THE TWINS: Are returning home after getting swept in three games at Atlanta over the weekend...tonight, they will begin a six-game homestand with the first of three against the White Sox...they will complete this series with Chicago on Thursday afternoon, then host the Angels for three games over the weekend.

◆ Iwins are looking to avoid losing their fourth-straight game, which would match their season-long, previously done to start the season (March 27-March 31 — 3 at STL, 1 at CWS).

BAD EGGS ON EASTER SUNDAY: The Twins lost to the Braves on Sunday afternoon at Truist Park by a score of 6-2...Joe Ryan (1-2) was the starter and dealt the loss, allowing six runs on eight hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and five strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, walked four times, went 0-for-7 with RISP and left nine men on base...Byron Buxton went 2-for-5 with a double and a home run...Minnesota suffered their second sweep of the season and fell to 3-10 on the road.

CAN LIGHTNING STRIKE TWICE: The Twins began their 2024 season with a record of 7-13 through games of April 21...on April 22, they began a four-game series at Target Field against the White Sox and swept...they went on to play the Angels in Anaheim that weekend for three games and swept again...then swept the White Sox again in three games at Chicago after that...this was part of a 12-game winning streak that jump-started the Twins to a record of 63-40 in their next 103 games - the most wins in baseball during that time (April 22-August 17).

4 During this stretch, specifically on April 25, the club — led by Kyle Farmer — debuted the Rally Sausage.

DEEP DISH: The Twins are playing the White Sox today for the fourth of 13 scheduled games in 2025... these two last met for three games at Rate Field from March 30-April 2 as the Twins took games two and three, including their first victory of 2025, an 8-3 win on April 1.

♣ Minnesofa has gone 21-3 in its last 24 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.
♣ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 101-71 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.
♣ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .375 (24-for-64) with a 1.047 OPS in 20 games vs. the White Sox.

♣ In his last 11 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .297 (11-for-37) with two doubles, two home runs, six RBI, eight walks, a .422 on-base percentage and a .936 OPS.
♣ Last series vs. Chicago: Ryan Jeffers went 3-for-7 with two walks...Ty France went 4-for-11 with a double and a walk...Byron Buxton went 3-for-9 with a double, a home run and a walk...Harrison Bader had two hits, both home runs (6 RBI).

BUX AND THE SOX: Byron Buxton is hitting .289 (88-for-304) with 28 doubles, one triple, 22 home runs, 51 RBI, 65 runs scored and a .958 OPS in 90 career games vs. the White Sox... below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 42 (June 30, 2019-present):

WE HAVE ENOUGH SOX AT HOME: Twins have won 12-straight at home against the White Sox, their longest streak against the Sox in Minnesota...it is fied for the second-longest Twins winning streak at home against a single opponent in their history (since 1961): 17 vs. Boston at Met Stadium from August 4, 1964-May 7, 1966; and 12 vs. Baltimore at Target Field from July 5, 2018-July 2, 2022...Minnesota's last loss at home vs. the Sox was April 10, 2023.

OPENING ACTS: Since April 8, Twins starters rank third in baseball in ERA, rank third in WHIP (0.97), and fifth in opponent batting average...below are starters numbers in their first 10 games (March 27-April 7), compared to their last 12 games (since April 8):

BUCK AROUND AND FIND OUT: Byron Buxton has multiple hits in five of his last seven games, hitting .367 (11-for-30) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, four RBI, a .700 slugging percentage and a 1.055 OPS in that span.

FEELING MINNESOTA: Twins are 4-5 at home this season and have gone 3-1 in their last four at Target Field...they won their last home series from April 14-16 vs. New York-NL, taking two of three.

◆Harrison Bader is 7-for-20 (.350) this season at Target Field.

THAT'S WHAT I'M TONKIN ABOUT: Right-handed pitcher Michael Tonkin (right shoulder strain) made his first appearance on rehab assignment on Friday vs. Bradenton, pitching 2.0 innings (24 pitches)...he made his second rehab appearance this afternoon for Triple-A St. Paul, allowing three runs on three hits in 1.0 inning, throwing 27 pitches.

GO SHORTY, IT'S YOUR EARTH DAY: Since opening Target Field in 2010, the Twins are the first and only MLB club to achieve five separate LEED certifications: LEED Silver for New Construction (in 2010, the second MLB team thus honored); LEED Silver for Existing Buildings: Operations & Maintenance (in 2011, making the Twins the first professional sports franchise to earn Silver for both construction and operations); LEED Gold for Existing Buildings: Operations & Maintenance (in 2017, becoming the first organization in pro sports to attain Gold in this category); LEED Gold recertification (in 2019); and LEED Platinum (in 2022, becoming the first MLB club to earn the U.S. Green Building Council's highest possible honor in the new LEED v4.1 rating system)...in 2024, the Twins were honored by GOAL (Green Operations & Advanced Leadership) with 29 "GOAL Medals" — more than any MLB club — in recognition of the organization's exceptional leadership, work and dedication to advancing environmental, social and governance (ESG) objectives.

