**THE TWINS:** Have gone 1-4 through five games on their current six-game roadtrip, getting swept in three games in St. Louis, followed by a split of the first two games in Chicago... today, Minnesota will complete the trip with the three-game series finale on the Southside against the White Sox...following today's game, the Twins will travel home to open their 16th season at Target Field with three games in four days against the Astros, beginning with the Home Opener tomorrow afternoon, followed by an off-day on Friday, then games two and three on Saturday and Sunday.

PATIENCE PAYS OFF FOR TWINS: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Rate Field by a score of 8-3, recording their first win of 2025...it marked their first win since September 25, 2024 vs. Miami and their first win on the road since September 20, 2024 at Boston...Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on five hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...Minnesota scored five runs in the sixth inning on four hits and two walks — all four hits averaged an exit velocity of 84.3 mph...the offense recorded 10 hits, two apiece from Ryan Jeffers and Ty France... Harrison Bader added a three-run homer for insurance in the ninth inning, his team-leading second of the season.

DEEP DISH: The Twins are playing the White Sox today for the third of 13 scheduled games in 2025...these two will meet next for a three-game series at Target Field from April 22-24... the next time the Twins will play at Rate Field will be for three games from August 22-24. 

➡ Minnesota has gone 20-3 in its last 23 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023. 

➡ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 100-71 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span. 

➡ Since 2019, no opponent has hit more home runs at Rate Field than the Twins, hitting 89 home runs (next: Kansas City with 55 and Cleveland with 53)...in that same span, no team has hit more homers against the Sox overall (home or away) than the Twins with 146 (next is KC with 105). 

➡ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .375 (24-for-64) with a 1.047 OPS in 20 games vs. the White Sox. 

➡ In his last 13 games against the White Sox, Willi Castro is hitting .327 (17-for-52) with three doubles, two triples, two home runs, 13 RBI, a .577 slugging percentage and a .952 OPS. 

➡ In his last 10 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (11-for-33) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, eight walks, a .463 on-base percentage and a .1.039 OPS. 

➡ Matt Wallner is hitting .344 (22-for-64) with five doubles, one triple, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .494 on-base percentage and a .1.088 OPS in 23 career games against the White Sox... in 12 career games at Rate Field, he is slashing .441/.548/.706 (1.254 OPS), hitting safely in 10 of those 12.

BUX AND THE SOX: Byron Buxton is hitting .287 (86-for-300) with 27 doubles, one triple, 21 home runs, 49 RBI, 63 runs scored and a .945 OPS in 89 career games vs. the White Sox... below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 41 (June 30, 2019-present):

.291 .416 1.170 .345 36 49 14 1/ 28 15 39 .754 ALSO: Buxton's 21 career home runs and 49 RBI against the Sox are his most against any opponent.

MAJORITY RULES: Twins are seeking their first series win this afternoon...they went 26-22-4 in series play last season, going 14-11-1 at home and 12-11-3 on the road...their last series win came September 9-11, 2024, taking two of three at home against the Angels...their last series win on the road came August 15-18, 2024, taking three of four at Texas.

♣ Dating back to July of 2023, the Twins have gone 6-0-0 in series play against the White Sox... their last series loss to the Sox came May 2-4, 2023 at Rate Field, dropping two of three.

**DON'T STOP RELIEVIN':** Of the 31 runs allowed by the Twins staff this season, relievers have allowed just seven of those runs, while starters have allowed 24...Twins relievers rank 10th in baseball in opponent batting average (.195) and 11th in ERA (3.00).
