THE TWINS: After getting swept in three games at Truist Park by the Braves last weekend, the Twins returned home and began their six-game homestand with consecutive wins over the White Sox the last two nights...today, they will play the three-game series finale against the Sox...tomorrow night, the Twins will welcome the Angels for a three-game series over the weekend. ✦ Twins are 6-5 at home this season and have gone 5-1 in their last six at Target Field. ✦ Due to NBA playoff scheduling conflicts (Wolves vs. Lakers at Target Center), Friday night's game against the Angels has been moved from 7:10 to 6:40 pm and Sunday afternoon's game has been moved from 1:10 to 12:40 pm.

TWINS CLOG UP BASES AND EVENTUALLY FLUSH THROUGH: The Twins beat the White Sox last night by a score of 6-3 at Target Field, winning their third series of the season and second over the White Sox...David Festa was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing two runs on four hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, walked six times, struck out just seven times, went 4-for-15 with RISP and left 13 men on base...Ryan Jeffers tied his career-high with three hits, including his fifth double of the season...Byron Buxton homered for the second time in three games and Trevor Larnach homered for the third time in his last five games.

ROSTER MOVES: The Twins have placed utility player Willi Castro on the 10-day Injured List with a right oblique strain...Castro was removed from Minnesota's game on April 16 vs. New York-NL in the eighth inning with the injury...Castro, who turns 28-years-old today, has hit .227 (15-for-66) with six doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks, seven runs scored and a .655 OPS in 18 games for the Twins this season.

✦ To replace Castro on the 26-man roster, the Twins have recalled utility player Mickey Gasper from the Saints...Gasper, who was optioned to St. Paul on April 18 after making the Twins' Opening Day roster, played in four games for the Saints, hitting .333 (4-for-12) with one double, two home runs, three RBI, three walks, one stolen base and five runs scored.

✦ Additionally, the Twins have optioned right-handed pitcher David Festa to Triple-A St. Paul...Minnesota plans to play today's game against the White Sox with 25 men on roster and make a corresponding 26-man roster move prior to tomorrow night's game against the Angels.

WEARING OUT THE SOX: The Twins are playing the White Sox today for the sixth of 13 scheduled games in 2025...after dropping their first meeting on March 31 at Rate Field, the Twins have won four-straight over Chicago, outscoring the Sox 24-9 over those four.

✦ These two will meet next for three games at Rate Field from August 22-24.

✦ Minnesota has gone 23-3 in its last 26 against the White Sox, dating back to May 4, 2023.

✦ Since 2015, the Twins have gone 103-71 against the Sox, their most wins against any opponent in that span.

✦ In his last 13 games against the Sox, Trevor Larnach is hitting .326 (14-for-43) with two doubles, four home runs, 10 RBI, 10 walks, a .453 on-base percentage and a 1.104 OPS.

✦ Minnesota faced Shane Smith in his major league debut on April 1 at Rate Field, handing him a loss...the Twins scored five runs in the sixth - two off Smith and three off Penn Murfee...Ty France and Trevor Larnach had the only hits for the Twins off Smith - both singles.

SOCK DRAWERS: Twins have won 14-straight at home against the White Sox, their longest streak against the Sox in Minnesota...it is the second-longest Twins winning streak at home against a single opponent in their history (since 1961), behind 17 vs. Boston at Met Stadium from August 4, 1964-May 7, 1966...Minnesota's last loss at home vs. the Sox was April 10, 2023.

LUKE WHAT WE HAVE HERE: Luke Keaschall has hit safely in all five games played, going 6-for-17 (.353) with three doubles, two RBI, four runs, four walks and five stolen bases...Keaschall's five steals are tied for most by a player in their first five games in AL/NL history, matching Luis Castillo (1996), Ced Landrum (1991), Donell Nixon (1987) and Vince Coleman (1985). ✦ Last Twins rookie to hit safely in each of their first five games was Brooks Lee, who hit safely in six-straight to start his career from July 3-8, 2024...the club record for a rookie is 23, held by Kent Hrbek from April 17-May 13, 1982.

STARTING POINTS: Since April 8, Twins starters rank second in baseball in ERA (2.35) and WHIP (1.02)...below are starters numbers in their first 10 games (March 27-April 7), compared to their last 14 games (since April 8):

SWEEPING SUCCESS: Minnesota is seeking its first sweep of the season today and first since August 2-4, 2024, when they took all three from the White Sox at Target Field...Twins recorded five sweeps all of 2024.

