THE TWINS: Opened their 65th season with consecutive losses to the Cardinals at Busch Stadium on Thursday and Saturday...today, they will play the three-game series finale in St. Louis...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Chicago to play a three-game series against the White Sox at Rate Field from Monday-Wednesday...following this trip, the Twins will open their 16th season at Target Field with three games in four days against the Astros, beginning with the Home Opener on Thursday, April 3, followed by an off-day on Friday, then games two and three on Saturday and Sunday.
⌘ 11 of the Twins' first 16 games (including Thursday's game) are scheduled as day games...the Twins posted a .591 winning percentage (39-27) in day games in 2024, the fourth-highest mark in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (.651 // 28-15), Cleveland (.614 // 35-22) and Milwaukee (.600 // 39-26).

ST. LOUIS BLUES: The Twins lost to the Cardinals yesterday afternoon at Busch Stadium by a score of 5-1, dropping their first series of the season...Joe Ryan made his first start since August 7, 2024, and allowed one run on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Jorge Alcala (0-1) was dealt the loss, allowing three runs on two hits and one walk in the sixth inning and did not record an out...the offense recorded three hits, scoring their only run on a Willi Castro RBI-double in the second inning...Mickey Gasper recorded his first major league hit with an eighth inning infield single off Jolo Romero...Minnesota batters struck out just three times after fanning 11 times in the Opener.

GET OBER THAT FIRST HURDLE: Bailey Ober made his first start of 2024 on March 31 at Kansas City, allowing eight runs on nine hits in 1.1 innings pitched, including three home runs...after that start, he finished the season going 12-8, 3.60 ERA (177.1 IP, 71 ER) with 42 walks, 190 strikeouts, a 0.95 WHIP and a .198 opponent batting average in 30 starts...below are his AL ranks from his second start, on April 8, through the end of the 2024 season:

NATIONAL ATTENTION: The Twins went 18-28 in Interleague Play last season, including a record of just 8-18 since July 14...by comparison, the Twins went 64-52 against AL opponents...Byron Buxton hit .322 (37-for-115) with four doubles, 10 home runs, 21 RBI, a .617 slugging percentage and a .990 OPS in 31 games against the NL in 2024...below is where Buck ranks in a few categories among Twins all-time in Interleague Play:

YOU CAN FIND ME IN ST. LOUEY: Twins and Cardinals are playing each other for the 42nd time in their history during the regular season today...Twins are 20-21 all-time against St. Louis in the regular season (since 1997) and 12-9 in their last 21...in the regular season, the Twins are 6-3 all-time against the Cardinals at Target Field (since 2010), 4-2 at the Metrodome (1998-2000), 2-7 at the old Busch Stadium (1997-2001) and are 8-9 at the new Busch Stadium (2009-23).
⌘ Former Cardinal Harrison Bader ranks 14th on Busch Stadium's all-time games played list (270)...he also has the seventh-most stolen bases all-time in this ballpark with 24.

THE LAST DANCE: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today...last time they were swept in the Opening Series was April 6-7, 2016 in three games at Baltimore...in their history (since 1961), the Twins have been swept in the first series of the season eight times: 2016 (3 games at BAL), 2015 (3 games at DET), 2012 (3 games at BAL), 1988 (2 games at NYY), 1984 (2 games vs. DET), 1981 (4 games vs. OAK), 1969 (2 games at KC) and 1967 (2 games at BAL).
⌘ Twins were swept nine times in 2024, their first coming April 4-6 vs. Cleveland (2 games - PPD/weather-shortened series).

THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach went 2-for-3 with a walk on Thursday and 1-for-3 yesterday...his second inning single yesterday extended his hitting streak to six games, setting a new career-high (dating to September 22, 2024)...dating back to August 21, 2024, he is hitting .316 (31-for-98) with 15 RBI, a .402 on-base percentage and an .871 OPS in 31 games.
⌘ Larnach's improvement in strikeout rate from 2023 to 2024 jumped 11.7%, going from 34.0 to 22.3.

EXIT STRATEGY: Through two games, the Twins have posted an average exit velocity of 92.7 mph, the second-highest in baseball, trailing Tampa Bay (93.7 mph)...additionally, they rank fifth in hard hit percentage (48.0%), trailing Philadelphia (57.7%), Tampa Bay (57.4%), Houston (50.8%) and New York-AL (48.2%).
⌘ Willi Castro leads the MLB in average exit velocity at 104.4 mph — among players with at least 25 pitches seen...among that same group of players, Castro ranks third in hard hit percentage at 100.0.

TWINS MILB "WEEKLYS": Outfielder Emmanuel Rodriguez as Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.
⌘ Festa, 25, made the Opening Day start for St. Paul on Friday night vs. Indianapolis, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, no walks and four strikeouts...he retired each of his first eight batters to start the game.
⌘ Rodriguez, 22, went 3-for-4 with a double, a walk and a run scored on Friday night at Indy...Rodriguez is ranked as the club's number two overall prospect by MLB.com.

