian Vázquez, all singles...Minnesota finished the series going 14-for-91 (.154) and scored just two runs over the weekend (0.7 R/G).

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins have placed catcher Christian Vázquez on the Paternity List... Vázquez has played in 84 games for the Twins this season, hitting .228 (60-for-263) with nine doubles, seven home runs, 27 RBI and 26 runs scored...to replace Vázquez on the 28-man roster, the Twins have recalled catcher Jair Camargo from Triple-A St. Paul...Camargo has played in 67 games for the Saints this season, hitting .205 (53-for-259) with 15 doubles, 11 home runs, 49 RBI and 22 walks...this marks Camargo's third stint with the Twins this season after appearing in five games in April and July, going 0-for-6 with a walk.

TWINS AND HALOS: The Twins and Angels are playing their fourth of six games this season... these two last met for three games at Angel Stadium from April 26-28 as the Twins swept and outscored Anaheim 32-13...the three wins were wins five, six and seven on the 12-game winning streak that went from April 22-May 4.

☞ The last time the Twins hosted the Angels was from September 22-24 of last season, winning the bookend games of the three-game series.

☞ Twins have won four-straight over Anaheim, dating back to September 24, 2023...a win tonight would be their longest winning streak over the Angels since May 14-May 23, 2019 (also 5).

☞ A win tonight would secure the season series over the Angels for the first time since 2019 (5-1).

☞ Willi Castro has hit safely in his last 16 games vs. the Angels since August 17, 2021, batting .348 (23-for-66) with six doubles, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI, 12 runs scored and a .992 OPS in that span...it's Castro's longest of his career against any opponent...it ties Chuck Knoblauch (June 7, 1994-May 3, 1996) for the longest in Twins history against the Angels.

☞ Kyle Farmer is hitting .424 (14-for-33) with three doubles, four walks, a .500 on-base percentage and a 1.015 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Angels.

☞ Carlos Santana is hitting .310 (13-for-42) with four doubles, six home runs, 18 RBI and a 1.189 OPS in his last 10 games against the Angels.

WEST IS THE BEST: The Twins have gone 23-7 against AL West opponents this season, going 5-2 vs. Texas, 3-0 vs. Los Angeles, 5-2 vs. Seattle, 4-2 vs. Houston and 6-1 vs. Oakland... their .767 winning percentage against the AL West would be their highest since the current divisional format began in 1994; 2019 being second best at .676 (23-11).

☞ 23 wins against the AL West this season are tied for their third-most in the divisional era...27-22 in 1996, 24-12 in 2010 and 23-11 in 2019.

GETTING LOOSE ON LEFTIES: The Twins are slashing .257/.311/.430 (.741 OPS) against left-handed pitching, compared to .247/.320/.418 (.738 OPS) against right-handers.

☞ The Twins went 16-9 when facing a left-handed starter prior to the All-Star break...since the break, they have gone 5-11 when facing a lefty starter.

☞ Minnesota's .257 average against lefties ranks third the AL and ranks seventh-best in baseball...its .430 slugging percentage ranks second in the AL and seventh in baseball.

☞ In his last 37 games against lefties...since June 5 — Carlos Santana is slashing .308/.393/.679 (1.073 OPS)...since that date, his slugging ranks sixth in the AL and his OPS ranks eighth.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .360 (9-for-25) with one double, four home runs, a .370 on-base, an .880 slugging and a 1.250 OPS in his last 14 games against left-handed pitching.

ROBERTO CLEMENTE AWARD: MLB today announced that right-handed pitcher Pablo López has been named the Twins' 2024 nominee for the Roberto Clemente Award presented by Capital One, baseball's most prestigious individual honor for major leaguers...it is the annual recognition of a major league player who best represents the game of baseball through extraordinary character, community involvement, philanthropy and positive contributions, both on and off the field...as part of the annual program, each MLB club nominates one player to be considered for the league-wide Award in tribute to Clemente's achievements and character.

☞ In addition to generous financial support for the MTCF and its mission, López often takes the time to encourage young people at MTCF programs...this summer, López helped coach young athletes at MTCF's adaptive wheelchair softball clinic, making youth of all ages and abilities feel welcome, inspired and celebrated on the field.

☞ This season, Pablo and his wife, Kaylee, started the "Pablo Day" initiative, turning his regular season home starts into an opportunity to bring awareness and financial support to three nonprofits and causes close to their hearts.