The Twins are 22-24 all-time on Earth Day, since the holiday's inception in 1970.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In **1961**, the Twins won their first game in Minnesota at Metropolitan Stadium after moving from Washington, D.C...the score was 5-4 over the Washington Senators in 10 innings...they won on a Zoilo Versalles sac fly, scoring Earl Battey...in **1985**, Kirby Puckett hit the first of 207 career home runs, a three-run shot off Seattle's Matt Young.

SOMEWHERE OBER THE RAINBOW: Last pitched on April 15 at Target Field vs. the Mets, opposite Tyler Megill...snagged his first win of the season in Minnesota's 6-1 victory..allowed three runs (3 ER) on five hits (2 HR) in 6.1 quality innings, with no walks and five strikeouts...allowed no walks for the first time this season...recorded his most innings pitched and most strikes thrown so far this season.

- ◆ Snapped a five-game losing streak (over 10 starts) from August 26, 2024 March 30, 2025, the longest losing streak of his career.
- ₱ Recorded back-to-back quality starts for the first time since September 1-7. 2024
- Fanning Brandon Nimmo in the fourth inning, Ober marked his 500th career strikeout...he is the third pitcher in Twins history to achieve 500 strikeouts in his first 92 games, alongside Bert Blyleven (89 games) and José Berrios (91 games).

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on April 10 at Kauffman Stadium vs. the Royals...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-3 defeat...allowed one run on five hits in 6.0 quality innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...Twins led Kansas City 2-1 when Ober exited the game, but the Royals scored twice against the bullpen in the seventh.

This lone run allowed came on a single to leftfield from Salvador Perez, scoring Bobby Witt Jr.; this was Ober's first time allowing a run during the first inning so far this seasor

VS. THE SOUTHSIDERS: In 13 career starts (his most against any opponent) vs. the White Sox, Ober has a 3.60 ERA (70.0 IP, 28 ER), with 13 walks and 72 strikeouts...also has a .205 (53-for-259)

- ₱ Went 2-1 in three starts against the Sox in 2024, posted a 4.26 ERA (19.0 IP, 9 ER), with three
- of the Twins' 5-4 victory...allowed four runs off five hits (2 HR) in 4.0 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts

NIGHTMARES: Went 4-6 in night games during the 2024 season, with a 4.78 ERA (96.0 IP, 51 ER), a .288 (51-for-354) opponent batting average and a .704 opponent OPS in 17 starts; compared to 8-3, with a 3.05 ERA (82.2 IP, 28 ER), a .193 (30-for-301) BAA and a .590 opponent OPS in 14 day game starts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In four seasons with the Twins, Ober has gone 15-9 with a 3.84 ERA (241.2 IP, 103 ER), 9.31 K/9, 2.20 BB/9 and 1.60 HR/9 in 46 starts at home compared to 11-13 with a 3.87

- ERA (248.2 IP, 107 ER), 9.08 K/9, 1.77 BB/9 and 1.27 HR/9 in 46 road starts.

 © Ober is 1-3 in his last five starts at home, posting a 5.33 ERA (27.0 IP, 16 ER) with six walks and 27 strikeouts, allowing 16 runs off 27 hits (6 HR); compared to 3-1, 4.50 ERA (28.0 IP, 14 ER), with 10 walks and 30 strikeouts, allowing 14 runs off 16 hits (5 HR) in the previous
 - ◆Ober is 5-1 when facing AL Central opponents at home, posting a 2.25 ERA (60.0 IP, 15 ER), with 11 walks and 65 strikeouts...allowing a .188 (41-for-218) opponent batting average

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through four starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .286/.375/.536 in 28 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .260/.302/.520 in 50 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 92.2 mph and a hard-hit percentage of 40.9 compared to righties' 92.5 mph and 64.1 percent.

₱ Has a whiff rate of 21.1 percent and put-away percentage of 18.2 against lefties vs. 26.9 percent and 16.7 percent vs. righties

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 38% of the time...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curvehall against left-handed hatters here is a look at his nitch breakdown

- The currently ranks fifth in baseball for extension, behind Tyler Glasnow, Alexis Díaz, Logan Gilbert and Jordan Romano
- ₱He ranks seventh to last in baseball for exit velocity, with an average of 94.5, and the bottom three percent for hard hit percentage, with an average of 55.7.

 His changeup strikeout percentage is at a career high of 45 percent.

UNDER PRESSURE: This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .313 (5-for-16), with two home runs, two walks and five strikeouts; with runners in scoring position and two outs, opponents are 0-for-6 with two walks and two strikeouts.

FIXING THE FASTBALL: Through 2024, opponents were steadily hitting Ober's 4-seam fastball harder and more often than in previous seasons...through four starts this season, opponents continue to have a higher hard hit percentage, but Ober has substantially lowered opponent batting average and slugging percentage...here are some of his fastball numbers since his 2021 debut:

- In 2025, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the second consecutive year and
- In 2024, pitched first career complete game on June 22 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, with two walks and 10 strikeouts...threw just 89 pitches, becoming the first pitcher with a nine-inning CG and 10+ strikeouts on fewer than 90 pitches since David Cone.
- Struck out career-high 12 batters on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland (7.0 IP), fourth time on season and fifth time in career with double-digit strikeout totals.
- Set career highs in wins (12), starts (31), innings pitched (178.2) and strikeouts (191) in 2024.
- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4
- HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3. In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA
- (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks. 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.

 In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL. Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
