BUCK LEAVES THE PLANET ON EARTH DAY: The Twins beat the White Sox last night at Target Field by a score of 4-2, snapping their three-game losing streak...Byron Buxton made a leaping game-ending catch at the centerfield warning track on a ball hit off the bat of Andrew Benintendi — with two men in scoring position..Buck covered 78 feet on 76 feet needed, registered a sprint speed of 28.4 mph, while the ball had a catch probability of 50%...Bailey Ober (2-1) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on eight hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, highlighted by a Trevor Larnach two-run insurance homer in the eighth inning...Luke Keaschall reached three times, going 1-for-2 with two walks and two runs scored.

WEARING OUT THE SOX: The Twins are playing the White Sox today for the fifth of 13 scheduled games in 2025...after dropping their first meeting on March 31 at Rate Field, the Twins have won three-straight over Chicago, outscoring the Sox 18-6 over those three.

♣ Minnesota has gone 22-3 in its last 25 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

♣ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 102-71 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

♣ Since the start of 2023, Ryan Jeffers is hitting .368 (25-for-68) with a 1.017 OPS in 21 games vs. the White Sox...he has reached safely in 17-straight starts against CWS.

♣ In his last 12 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .300 (12-for-40) with two doubles, three home runs, eight RBI, nine walks, a .429 on-base percentage and a 1.004 OPS.

BUX AND THE SOX: Byron Buxton is hitting .286 (88-for-308) with 28 doubles, one triple, 22 home runs, 51 RBI, 65 runs scored and a .946 OPS in 91 career games vs. the White Sox... below are his first 48 career games vs. the Sox (June 22, 2015-June 29, 2019), compared to his last 43 (June 30, 2019-present): RBI AVG R Н 2B HR BB OBP OPS

WE HAVE ENOUGH SOX AT HOME: Twins have won 13-straight at home against the White Sox, their longest streak against the Sox in Minnesota...it is the second-longest Twins winning streak at home against a single opponent in their history (since 1961), behind 17 vs. Boston at Met Stadium from August 4, 1964-May 7, 1966...Minnesota's last loss at home vs. the Sox was April 10, 2023.

KEA PLAYER: Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all four games played, going 5-for-14 (.357) with two doubles, two RBI, three runs, three walks and three stolen bases...he is the first player in club history to steal at least three bases in their first four career games.

■Last Twins rookie to hit safely in each of their first four games was Brooks Lee, who hit safely in six-straight to start his career, from July 3-8, 2024.

EIGHT POINT BUCK: Byron Buxton has multiple hits in five of his last eight games, hitting .324 (11-for-34) with two doubles, one triple, two home runs, four RBI, two stolen bases, a .618 slugging percentage and a .932 OPS in that span.

◆ Buck ranks in the 94th percentile in baseball in hard hit percentage (56.4%), the 89th percentile in bat speed (74.8) and 86th percentile in barrel percentage (16.4%).

◆ He has a 8.3% increase in his hard hit percentage from 2024 to 2025, improving from 48.1% to 56.4%...17th-best increase in the American League.

TWINS GO FOR THE MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): Twins are seeking their third series win tonight...they are 2-5-0 in series play...their two series wins this season came March 31-April 2, taking two of three at Chicago-AL, and April 14-16, taking two of three vs. New York-NL.

Minnesota did not win their second series of 2024 until sweeping the White Sox in four games from April 22-25...they entered that series 1-4-2 in series play.

THIS AND THAT:

**Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in a season-long seven-straight games (career-high is 13, 7/6-26/24)...during the streak he has posted a .370 on-base percentage (5 hits, 4 walks), a .500 slugging percentage and an .870 OPS.

**Twins have homered in a season-long four-straight games...homers hit by (in order) Larnach, Correa, Buxton, Larnach.

**Twins are 8-3 when scoring at least four runs and 0-12 when scoring under four runs.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1980, Angels pitcher Bruce Kison settled for a one-hitter when Minnesota's Ken Landreaux hit a ninth-inning double in a California 17-0 win...for Landreaux, the hit marked the beginning of a 31-game hitting streak, the longest in Twins history.

LAST TIME OUT: Faced New York-NL at Target Field on April 16, his second major league start of the season...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 4-3 10-inning walk-off victory against opener Huascar Brazobán and bulk reliever Justin Hagenman...in 4.1 scoreless innings, allowed five hits with one walk and six strikeouts...exited the game in the fifth after surrendering back-to-back leadoff singles and plunking Francisco Lindor with one out; reliever Danny Coulombe induced a ground ball double play

to end the inning.

• Six strikeouts were Festa's most since September 20, 2024 at Boston (6)...marked his 11th career major league start with five-or-more strikeouts.

TWO STARTS AGO: Started against Detroit at Target Field on April 11, his first major league start of the season, opposite Reese Olson...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 loss...allowed one unearned run on three hits over 4.2 innings, with one walk and four strikeouts...with two outs in the fifth inning, Gleyber Torres singled and Matt Wallner's errant throw from right field allowed Dillon Dingler to score.

© Marked his first major league outing without an earned run allowed since August 5, 2024 at Chicago-NL...also, marked his 11th straight professional start with four-or-more strikeouts.

2024 RECAP: Began 2024 with Triple-A St. Paul, making 14 starts prior to his late-June call up to the Twins and one additional start on July 12...overall, went 3-3 with a 4.03 ERA (60.1 IP, 27 ER), 26 walks and 89 strikeouts...made his major league debut on June 27, earning the win in Arizona after allowing five runs on seven hits in 5.0 innings with one homer, one walk, and two strikeouts...started again on July 3 and made a long-relief outing on July 24 before officially joining the Twins' rotation on July 30; was part of a three pitcher rookie group with Simeon Woods Richardson and Zebby Matthews that was relied heavily upon in while Joe Ryan and Chris Paddack were injured...at the major league level, went 2-6 with a 4.90 ERA (64.1 IP, 35 ER), 23 walks and 77 strikeouts; Twins were 5-8 in Festa's starts

FACING CHICAGO-AL: Is facing the White Sox for the first time in his career...since his debut in 2024, has made three starts against American League Central opponents - so far, the Tigers and the Guardians - all at Target Field...is 0-1 with a 5.54 ERA (13.0 IP, 8 ER), four home runs, four walks and 13 strikeouts; Twins are 0-3.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In his nine starts (10 appearances) at home since his MLB debut, Festa is 0-4 with 4.78 ERA (43.1 IP, 23 ER), 17 walks and 51 strikeouts…on the road, he is 2-2 in six starts with a 3.60 ERA (30.0 IP, 12 ER), eight walks and 36 strikeouts.

◆ In his last five home starts dating back to September 9, 2024 vs. Los-Angeles-AL, is 0-1 with a 3.86