☞ Every September in recognition of Childhood Cancer Awareness Month, López visits Children's Minnesota and the University of Minnesota Masonic Children's Hospital and has become a favorite of patients through his interactions with them and their families.

☞ Another Pablo Day beneficiary is Ruff Start Rescue, for Pablo and Kaylee's love of animals; the pair recently adopted a puppy — their second rescue dog — through the organization, which focuses on finding loving homes for abandoned animals.

☞ The third Pablo Day nonprofit is Project Success, a program dedicated to supporting students that represents the Lópezes' commitment to empowering youth through education.

☞ López takes advantage of every opportunity he can to support students, bringing underserved students back-to-school shopping to equip them with the supplies they need to be successful and visiting local high school classes to help students practice their foreign language conversational skills.

☞ This marks Pablo's second career nomination (2022 with Miami)...last season's Twins nomination was Carlos Correa.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1976, Rod Carew hit a pinch-hit grand slam in the seventh for the Twins as Minnesota beat Texas, 6-0...it marked Carew's third grand slam of that year...it was the ninth pinch-hit grand slam in Twins history and one of 15 to date...the last to do it was Matt LeCroy on May 19, 2004 at Toronto.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on September 3 at Tampa...took the 2-1 loss his fifth of the season, allowing two runs on five hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in 5.0 innings...allowed two RBI singles from Jonathan Aranda and Logan Driscoll in the fourth inning...Rays hitters went 2-for-11 with four strikeouts first time through the batting order.

- ⚡ His seven strikeouts matched the second-highest total of his MLB career (high is 9 K)...has now recorded back-to-back games with seven strikeouts.
- ⚡ 90 pitches also set a new MLB career high.

TWO STARTS AGO: Made the start on August 28 vs. Atlanta...took the 5-1 loss, allowing two runs on two hits in a career-high 6.0 innings, with one walk and seven strikeouts...first-inning Jorge Soler home run was the first home run (3rd XBH) he's allowed first time through the order...struck out the side in a 1-2-3 fifth inning...second time through the order, Atlanta went 0-for-9 with five strikeouts; entering the game...was pulled after walking Marcell Ozuna to lead off the seventh; Caleb Thielbar entered and allowed the run to score.

- ⚡ Recorded the first quality start of his career.

FIRST START VS. LOS ANGELES-AL: Making first career start and appearance vs. Los Angeles-AL.

- ⚡ Making his fifth start against American League opponents; he is 0-2, 5.89 ERA (18.1 IP, 12 ER), four walks, 22 strikeouts, a 1.47 WHIP and a .295 (23-for-78) opponent batting average.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making fifth start at home (sixth appearances)...is 0-3 with a 5.64 ERA (22.1 IP, 14 ER), eight walks, 28 strikeouts and a .859 opponent OPS in four home starts (sixth appearance), compared to 2-3 with a 3.96 ERA (25.0 IP, 11 ER), five walks, 30 strikeouts and a .622 OPS in five road starts.

- ⚡ Twins are 1-4 in Festa's home home starts.
- ⚡ Has allowed six of his eight home runs at Target Field.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through nine MLB games vs. Festa, left-handed hitters have hit .223 (21-for-94) with a .436 slugging percentage, .727 OPS, 28.2 percent strikeout rate, 7.8 percent walk rate and 3.8 percent home run rate, while righties have hit .253 (23-for-91) with a .451 SLG, .742 OPS, 30.2 percent strikeout rate, 5.2 percent walk rate and 4.2 percent home run rate.

- ⚡ Whiff rate: 28.6 percent vs. lefties, 27.4 percent vs. righties.
- ⚡ Hard-hit rate vs. Festa: 29.2 percent by lefties, 46.8 percent by righties.
- ⚡ Average exit velocity vs. Festa: 86.5 mph by lefties, 91.1 mph by righties.

THE ARSENAL: Festa has used a three-pitch mix in his MLB outings, not throwing any curveballs -- his least-used pitch in Triple-A this season...here's his pitch mix and results:

- ⚡ Changeup has a 42.2 percent whiff rate, but has allowed four home runs and a .473 SLG.
- ⚡ In his last two start hitters went 1-for-18 with five strikeouts vs. Festa's slider.
- ⚡ In two-strike counts, opponents have gone 5-for-29 with 19 strikeouts vs. Festa's 4-seamer.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - PABLO LÓPEZ (2024: 14-8, 4.05 ERA // CAREER: 53-47, 3.90 ERA)