✦ Since the start of 2023, the Twins and White Sox have played nine series' with the Twins sweeping four of them.

✦ Since 2014, the Twins have swept the White Sox 12 times (62 series), their most of any opponent (next: Royals 11 times and Tigers - 8 times).

POWER SURGE: The Twins have homered in a season-long five-straight games...during the streak, the homers were hit by Trevor Larnach (3x), Byron Buxton (2x) and Carlos Correa...the club's all-time record for games with a home run is 28, done last season from June 10-July 10...additionally, the Twins have homered 13 times in their last 13 games after homering just six times in their first 11 games.

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in a season-long eight-straight games (career-high is 13, 7/6-26/24)...during the streak he has posted a .419 on-base percentage (7 hits, 5 walks), a .640 slugging percentage and a 1.059 OPS.

✦ During this stretch he has posted a 92.1 average exit velocity (89.4 MLB average).

HBD WILLI!: Twins utility player Willi Castro is celebrating his 28th birthday today.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1996, Greg Myers and Paul Molitor each recorded five RBI as the Twins set a team record for runs and beat the Detroit Tigers, 24-11.

LAST TIME OUT: Faced the Braves in Atlanta on April 18 opposite right-hander Bryce Elder...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-4 loss, allowed one run on three hits, including a solo home run by Jared Kelenic in the fifth inning, with one walk and six strikeouts...Twins led the Braves 4-1 when Paddack exited the game; Minnesota's bullpen allowed five one-out runs in the bottom of the eighth inning...Twins are 0-4 in Paddack's starts this season.

⌘ Marked second time this season the Twins have blown a lead that they held when Paddack left the game; also, April 6 vs. Houston...prior to this season, the Twins had never lost a game in which they led their opponent at the time of Paddack's exit.

⌘ Marked just the second time since joining the Twins that Paddack's lone run allowed came via a solo home run; also did so on May 8, 2024 vs. Seattle.

TWO STARTS AGO: Took the loss, his second of the season, on April 12 vs. Detroit at Target Field in a Twins 4-0 defeat...allowed two runs (one earned) on two hits over 5.0 innings, walked two and struck out five...retired nine-straight batters beginning with Spencer Torkelson's sacrifice fly in the first inning through the third inning...errant throw by Carlos Correa in the first allowed Zach McKinstry to advance to third and score on the sac fly...93 pitches thrown were Paddack's most since June 10, 2024 vs. Colorado (93).

⌘ Twins were shut out by rookie Jackson Jobe and the Detroit bullpen, their second scoreless game of the season; Paddack started the first game as well, a 9-0 Minnesota loss at Chicago-AL on March 31...other Paddack starts where Twins were shut out include April 13, 2022 vs. Los Angeles-NL (7-0 loss) and April 20, 2022 at Kansas City (2-0 loss).

FACING CHICAGO-AL: Is making his fourth career start against the White Sox and his second of the season...is 1-1 with a 6.46 ERA (15.1 IP, 11 ER), four home runs, six walks and 15 strikeouts...faced the South Siders in his first start of the season on March 31 at Rate Field; took the loss, allowing nine runs on six hits (3 HR) over 3.1 innings, with four walks and two strikeouts...has not started against the White Sox at Target Field since April 22, 2024; earned the win, pitching 7.0 scoreless innings with six hits, no walks and 10 strikeouts.

FIND YOUR CENTER: In his career, Paddack is 1-3 with a 4.23 ERA (44.2 IP, 21 ER) over eight starts against the American League Central; Twins are 4-4...his 3.64 strikeouts-per-walk ratio ranks seventh among the 10 Twins pitchers with eight-or-more divisional starts, while his 1.03 WHIP and .216 BAA trail only Joe Ryan (0.88 WHIP and .193 BAA).

