THE TWINS: Opened their 65th season by getting swept in three games to the Cardinals at Busch Stadium...today, Minnesota will continue the trip with the first of three on the Southside against the White Sox...following Wednesday afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel home to open their 16th season at Target Field with three games in four days against the Astros, beginning with the Home Opener on Thursday, followed by an off-day on Friday, then games two and three on Saturday and Sunday.

# 11 of the Twins' first 16 games (including Thursday's game) are scheduled as day games...
the Twins posted a .591 winning percentage (39-27) in day games in 2024, the fourth-highest mark in baseball, trailing Los Angeles-NL (.651 // 28-15), Cleveland (.614 // 35-22) and Milwaukee (.600 // 39-26).

**BAILEY BEAT-UP BY BIRDS:** The Twins lost to the Cardinals yesterday afternoon at Busch Stadium by a score of 9-2, suffering the three-game sweep...Bailey Ober (0-1) was the starter and loser, allowing eight runs on eight hits in 2.2 innings pitched, with three walks, three strikeouts and two home runs (both 3-run shots)...the offense recorded five hits, two from Willi Castro, who hit his first home run of the season and second for a Twins hitter in 2025...Matt Wallner reached twice, going 1-for-3 with a walk...Minnesota remains one of four win-less teams on the season, joining Detroit (0-3), Atlanta (0-4) and Milwaukee (0-3).

PITCH DMC: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Darren McCaughan from Triple-A St. Paul...McCaughan (pronounced man-CACK-en), 29, split the 2024 season between Triple-A Columbus, Triple-A Jacksonville, the Guardians and the Marlins, combining to go 5-4, 5.22 ERA (127.2 IP, 74 ER), 45 walks and 120 strikeouts in 29 games (22 starts)... the Long Beach, California native was signed by the Twins to a minor league contract over the offseason and pitched in three games for Minnesota in spring training.

To make room on both the 26-man and 40-man rosters, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak for release or assignment...Dobnak appeared in relief yesterday afternoon in St. Louis, allowing one run on two hits (1 home run) in 5.1 innings pitched, with two walks and one strikeout.

TWINS AND SOX: The Twins went 12-1 vs. the Sox last season, going 7-0 at Target Field and 5-1 at Guaranteed Rate Field...Minnesota's .923 winning percentage against the Sox in 2024 was the highest in their history, ahead of their 1966 total of .778 (14-4) and their 2001 total of .737 (14-5).

♣ Minnesota has gone 19-2 in its last 21 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

♣ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 99-70 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

♣ Since 2019, no opponent has hit more home runs at Rate Field than the Twins, hitting 88 home runs (next: Kansas City with 55 and Cleveland with 53)...in that same span, no team has hit more homers against the Sox overall (home or away) than the Twins with 145 (next is KC with 105).

THEY WEAR OUT THE SOX: Notable individuals against White Sox pitching:

◆ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .368 (21-for-57) with a 1.053 OPS in 18 games vs. the White Sox.

◆ In his last 11 games against the White Sox, Willi Castro is hitting .356 (16-for-45) with three doubles, two friples, two home runs, 13 RBI, a .644 slugging percentage and a 1.040 OPS.

◆ In his last nine games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, seven walks, a .459 on-base percentage and a 1.059 OPS.

◆ Matt Wallner is hitting .339 (21-for-62) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .474 on-base percentage and a 1.055 OPS in 21 career games against the White Sox...in 10 career games at Rate Field, he is slashing .438/.514/.688 (1.201 OPS), hitting safely in nine of those 10...five of his last seven games here have been multi-hit games.

**BUX AND THE SOX:** Byron Buxton is hitting .288 (85-for-295) with 27 doubles, one triple, 21 home runs, 49 RBI, 61 runs scored and a .925 OPS in 87 career games vs. the White Sox... below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 39 (June 30, 2019-present):

◆ Buxton's 21 career home runs and 49 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent...since 2019, Buck has an at-bat-per-home run ratio of 9.33 at Rate Field, third-highest in baseball (minimum of 50 plate appearances), trailing Shohei Ohtani (7.67) and Aaron Judge (8.00).

THE LEFTORIUM: The Twins had 19 plate appearances against left-handed pitching during the Cardinals series, recording three hits (Castro - 2, Gasper - 1)...in 2024, Minnesota hitters slashed .253/.310/.422 (.732 OPS) against lefties, compared to .244/.317/.407 (.724 OPS) against righties.