THIS AND THAT:

⌘ Players yet to be used in 2025: pitchers Randy Dobnak, Bailey Ober, Chris Paddack and Simeon Woods Richardson, and infielder Edouard Julien.
⌘ Twins hitters have struck out just 14 times in two games...only four teams have recorded equal-or-fewer strikeouts: Cleveland (10), Tampa Bay (12), Chicago-AL (13) and Kansas City (14).
⌘ Of the pitching staff's eight earned runs allowed, five have been allowed by relievers, three by starters.
⌘ The Twins' last road win was a 4-2 victory on September 20, 2024 at Fenway Park.
⌘ Twins batters have three hits with two outs this season, all doubles.

- ☞ Enters today looking to snap a four-game losing streak (over 7 starts)...seeking first win since August 9, 2024 vs. Cleveland...seeking first road win since July 28, 2024 at Detroit.
- ☞ Ober has made one career start against the Cardinals, on July 31, 2021 in St. Louis (ND, 4.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R/ER, 1 BB, 6K) — a Twins 8-1 victory.

SPRING TRAINING RECAP: Ober made five starts in spring training, going 2-1, 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...allowed a .231 (18-for-78) opponent batting average, with four runs and two homers...he led Twins staff in total innings pitched at 20.1.

☞ This year marked his most innings pitched in spring training.

☞ Last pitched on March 24 at LECOM Park vs. the Pirates...took the win in Minnesota's 5-1 victory...tossed 3.1 innings allowing one run on two hits, with one walk and two strikeouts.

☞ The Pirates' one run came at the top of the third when Bryan Reynolds singled on a sharp ground ball to right fielder Matt Wallner, scoring Ji Hwan Bae.

2024 SEASON RECAP: Made a career-high 31 starts on the season, going 12-9 with a 3.98 ERA (178.2 IP, 79 ER); allowed 136 total hits (27 HR), with 43 walks and 191 strikeouts...had career-high strikeouts (14) on June 23 at Oakland, career-high walks (4) on June 2 at New York-AL and career-high pitches (106) on August 9 vs. Cleveland.
 ☞ Threw his first complete game on June 22 at Oakland, leading Minnesota to a 10-2 victory.

CAREER VS. ST. LOUIS: In one career start against the Cardinals on July 31, 2021; 2.25 ERA (4.0 IP, 1 ER), with one walk and six strikeouts, allowing a .267 (4-for-15) opponent batting average.

☞ It marked his 11th career start in his rookie season and fifth on the road.

☞ Did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 8-1 win over the Cardinals.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In four seasons with the Twins, Ober has gone 14-9 with a 3.85 ERA (231.1 IP, 99 ER), 9.34 K/9, 2.22 B/9 and 1.56 HR/9 in 44 starts at home compared to 11-12 with a 3.68 ERA (240.0 IP, 98 ER), 9.15 K/9, 1.69 BB/9 and 1.24 HR/9 in 44 road starts.

- ✚ In 2024, allowed a .221 (69-for-312) batting average and .701 OPS at home, compared to a .195 (67-for-343) opponent batting average and .607 OPS away.
- ✚ Has not allowed more than three runs in a road game since June 6, 2024 at Pittsburgh; is 2-1, 2.13 ERA (55.0 IP, 13ER) with a .144 (27-for-187) opponent batting average in eight road starts in that span...has not allowed more than two home runs since his one and only previous start on March 31, 2024 at Kansas City.
- ✚ Did not factor into the decision of any of Minnesota's last three consecutive away game losses of the 2024 regular season, despite throwing 6-9+ innings in each...had a 2.25 ERA (20.0 IP, 5 ER), with no walks and 24 strikeouts on a .130 (9-for-69) opponent batting average and a 0.45 WHIP.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In 2024 left-handed batters slashed .190/.233/.359 in 326 plate appearances, while righties slashed .223/.285/.418 in 383 plate appearances...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 85.3 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 39.1, compared to righties' 88.7 mph, 29 percent and 27.2 percent

⌘ Posted a whiff rate of 30.5 percent vs. lefties and 27.2 percent vs. righties.

THE ARSENAL: Ober used a five-pitch mix in 2024, per Baseball Savant...threw a 4-seamer over 38% of the time...primarily used his slider and sweeper against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his 2024 pitch breakdown:

- ⚡ He ranked in the 99th percentile for offspeed run value, the 97th percentile for extension, the 93rd percentile for chase % and the 91st percentile pitching run value.
- ⚡ Lowered 4-seamer use from 45.7% and sweeper from 17.1% in 2023...increased slider from 2.4% in 2023.
- ⚡ In his single appearance against the Cardinals in 2021, he threw a 4-seam fastball 63 percent of the time, inducing a whiff rate of 43 percent.
- ⚡ In 2024, his changeup ranked first in baseball (min. 150 PA) in opponent batting average (.154), first in strikeout rate (37.7%), second in wOBA (.212) and second in put away rate (30.6%).
