THE TWINS: After completing their six-game homestand with a record of 3-3 (1-2 vs. Detroit and 2-1 vs. New York-NL), the Twins began their three-game roadtrip/series against the Braves with consecutive losses the last two nights...today, they will play the three-game series finale at Truist Park...after today's game, the Twins will travel home to enjoy an off-day tomorrow, before beginning a six-game homestand with three against the White Sox (April 22-24) and three against the Angels (April 25-27).

◆ Twins have gone 2-6 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis from March 27-30, 2-1 vs. New York-NL from April 14-16 and 0-2 at Atlanta...Minnesota is just 4-14 against the NL since August 25, 2024.

TWINS CAN'T TAKE ADVANTAGE OF SALE: The Twins lost to the Braves last night at Truist Park by a score of 4-3, making them 1-4 in one-run games this season...Justin Topa was the Opener, allowing one run on three hits in 1.0 inning...Simeon Woods Richardson relieved Topa, allowing three runs on seven hits (1 HR - Harris II) in 4.1 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts...the offense recorded seven hits and were led by Byron Buxton, who went 3-for-4 with a triple and an RBI...Carlos Correa hit his first home run of the season, an opposite field solo shot in the fourth inning.

TWINS-BRAVES: The Twins and Braves are playing each other in the regular season for the 26th, 27th and 28th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 8-19 all-time against the Braves in the regular season, going 6-11 in Minnesota (4-2 at the Metrodome, 2-9 at Target Field) and 2-8 in Georgia (2-3 at Turner Field and 0-5 at Truist Park).

♣ The Twins have dropped 10-straight against the Braves, dating back to August of 2019... their last win came on August 5, 2019, when Miguel Sanó hit a pinch-hit, 443-foot, two-run, walk-off home run to centerfield against Chris Martin, giving the Twins a 5-3 victory.

♣ It's tied for the Twins' longest active losing streak against any opponent, the other vs. Baltimore (dating back to July of 2023).

♣ Marks the second-longest losing streak to an NL opponent in Twins history with the only longer one being 11-straight against the Dodgers, from April 30, 2014-May 15, 2023.

BY-RUN: Byron Buxton has been on base 23 times this season and has scored 16 runs...he leads baseball in average spring speed at 30.2 mph, ahead of Bobby Witt Jr. (30.1 mph)...Buck enters today with five stolen bases (5 attempts) on the season...he stole seven all of 2024...he has 98 for his career, tied with Brian Dozier for eighth on the Twins all-time list (since 1961): **PLAYED**

BREAK THE BROOM: Minnesota is looking to avoid being swept today for the second time this season, the other was in three games at St. Louis to open 2025, from March 27-30...prior to that Cardinals sweep, the Twins' last sweep at the hands of an NL opponent was the Braves in three games, from August 26-28, 2024 at Target Field.

PABLO IN THE CORNFIELDS: Pablo López (right hamstring strain) made his first rehab start yesterday afternoon for Triple-A St. Paul at the lowa Cubs...he allowed one run on three hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with no walks and four strikeouts, throwing 63 pitches to 17 batters.

TWINS Milb WEEKLYS: The Twins have named Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Jason Doktorczyk and Double-A Wichita outfielder Kyler Fedko as Twins minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

Doktorczyk, 22, started for the Mighty Mussels on Friday vs. Bradenton, allowing three unearned runs on four hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and 10 strikeouts...the Long Beach, CA native was selected by the Twins in the ninth round of the 2024 MLB Draft out of the University of Nevada, Reno.

Fedko, 25, played in five games for the Wind Surge, hitting .333 (6-for-18) with two home runs, five RBI, four walks, a .455 on-base percentage and a 1.121 OPS...the Gibsonia, PA native was selected by the Twins in the 12th round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Connecticut.

LAST TIME OUT: Started on April 14 vs. New York-NL at Target Field opposite right-hander Clay Holmes... did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-1 loss, allowed one run on three hits over 5.0 innings, walking two and striking out eight...his one run allowed came on a Pete Alonso RBI single in the third inning...was his first outing of the year with 90+ pitches thrown (101) and his first outing allowing a walk since August 2, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL.

The Struck out the side in the second inning, the second time this season he's retired all three

batters in an inning via the strikeout; also did so in the first inning on April 3 vs. Houston.

TWO STARTS AGO: On April 9, earned the win at Kauffman Stadium, his first of the season and first on the road since May 21, 2024 at Nationals Park; Twins won 4-0 against right-hander Seth Lugo... Ryan pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing two hits with no walks and four strikeouts...lowered his career ERA at Kauffman Stadium to 0.90, the best mark among all MLB starters with 30-or-more innings pitched in the ballpark's history.

© Outing marked his 40th career quality start, leading active Twins (Pablo López trails Ryan with 39 career quality starts)...is just the fourth player in franchise history to pitch 40 quality starts in less than 500 career innings.

FACING ATLANTA: Is 0-1 in one career start against Atlanta, coming on June 27, 2023 at Truist Park... allowed six runs on nine hits (5 HR) in 3.0 innings, with no walks and five strikeouts...marked the shortest outing of his career; since then, the only time he's pitched less than 3.0 innings was on August 7, 2024 at Chicago-NL, his injury-shortened start (2.0 IP).

4 All five home runs he allowed were hit in the first and second innings, Ronald Acuña Jr. hit two of them, both solo shots...the others were hit by Austin Riley, Sean Murphy and Michael Harris II...five home runs tied a club record, previously done by Bert Blyleven (1986), Carlos Silva (2006) and Ryan himself (2022 against SD).

ON THE ROAD AGAIN: Is making his third road start of the season...earned the win in his last outing away from Target Field, the Twins' 4-0 victory at Kansas City on April 9...in his last five road starts dating back to July 12, 2024 at San Francisco, is 1-2 with a 3.20 ERA (25.1 IP, 9 ER), four walks, 25 strikeouts, a 0.83 WHIP and a .191 (17-for-89) BAA; Twins went 1-4 and were outscored 10-27... in his career, Ryan is 15-14 in 43 road starts with a 3.97 ERA (235.2 IP, 104 ER), 51 walks and 247 strikeouts; 20 of his 40 career quality starts have come on the road.

This 247 career strikeouts on the road rank 12th all-time among Twins pitchers (1961-present); Railey Oher ranks 11th with 251 strikeouts

Bailey Ober ranks 11th with 251 strikeouts.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .152/.176/.182 with no walks and six strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .222/.300/.400 with two home runs, two walks and 17 strikeouts...in 2024, left-handed hitters slashed .203/.243/.373 with nine home runs, 11 walks and 61 strikeouts in 255 plate appearances, while right-handed hitters slashed .229/.269/.425 with 10 home runs, 12 walks and 86 strikeouts in 283 plate appearances.

© Over his career, lefties are batting .204 (179-for-876) with a .620 OPS...righties are .238 (232-for-976) with a .732 OPS.
