HOW DO YOU LIKE THEM APPLES: The Twins beat the Mets last night at Target Field by a score of 6-3, earning their first victory against an NL opponent this season (1-4)...Bailey Ober (1-1) was the starter and winner, allowing three runs on five hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Cole Sands (0.2), Griffin Jax (1.0) and Jhoan Duran (1.0) combined for 2.2 innings of relief as Duran earned the first save for a Twin this season...the oftense recorded 13 hits, three from both Ryan Jeffers and Harrison Bader...Brooks Lee hit his first home run of the season...Minnesota set season-highs in hits and total bases (18).

STARTER KIT: In their first 10 games of the season, the Twins starting staff went 1-5, 6.90 ERA (45.2 IP, 35 ER), with 17 walks, 42 strikeouts, a .314 opponent batting average and 11 home runs allowed...in their last eight starts, they have combined to go 3-1, 1.44 ERA (43.2 IP, 7 ER), with seven walks, 41 strikeouts, a .178 opponent batting average and three home runs allowed...below are the last eight starts:

SPRING RECAP: In four Grapefruit League appearances (3 starts), went 0-1 with a 11.91 ERA (11.1 IP, 15 ER) with two home runs, three walks, and 11 strikeouts...earned his lone loss in his most recent outing on March 14 against Baltimore...allowed six runs on seven hits, walking three and striking out two over 3.1 innings...surrendered two-run home runs to Ryan Mountcastle and Adley Rutschman.

LAST TIME OUT: Faced Detroit at Target Field on April 11, his first major league start of the season...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 loss...allowed one unearned run on three hits over 4.2 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...with two outs in the fifth inning, Gleyber Torres singled and Matt Wallner's errant throw from right field allowed Dillon Dingler to score.

◆ Marked his first major league outing without an earned run allowed since August 5, 2024 at Chicago-NL...also, marked his 11th straight professional start with four-or-more strikeouts.

2024 RECAP: Began 2024 with Triple-A St. Paul, making 14 starts prior to his late-June call up to the Twins and one additional start on July 12...overall, went 3-3 with a 4.03 ERA (60.1 IP, 27 ER), 26 walks and 89 strikeouts...made his major league debut on June 27, earning the win in Arizona after allowing five runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings with one homer, one walk, and two strikeouts...started again on July 3 and made a long-relief outing on July 24 before officially joining the Twins' rotation on July 30; was part of a three pitcher rookie group with Simeon Woods Richardson and Zebby Matthews that was relied heavily upon in a playoff push while Joe Ryan and Chris Paddack were injured...at the major league level, went 2-6 with a 4.90 ERA (64.1 IP, 35 ER), 23 walks and 77 strikeouts; Twins were 5-8 in Festa's starts.

METROPOLITAN MATCHUP: The Verona, New Jersey native is facing the Mets for the second time in his career...previous start came on July 30, 2024 in New York with a crowd of family and friends in attendance...took the loss as the Twins were shut out, 2-0, by New York's Sean Manaea...allowed two runs on three hits (1 HR) over 5.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts.

The Mark Vientos's leadoff home run in the fifth inning marked Festa's fourth consecutive outing with a home run allowed...was the first Twin to surrender a home run in the first four games of their career since Kevin Slowey did so in his first eight games (6/1/2004-9/4).

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his eight starts (9 appearances) at Target Field since his MLB debut, Festa is 0-4 with a 5.31 ERA (39.0 IP, 23 ER), 16 walks and 45 strikeouts...on the road last year, he went 2-2 in six starts with a 3.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 12 ER), eight walks and 36 strikeouts...seven of his nine major league home runs allowed have come at Target Field; has not allowed one since September 9 vs. Los Angeles-AL.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: In 15 MLB games vs. Festa since his debut in 2024, left-handed hitters have hit .217 C28-for-129) with a 380 slugging percentage, 678 OPS, four home runs, 13 walks and 40 strikeouts, while righties have hit .266 (37-for-139) with a .453 SLG, .776 OPS, five home runs, 11 walks and 41 strikeouts.

◆ Whiff rate: 30.9 percent vs. lefties, 26.5 percent vs. righties.

◆ Hard-hit rate vs. Festa: 30.3 percent by lefties, 46.9 percent by righties.

◆ Average exit velocity vs. Festa: 86.0 mph by lefties, 92.2 mph by righties.

2025 MLB HIGHS
