♣ After starting the season with a record of 70-53 in their first 123 games, the Twins have gone 12-25 in their last 37...in those first 123 they scored 4.9 runs-per-game...in these last 37 they have scored 3.7 runs-per-game.

TWINS FALL IN THEIR FINAL HAIL MARY: The Twins lost to the Orioles last night at Target Field by a score of 7-2...Pablo López (15-10) was the starter and was dealt the loss, allowing two runs on six hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with three walks and eight strikeouts...the offense recorded just four hits, walked three times and went 1-for-8 with runners in scoring position... Byron Buxton had two of the club's hits, doubling twice, his 26th and 27th of the season... Minnesota was officially eliminated from Postseason contention as Kansas City and Detroit claimed the final two American League Wild Card spots.

from 2022 (423) and 2006 (351)...of the 2024 rookies, starters have struck out 225 (3rd-most) and relievers have struck out 72 (17th-most).

TWINS AND 0's: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other for the fifth of six games in 2024...Twins are 0-4 against Baltimore this season, going 0-3 at Camden Yards in mid-April, followed by a loss last night.

♣ Minnesota has lost eight straight vs. the Orioles, their longest losing streak to Baltimore since July 30, 1996-May 1, 1997 (also 8)...last time they lost nine-straight was July 21 (G2), 1980-May 17, 1981, when they lost 12.

♣ The Twins are 38-25 vs. Baltimore since the start of 2014...that marks the second-most wins against Baltimore among non-American League East teams in that span...the only other non-AL East team with more wins is Houston (42-24).

TWINS BRING BACK THE BIG MAYONNAISE (AND OTHER MOVES): The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Diego Castillo and utility player Michael Helman.

♣ Castillo has appeared in six games over two stints with the Twins this season, posting a 2.25 ERA (8.0 IP, 2 ER) with seven walks, four strikeouts and a .200 opponent batting average...he made 40 relief appearances for Triple-A St. Paul this season, going 0-5, 5.59 ERA (37.0 IP, 23 ER), eight saves, 25 walks and 42 strikeouts.

♣ Helman played in seven games for the Twins from September 3-10, hitting .375 (3-for-8) with two doubles and two runs scored...he played in 72 games for St. Paul this season, hitting .271 (75-for-277) with 18 doubles, 14 home runs, 47 RBI, 49 runs scored, 29 walks, 12 stolen bases, a .350 on-base percentage and an .837 OPS.

♣ To make room for Castillo and Helman on the 28-man roster, the Twins have placed infielder Jose Miranda on the 10-day Injured List with a low back strain and have optioned left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk...Miranda played in 121 games for Minnesota this season, hitting .284 (114-for-401) with 28 doubles, four triples, nine home runs, 49 RBI and a .763 OPS... Funderburk, who was recalled yesterday, appeared in last night's game, pitching 1.0 inning.

I'M JUST GLADD TO BE HERE: Twins radio stallion Dan Gladden hit .261 (64-for-245) with four home runs in 69 career games against Baltimore...three of those home runs came in a three-game stretch from August 10-12, 1993 at Tiger Stadium, which included 12 RBI...that stretch of 12 RBI was the most he had in a three-game span in his career.
