TWINS SUFFER ANOTHER BLOWN LEAD AT HOME: The Twins lost to the Tigers last night at Target Field by a score of 7-6, blowing a 4-1 lead they held entering the sixth inning...David Festa was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one unearned run on three hits, with one walk and four strikeouts...Jorge Alcala (0-2) was dealt the loss, allowing four runs on two hits and two walks without recording an out...the offense recorded 12 hits, which tied a season-high...Edouard Julien and Ty France each had three hits...Byron Buxton hit his second home run of the season...France and Buxton each drove in two runs...the game lasted 3:21, the longest nine-inning game for the Twins this season.

HAVE A LITTLE FUNDY: The Twins have recalled left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk from Triple-A St. Paul...Funderburk has thrown 5.2 scoreless innings with one hit allowed, two walks and seven strikeouts in four relief appearances for the Saints this season...the 28-year-old pitched in 27 games for Minnesota in 2024, going 1-0 with one save, five holds, a 6.49 ERA (34.2 IP, 25 ER), 15 walks, 32 strikeouts and a 1.62 WHIP...to make room for Funderburk on the 26-man roster, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Scott Blewett for release or assignment...Blewett made two appearances since joining the Twins on April 7, pitching 4.2 innings with one run allowed, four hits, no walks and five strikeouts.

TWINS AND TIGERS: The Twins went 7-6 against the Tigers last season, going 3-3 at Comerica Park and 4-3 at Target Field.

♣ The Twins have gone 38-20 at home against the Tigers since the start of the 2018 season, second-most home wins against any opponent in that span (Kansas City - 41-15)...in fact, in that time frame, the Twins have only lost three home series to the Tigers, holding a 13-3-2 series record in that span.

♣ Twins lead baseball in home runs vs. Detroit since the start of 2019, hitting 133, 25 ahead of Cleveland (108).

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .304 (34-for-112) with seven doubles, six home runs, 17 RBI and an .898 OPS in his last 29 games vs. the Tigers...he has homered four times in his last 12 against the Tigers.

♣ Byron Buxton has a .998 OPS and a .645 slugging percentage in his last eight games against the Tigers, hitting five doubles and two home runs in 34 plate appearances.

NOTHING RUNS LIKE A BEER BUCK: Byron Buxton stole his third base of the season last night... he had seven all of 2024...it marked the 96th stolen base of Buck's career, tying Matt Lawton for ninth on the Twins all-time list:

READY AND WILLING: Willi Castro has reached base safely in all 13 of his games played, tied for fifth-longest active on-base streak in baseball with Jackson Chourio, Kyle Schwarber and Fernando Tatis Jr., trailing Kyle Tucker (15), Jacob Wilson (14), Kristian Campbell (14) and Corbin Carroll (14).

STARTING TO ROLL: In their first 10 games of the season, the Twins starting staff went 1-5, 6.90 ERA (45.2 IP, 35 ER), with 17 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .314 opponent batting average and 11 home runs allowed...in their last four starts, since Tuesday, they have combined to go 1-0, 0.40 ERA (22.1 IP, 1 ER), with three walks, 18 strikeouts, a .163 opponent batting average and no home runs allowed.

EIFFEL POWER: Ty France enters today with a five-game hitting streak, the longest for a Twin this season...over the streak, he is hitting .500 (9-for-18) with two doubles, two home runs, five RBI, a .571 on-base percentage, a .944 slugging percentage and a 1.516 OPS...on the season, he has posted an .844 OPS, which ranks 10th in the AL among players with at least 55 plate appearances.

♣ Additionally on the season, he ranks in the 97th percentile in strikeout percentage (7.3%), 93rd in expected batting average (.328) and 89th in xwOBA (.411).

TARGET FIELD IM-MAUER-TALITY: The Twins will formally unveil and dedicate a statue outside
Target Field honoring the career and legacy of St. Paul native, franchise legend and 2024 National Baseball Hall of Fame inductee Joe
Mauer...tomorrow at 11:30 am on Target Plaza, outside Target Field's Gate 34 heading toward 6th Street and 1st Avenue...along with
Mauer, the following are also scheduled to attend: Justin Morneau (longtime teammate and Twins Hall of Famer), Tom Kelly (Twins Hall
of Famer who also has a Target Field statue in his honor), Paul Molitor (fellow St. Paul native and National Baseball Hall of Famer,
along with Joe's final Twins manager), Tony Oliva (Twins great and National Baseball Hall of Famer), Corey Koskie (teammate and Twins
Hall of Fame electee), Glen Perkins (fellow Minnesota native and former teammate) and Bill Mack (the Minnesota-based artist who has
crafted each Target Field statue).

