THERE GOES THE PERFECT SEASON - THE '72 DOLPHINS RAISE A GLASS: The Twins lost on Thursday afternoon in St. Louis by a score of 5-3, dropping their first Opening Day since a 2-1 loss to the Mariners on April 8, 2022 at Target Field...Pablo López made his third consecutive Opening Day start, allowing four runs (2 earned) on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and three strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits, two apiece from Trevor Larnach and Harrison Bader. Bader hit the club's first home run of the season with a fifth inning two-run shot and added a double in the eighth inning.

◆ Bader's home run in his first game as a Twin marked the first since Gio Urshela homered on Opening Day 2022 vs. Seattle.

◆ Former Cardinal Harrison Bader ranks 14th on Busch Stadium's all-time games played list (270)...he also has the seventh-most stolen bases all-time in this ballpark with 24.

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins went 18-28 in Interleague Play last season, including a record of just 8-18 since July 14...by comparison, the Twins went 64-52 against AL opponents...
