**THE TWINS:** Opened their season by getting swept in three games to the Cardinals at Busch Stadium, followed by a loss to the White Sox at Rate Field yesterday afternoon...today, Minnessota will continue the trip with the second of three on the Southside against the White Sox... following tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will travel home to open their 16th season at Target Field with three games in four days against the Astros, beginning with the Home Opener on Thursday, followed by an off-day on Friday, then games two and three on Saturday and Sunday.

**TWINS SOCKED ON SOUTH SIDE:** The Twins were shut out by the White Sox at Rate Field yesterday afternoon by a score of 9-0, suffering their biggest margin of loss in a shutout since a 15-0 defeat on August 31, 2024 vs. Toronto...Chris Paddack (0-1) was the starter and loser, tying a career high with nine runs allowed on six hits (3 HR) in 3.1 innings tiched, with four walks and two strikeouts — Paddack's first start since July 14, 2024 at San Francisco...the offense recorded just two hits, singles from Ryan Jeffers and Willi Castro...Jeffers reached three times, drawing two walks.

FILTHY RICH: Simeon Woods Richardson made his first career Opening Day roster this season...he started 2024 at Triple-A St. Paul and made two starts before eventually becoming a mainstay in Minnesota's rotation...overall, he made 28 starts for the Twins, going 5-5, 4.17 ERA (133.2 IP, 62 ER) with 48 walks and 117 strikeouts...below are where SWR ranked among MLB rookie pitchers in a few categories (minimum 125.0 innings pitched):

DEEP DISH: The Twins are playing the White Sox today for the second of 13 scheduled games in 2025...yesterday marked their first loss to the Sox since a 3-1 defeat on July 10, 2024 (Game 1) at Rate Field, snapping a four-game winning streak over Chicago...Minnesota went 12-1 vs. the Sox last season, going 7-0 at Target Field and 5-1 at Rate Field.

♣ Minnesota has gone 19-3 in its last 22 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

♣ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 99-71 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

♣ Since 2019, no opponent has hit more home runs at Rate Field than the Twins, hitting 88 home runs (next: Kansas City with 55 and Cleveland with 53)...in that same span, no team has hit more homers against the Sox overall (home or away) than the Twins with 145 (next is KC with 105).

THEY WEAR OUT THE SOX: Notable individuals against White Sox pitching:

Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .373 (22-for-59) with a 1.067 OPS in 19 games vs. the White Sox.

In his last 12 games against the White Sox, Willi Castro is hitting .347 (17-for-49) with three

games vs. the White Sox.

In his last nine games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, seven walks, a .459 on-base percentage and a 1.059 OPS.

Matt Wallner is hitting .339 (21-for-62) with four doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .474 on-base percentage and a 1.055 OPS in 22 career games against the White Sox...in 11 career games at Rate Field, he is slashing .438/.514/.688 (1.201 OPS), hitting safely in nine of those 10...five of his last eight games here have been multi-hit games.

BUX AND THE SOX: Byron Buxton is hitting .287 (85-for-296) with 27 doubles, one triple, 21 home runs, 49 RBI, 61 runs scored and a .949 OPS in 88 career games vs. the White Sox... below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 40 (June 30, 2019-present):

WILL-TY PLEASURES: Willi Castro has hit safely in all four games, one of eight players in the AL to hit safely in all of their team's games, joining Andrés Giménez (5), Jacob Wilson (5), Jose Altuve (4), Junior Caminero (4), Maikel Garcia (4), Spencer Torkelson (4) and Bobby Witt Jr. (4)... 
₱ Castro is hitting .357 (5-for-14) with three doubles, one home run, three RBI, one walk, a 400 on-base percentage, a .786 slugging percentage and a 1.186 OPS.
₱ Castro ranks 11th in the AL in average exit velocity at 95.3 mph — among players with at least 60 pitches seen...among that same group, he ranks seventh in hard hit percentage at 70.0.

WHAT DOES THE FOX SAY: Bringing Twins baseball back to free, over-the-air television for the first time since 2012, the Twins, FOX 9 (KMSP-TV) and Gray Media today announced a new multi-year partnership to broadcast 10 Tuesday night regular season games per season...all 10 simulcasts of Twins. TV production will air live in the Twin Cities on the main FOX 9 channel, beginning with an exclusive 30-minute FOX 9 pregame show, "Twins Tuesday Live"...select Gray Media stations in Minnesota, North Dakota, South Dakota and lowa will carry each of the 10 Tuesday games, ensuring local over-the-air coverage of Twins baseball across Twins Territory for the first time since 1988...the first game will be Tuesday, April 15 vs. New York-NL at 6:40 pm (CT).

The Twins have also been selected for five FOX Saturday Baseball telecasts, meaning 15 games will air on FOX 9 this season.

- Fin the middle three appearances of his Grapefruit League season, went 1-1 with 9.0 scoreless innings, two walks and six strikeouts...of his six hits allowed, only one went for extra bases,
- an Austin Riley double on March 15 at Atlanta.

  ◆ Earned his first career spring training victory in his start on March 15 at Atlanta...allowed one hit over 4.0 scoreless innings, walking none and striking out two.

2024 RECAP: Made three starts with Triple-A St. Paul to start the season (0-1, 6.08 ERA, 13.1 IP)...made 2024 RECAP: Made three starts with Iriple-A St. Paul to start the season (U-1, 6.08 ERA, 13.1 IP)...made his first major league start of the season and secured his first career victory as the 27th man in game two of an April 13 doubleheader in Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, BB, 5 K)...officially joined the starting rotation on April 25 vs. Chicago-AL, went 5.0 innings and allowed two runs on seven hits, one walk and six strikeouts; did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-3 win...finished 5-5 in 28 starts with a 4.17 ERA over 133.2 innings (48 BB, 117 K); Twins were 17-11 in Woods Richardson's starts.

♥Was the shortest outing of his career and the 14th time in 2024 that he pitched fewer than 5.0 innings...went 0-3 in those starts (Twins went 8-6) and allowed 3+ runs in nine of them,

AGAINST WHITE SOX: Made all three of his career starts vs. Chicago-AL in 2024, posting a 4.26 ERA AGAINST WHITE SOX: Made all three of his career starts vs. Chicago-AL in 2024, posting a 4.26 ERA (12.2 IP, 6 ER)...did not factor into any game decisions; Twins went 3-0...his 20 hits and six walks allowed to Chicago-AL are his most against any team...his 14 career strikeouts are second most behind Cleveland (15)...in his most recent outing against the White Sox on August 4 a target Field, he pitched 4.0 innings, allowed three runs on six hits, walked three and struck out six.

◆ Made back-to-back starts against the White Sox on April 25 at home and April 30 at Rate Field in the midst of Minnesota's 12-game win streak (April 22-May 4).

◆ Chicago-AL has loaded the bases at least once in each game against Woods Richardson, converting twice: Kevin Pillar sacrifice fly in the second inning on April 25; Tommy Pham reaching on an error in the fourth inning on April 30 (Kody Funderburk on the mound, unearned run charged to Woods Richardson).