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, the Twins played their first ever game at Target Field, hosting the Boston Red Sox and winning 5-2...Carl Pavano was the starter and winner while Jon Rauch earned the save...Joe Mauer went 3-for-5 with two RBI and Jason Kubel went 3-for-4 with a home run and two RBI.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 9-7 loss against Houston at Target Field.. allowed four runs/three earned on seven hits, with two walks and two strikeouts over 4.0 innings.. retired seven in a row from the top of the second through the fourth inning...exited the game in the fifth after the first five batters reached and two scored...Twins led 7-3 at the time of Paddack's relief.

Dose Altuve and Isaac Paredes led off the game with back-to-back singles on the first and

- second pitch thrown by Paddack...was the first time in his career allowing hits off the first two pitches of a game.

 Seven hits allowed were his most since May 14, 2024 at New York-NL (5.0 IP, 12 H)...14th time
- in his career allowing seven-or-more hits and the 10th time doing so in 4.0 innings-or-les

2024 RECAP: Went 5-3, 4.99 ERA (88.1 IP, 49 ER) across 17 starts in his third season with Minnesota: Twins were 11-6 in Paddack's starts...went 5.0+ innings in 12 starts and struck out at least six in eight starts...recorded two 10+ strikeout games, April 22 vs. White Sox (7.0 IP, 0 ER) and May 8 vs. Seattle (5.1 IP, 1 ER), for the first time in career...made final start of the year on July 14 at San Francisco (5.0 IP, 5 H, ER, BB, 6 K) before being shut down for the season on July 20 with a right forearm strain.

₱ Twice rebounded from a 7+ run outing with a subsequent scoreless start; nine runs at Baltimore
on April 16 to scoreless vs. Chicago-AL on April 22, seven runs at New York-AL on June 5 to scoreless vs. Colorado on June 10...had not done so prior to 2024.

FACING DETROIT: Only career start against Detroit came on April 26, 2022 at Target Field...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-4 walk-off victory...allowed one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts over 5.2 innings...exited the game following back-to-back leadoff singles in the sixth and a one-out RBI double by Javier Báez .

- ♣ His one run allowed marked the first of seven eventual starts as a Twin giving up one earned run or less...accomplished the feat in 26 starts with the Padres (2019-2021).
 ♣ Marked his second start against American League Central teams since joining the division (also,
- April 20, 2022 at Kansas City)...since then, has gone 1-1 in five starts with a 5.28 ERA (29.0 IP, 17 ER), seven home runs, eight walks and 25 strikeouts against the AL Central.

 In his 87 career games, the Tigers are one of two teams Paddack has not allowed a home run
- against, the other team being the Atlanta Braves who he has made two starts against.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his second start at Target Field this season...in a Twins uniform, has gone 4-2 with a 4.41 ERA (65.1 IP, 32 ER) in 14 appearances (13 starts) at home, compared to 3-4 with a 6.55 ERA (57.2 IP, 42 ER) in 12 appearances (11 starts) on the road...in that span, has walked

- 13 and struck out 67 at home, compared to 17 walks and 44 strikeouts on the road.

 ◆ In 2024, Paddack went 4-1 in nine starts at Target Field with a 3.61 ERA (47.1 IP, 19 ER); Twins went 8-1...pitched at least 5.0 innings in all but two home starts: on June 16 against the A's (2.1 IP) and on April 10 vs. Los Angeles-NL (4.2 IP).

 ♣ In his career, Paddack is 16-11 in 40 starts (42 games) with a 4.24 ERA (208.0 IP, 98 ER), 216
 - strikeouts and 42 walks at home

PLATOON SPLITS: In his two starts this season, left-handed hitters are batting .429 (3-for-7) with one home run, one walk and one strikeout against Paddack, while righties are batting .385 (10-for-26) with two homers, five walks and three strikeouts...since the start of 2024, lefites are slashing .308/.351/.470 with eight home runs, 13 walks and 33 strikeouts, while righties are slashing .279/.323/.462 with nine home runs, 14 walks and 50 strikeouts.

◆ In a Twins uniform, Paddack has allowed a .277 BAA with 17 walks and 67 strikeouts against

- righties and a .308 BAA with 13 walks and 44 strikeouts against lefties.

 When facing the American League Central, Paddack has allowed a .238 BAA with three homers, seven walks and 21 strikeouts to righties, compared to a .206 BAA with four homers, two walks and 14 strikeouts to lefties.

THE ARSENAL: So far in 2025, Paddack has a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here are his pitch repertoire and results:

- With 157 pitches thrown this season, Paddack has a 66.5% 1st pitch strike rate, an 18.9% whiff rate and a 31.8% chase rate...his average exit velocty is 87.2 mph with a 38.7% hard hit rate...his 9.8% strikeout rate ranks in the bottom 6% of MLB.
- ₱ Through his first two starts of 2024, Paddack allowed a .343 (12-for-35) BAA with a 5% home run rate, a 10% walk rate, and a 18% strikeout rate...his average exit velocity was 83.8 mph with a 34% hard hit rate.

 Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
 In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
 Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
