loss in 2021 at Milwaukee)...following this series, the Twins will travel to Chicago to play a three-game series against the White Sox at Rate Field from Monday-Wednesday...following this trip, Minnesota will open its 16th season at Target Field with three games in four days against the Astros, beginning with the Home Opener on Thursday, April 3, followed by an off-day on Friday, then games two and three on Saturday and Sunday.

SPRING CLEANING: The Twins completed their 35th Spring Training in Fort Myers, FL on Tuesday with a record of 13-15-3...Ty France led the club in hits (21)...Matt Wallner led in home runs (6) and RBI (14)...Armando Alvarez played the most games (21)...Bailey Ober led the pitching staff in innings (20.1), while Pablo López led in strikeouts (22)...additionally, the Twins drew 113,670 in total attendance, ranking fourth in the Grapefruit League, behind New York-AL (151,837), Philadelphia (138,515) and Boston (126,102).

I GUESS IF WE HAVE TO TALK ABOUT IT: The Twins finished the 2024 season with a record of 82-80, in fourth place in the American League Central and 10.5 games back of the division-winning Cleveland Guardians (92-69)...behind the Guards were the Royals (86-76) and Tigers (86-76), who both made the playoffs as Wild Card teams...Minnesofa began the 2024 season by going 7-13 in their first 20 games through April 21...the Twins then won 12 straight from April 22-May 4 and continued to go 63-40 in their next 103 games from April 22-August 17, the most wins in baseball in that span...after August 17, they went 12-27 to finish the year and won just two of their final 12 series.

GRAND OPENING: The Twins opened last season vs. the Royals at Kauffman Stadium, winning by a score of 4-1...the Twins are 29-35 all-time in season openers, 11-13 when opening at home and 18-22 when opening on the road...the Iwins are looking for three-straight Opening Day wins for the first time since 2001-04, when they won a club record four-straight...the last time they won three-straight road openers was from 2001-03, winning in Detroit, Kansas City and Detroit. ₱ Pablo López will become the fourth different Twins pitcher to start at least three-straight Opening Days, joining Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Brad Radke (1999-05) and Dave Goltz (1977-79). ₱ In terms of non-consecutive, but overall Opening Day starts, López's three ranks tied for fourth in club history with Dave Goltz (3 - 1977-79), trailing Brad Radke (9 - 1996-97, '99-05), Bert Blyleven (6 - 1972-76, '87) and Frank Viola (4 - 1985-86, '88-89).

PABLO LÓP-ACE: Since being acquired by the Twins in January of 2023, Pablo López has gone 26-18, 3.87 ERA (379.1 lP, 163 ER) with 89 walks, 432 strikeouts, a 1.17 WHIP and 38 quality stats in 64 starts...below are López's ranks among AL starters since the start of 2023 (minimum 300.0 innings pitched):

ROC SOLID: Rocco Baldelli is entering his seventh season as the skipper and has a career managerial record of 457-413 (.525)...he ranks fourth on the club's all-time managerial wins list, trailing Tom Kelly (1,140). Ron Gardenhire (1,068) and Sam Mele (522)...his. 525 winning percentage is second-best in club history among managers with at least 400 games, trailing only Sam Mele's .548 mark (522-431 from 1961-67).

#In terms of the franchise list, which includes the Washington Senators (1901-60), he ranks sixth behind the aforementioned four managers plus Bucky Harris (1,336) and Clark Griffith (693).

#Rocco's 457 wins rank seventh among MLB managers since 2019, trailing only Los Angeles-NL's Dave Roberts (564), Atlanta's Brian Snitker (514), New York-AL's Aaron Boone (503), Tampa Bay's Kevin Cash (501), Chicago-NL's Craig Counsell (474) and San Francisco's Bob Melvin (470).

GATEWAY GAMES: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the 40th, 41st an 42nd times in their history during the regular season this week/weekend...Twins are 20-19 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997) and 12-7 in their last 19...in the regular season, the Twins are 6-3 all-time against the Cardinals at Target Field (since 2010), 4-2 at the Metrodome (1998-2000), 2-7 at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and are 8-7 at the new Busch Stadium (2009-23).

♣ These two last met for a three-game series at Target Field from August 23-25, 2024 as the Twins won the middle of the three-game series...the last time these two met at Busch Stadium was for a three-game series from August 1-3, 2023 as the Twins won two of three.

♣ Harrison Bader was selected by the Cardinals in the third round (100th overall) in the 2015 MLB Draft and spent eight professional seasons in St. Louis' organization...made major league debut in Busch Stadium on July 25, 2017 vs. Colorado, doubling off Jake McGee for his first major league hit...he ranks 14th on Busch Stadium's all-time games played list (269)...he also has the seventh-most stolen bases all-time in this ballpark with 24.

FIRST THINGS FIRST: Today will mark Carlos Correa's ninth career Opening Day start at short-stop and fourth as a Twin...he was Houston's Opening Day starting shortstop from 2016-18.
20-21...Correa has hit safely in all eight of his team's Opening Days and has combined to hit .344 (10-for-29) with three doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and three walks on the opener.