◆ Minnesota's .422 slugging percentage vs. lefties last season ranked fourth in the AL and ninth in baseball...their .732 OPS ranked fourth in the AL and 10th in baseball.

SPRING RECAP: Made five official 2025 Grapefruit League starts in his second spring training with Minnesota, going 1-0, 4.58 ERA (17.2 IP, 2 ER) with 21 strikeouts and four walks...first spring training with more than four appearances since 2021...struck out 5+ batters three times: March 14 vs. Tampa Bay (6), March 20 vs. Boston (7) and March 25 vs. Colorado (5)...in final spring outing on March 25 vs. Colorado, allowed two earned runs, both on a second-inning two-run home run by Hunter Goodman; struck out five and walked two over 3.1 innings.

₱Paddack unofficially started on February 24 at Tampa Bay; game was cancelled due to rain after 2.0 innings...struck out one and allowed one baserunner, a Danny Jansen solo home run in the first inning.

2024 RECAP: Went 5-3, 4.99 ERA (88.1 IP, 49 ER) across 17 starts in his third season with the Twins. posted a career-low 3.76 strikeout-to-walk ratio (79K, 21 BB)...went 5.0+ innings in 12 starts and struck out at least six in eight starts...allowed an extra-base hit in 14 starts and a home run in 11... recorded two 10+ strikeout games, April 22 vs. White Sox (7.0 IP, 0 ER) and May 8 vs. Seattle (5.1 IP, 1 ER), for the first time in career...Twins were 11-6 in Paddack's starts.

Twice rebounded from a 7+ run outing with a subsequent scoreless start, nine runs at Baltimore

on April 16 to scoreless vs. Chicago-AL on April 22, seven runs at New York-AL on June 5 to scoreless vs. Colorado on June 10...had not done so prior to 2024.

Following his June 21 start at OAK, was placed on the 15-day Injured List with right arm fatigue; was eventually shut down for the season with a right forearm strain after July 14 start at SF.

**FINAL 2024 APPEARANCE:** Started on July 14, 2024 at San Francisco (5.0 IP, 1 ER)...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-2 walk-off loss, his fourth consecutive no-decision and third on the road...allowed two runs on five hits, walking one and striking out six...three of five first outs were strikeouts...fourth inning strikeout to Thairo Estrada was career No. 200 on the road...outing was his second since coming off the 15-day Injured List on July 8 (right arm fatigue).

FACING THE WHITE SOX: Made first two career starts against Chicago-AL in 2024, going 1-0, 1.50 ERA (12.0 IP, 2 ER)...did not factor into the decision of most recent outing on July 8, 2024 at Rate Field (5.0 IP, 2 ER), an 8-6 Minnesota victory...both runs came on two-out extra-base hits: a third-inning home run by Martín Maldonado and fifth-inning RBI double by Corey Julks.

© Struck out a season-high 10 batters in first career start against White Sox, April 22 at Target Field.

♦ In his career, Paddack is 1-1 in six starts against American League Central teams with a 2.72 ERA, five walks and 33 strikeouts; in 2024, went 1-0 in four starts with a 2.81 ERA, four walks and 23 strikeouts...has pitched fewer innings vs. American League Central (36.1) than any

JUST ANOTHER PADDACK MONDAY: In 10 career starts on Mondays, Paddack is 7-1 with a 2.18 ERA (57.2 IP, 14 ER) and a 0.90 WHIP; is his lowest ERA on any day of the week and his most wins...his 61 strikeouts rank fourth behind Wednesdays (85), Tuesdays (72) and Sundays (63)...since joining the Twins, he is 3-0 in four Monday appearances (23.2 IP, 3 ER) with 22 strikeouts and three walks; his 1.14 ERA leads all Minnesota pitchers on Mondays in that span.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since 2022, has gone 3-3 with a 5.47 ERA (54.1 IP, 33 ER) in 11 appearances (10 starts) on the road, compared to 4-2 with a 4.26 ERA (61.1 IP, 29 ER) in 13 appearances (12 starts) at Target Field...has struck out 42 batters and walked 13 on the road, compared to 65 strikeouts, 11 walks at home...fewer home runs allowed on the road (6) than at home (9) with a lower OPS on the road (.722) than at home (.781).

Thin his career, Paddack is 11-13 in 42 starts (43 games) on the road with a 4.51 ERA (215.2 IP, 108 ER), 201 strikeouts and 47 walks, compared to 16-11 in 40 starts (42 games) with a 4.24 ERA (208.0 IP, 98 ER), 216 strikeouts and 42 walks at home.