⌘ Over his last five starts against the AL Central, dating back to May 19, 2024 at Cleveland, Paddack is 0-2 with a 6.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 18 ER), 10 walks and 20 strikeouts...AL Central batters are batting .198 (19-for-96) with 16 of their 19 total runs scoring via RBI extra-base hits - the remaining three scored via sacrifice flies...of Paddack's seven home runs allowed in that span, five were multi-run homers.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In previous two starts at Target Field this season, is 0-1 with a 4.00 ERA (9.0 IP, 4 ER), four walks and seven strikeouts, compared to 0-1 with a 10.80 ERA (8.1 IP, 10 ER), five walks and eight strikeouts in two road starts...since joining the Twins, has gone 4-3 with a 4.22 ERA (70.1 IP, 33 ER), nine home runs and 4.80 strikeouts-per-walk in 16 appearances (14 starts) at Target Field...in his career, is 16-12 with a 4.23 ERA (217.0 IP, 102 ER) in 45 home appearances (42 starts).

⌘ Since the start of 2024, is 1-1 with a 2.55 ERA (17.2 IP, 5 ER), a 0.96 WHIP and 4.75 strikeouts-per-walk in his three outings against American League Central teams at Target Field.

AIN'T NO SUNSHINE: Since joining Minnesota, Paddack is 0-3 with a 5.65 ERA (51.0 IP, 32 ER) in 11 day starts; Twins are 6-6...of the eight Twins pitchers with 11-or-more daytime starts in that span (2022-), Paddack's ERA is the highest...his 9.71 hits-per-nine innings trails only Kenta Maeda (10.13 H/9 in 11 starts) while his 2.80 strikeouts-per-walk ratio leads only Chris Archer (1.43 K/BB in 11 starts).

⌘ Three of his four starts this season have come in day games (all but his last start)...in his last five daytime starts, dating back to May 30, 2024 vs. Kansas City, Paddack is 0-2 with a 7.04 ERA (23.0 IP, 18 ER) and a 1.73 strikeouts-per-walk ratio; Twins are 1-4.

⌘ In 15 night starts since 2022, Paddack is 6-4 with a 4.79 ERA (77.0 IP, 41 ER), nine home runs, 17 walks and 72 strikeouts...holds a 1.39 WHIP and is averaging 10.52 hits-per-nine innings; Twins are 9-6.

PLATOON SPLITS: So far this season, left-handed hitters are batting .231 (6-for-26) with two home runs, four walks and five strikeouts against Paddack, while righties are batting .293 (12-for-41) with two home runs, five walks and 10 strikeouts...since the start of 2024, lefties are slashing .294/.344/.456 with nine home runs and 2.31 strikeouts-per-walk against Paddack, while righties are slashing .269/.308/.439 with nine home runs and 4.07 strikeouts-per-walk.

⌘ In a Twins uniform, Paddack has allowed a .296 BAA with 16 walks and 48 strikeouts against lefties and a .270 BAA with 17 walks and 74 strikeouts against righties.

⌘ In eight career games facing the American League Central, Paddack has allowed a .194 BAA with four homers, four walks and 16 strikeouts to lefties, compared to a .233 BAA with three homers, seven walks and 24 strikeouts to righties.

THE ARSENAL: So far in 2025, Paddack has a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

⌘ With 338 pitches thrown this season, Paddack has a 61.3 percent first pitch strike rate, a 20.0 percent whiff rate and a 30.3 percent chase rate...his average exit velocity is 89.4 mph with a 42.9 percent hard hit rate...he is striking out batters 19.2 percent of the time and walking them 11.5 percent of the time.

⌘ Excluding this season, Paddack's strikeout rate over March and April starts has dropped below 20 percent only in 2024 (17.4) while his walk rate has never been above 7.4 percent (2019)...his highest average pitch velocity in the first two months of the season came in 2021 (90.5 mph) while his highest average exit velocity and hard hit rate both came in 2024 (89.6 mph and 39.8%, respectively).

CAREER NOTES

• 2025 marks his ninth professional season and fourth with the Twins...is seeking his first unabridged major league season since his rookie year in 2019.

• Finished 2024 season on 15-day IL with a right shoulder strain, retroactive July 20.

• Pitched a career-high 8.0 inning game on May 19, 2024 at Cleveland...previous high of 7.2 innings, May 6, 2019 and July 17, 2019 with San Diego.

• Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.

• In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.

• Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.

• In 2022, made Minnesota's Opening Day rotation after being acquired from San Diego in April 7 trade...went 1-2 with 4.03 ERA in five starts before suffering right elbow injury and undergoing Tommy John surgery.

• In 2021, his third big league season, went 7-7 with 5.07 ERA...oblique and elbow injuries limited him to 108.1 innings...walk rate of 4.8% ranked in MLB's 95th percentile.