The eight-game OD hit-streak is tied with Nick Castellanos and Aaron Judge for longest among actives - Elias Sports Bureau.

ALLOW ME TO RE-INTRODUCE MYSELF: The Twin sopen the 2025 season with eight players on their 26-man roster who were not not not the 2024 Opening Day roster: pitchers (4) - Danny Coulombe, Randy Dobnak, Justin Topa and Simeon Woods Richardson; infielders (1) - Ty France; outfielders (2) - Harrison Bader and DaShawn Keirsey Jr.; utility players (1) - Mickey Gasper.

4 Of the 26 players on the Twins' active roster, 12 began their professional careers in the Twins organization: Byron Buxton, Randy Dobnak, Griffin Jax, Ryan Jeffers, Edouard Julien, DaShawn Keirsey Jr., Trevor Larnach, Jose Miranda, Bailey Ober, Cole Sands, Louis Varland and Matt Wallner.

SPRING TRAINING RECAP: Went 0-4, posting a 6.62 ERA (17.2 IP, 13 ER) with nine walks and 22 strikeouts in five 2025 Grapefruit League starts, allowing 24 hits and two home runs

• López is known to utilize spring training as a way to test out various aspects of his repertoire

OPENING DAY THREE-PEAT: This is Pablo's third career and third consecutive Opening Day start... his first came on March 30, 2023 where he pitched 5.1 shutout innings against the Kansas City Royals, with two hits, three walks and eight strikeouts, earning the win in a Twins 2-0 victory...on March 28, 2024, he opened against the Royals once again, pitching 7.0 innings with four hits, no walks and seven strikeouts, again earning the win in a 4-1 Twins victory.

♣ He is the first Twin to make three-straight Opening Day starts since Brad Radke made seven from 1999-2005.

♣ Other pitchers with at least three consecutive Opening Day starts for Minnesota: Brad Radke (1999-05), Dave Goltz (1977-79) and Bert Blyleven (1972-76).

♣ Most Opening Day starts in Twins history: Brad Radke (9), Bert Blyleven (6), Frank Viola (4), Dave Goltz/Pablo López (3).

♣ His third-straight Opening Day start this afternoon is tied with Arizona's Zac Gallen for second-longest active streak in baseball, trailing Houston's Framber Valdez and San Francisco's Logan Webb, each starting their fourth-straight today — credit Elias.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on March 27 at BayCare Ballpark vs. the Phillies...did not factor into Minnesota's 3-6 defeat..allowed two hits in 3.0 scoreless innings, with one walk and four strikeouts.

2024 SEASON RECAP: Made 32 starts on the season, going 15-10 with a 4.08 ERA (185.1 IP, 84 ER), his highest since 2019...allowed 180 total hits (26 HR), with 41 walks and 198 strikeouts... tied career-high strikeouts (14) on June 23 at Oakland...had longest win streak of his career from August 12 through September 10, with 5 straight wins...and threw a career-high 111 pitches during his last outing of the 2024 season vs. Baltimore.

CAREER VS. ST. LOUIS: In five career starts vs. St. Louis: 3-2, 2.33 ERA (38.2 IP, 10 ER), five walks, 39 strikeouts, allowing a .176 AVG (14-for-136)...since being traded to the Twins, Pablo has gone 2-0, 0.69 ERA (13.0 IP, 1 ER), with one walk, 14 strikeouts and a .182 BAA (8-for-44) in two starts.

© Last faced St. Louis on August 24 at Target Field, allowing four hits (0 HR) in 7.0 scoreless innings, with one walk and nine strikeouts; taking the win on Minnesota's 6-0 victory.

© His last start at Busch Stadium was August 1, 2023, allowing one run on four hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts, earning a win in a Twins 3-2 victory.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since being traded to the Twins, López has gone 13-8 with a 3.86 ERA (191.1 IP, 82 ER), 10.21 k/9, 1.93 BB/9 and 0.99 HR/9 in 32 starts at home, compared to 15-10 with a 3.68 ERA (200.2 IP, 82 ER), 10.09 k/9, 2.29 BB/9 and 1.30 HR/9 in 32 road starts.

◆ In 2024, allowed a .265 batting average (90-for-340) and .711 OPS at home, compared to a .240 AVG (90-for-375) and .700 OPS away.

◆ Has three career starts in March (3-0), posting a 2.04 ERA (17.2 IP, 4 ER), with three walks and .22 strikeouts...allowing .180 AVG (11-for-61) during the month.

◆ Posted a 6.35 ERA (17.0 IP) with four walks and 16 strikeouts across his last three road starts in September 2024...allowed seven runs in 4.0 innings in his most recent road start against Boston on September 22, compared to five total runs in 18.3 innings across the three previous road starts from August 18-September 16.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024, left-handed hitters slashed .267/.310/.423 in 352 plate appearances vs. López, while righties slashed .237/.286/.391 in 363 plate appearances...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 31.7, compared to righties' 88.5 mph, 43.5 mph, 43.5 mph.

THE ARSENAL: López used a five-pitch mix in 2024, per Baseball Savant...threw a 4-seamer more than 40% of the time...primarily used his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, wile
