AGAINST THE ANGELS: Has never faced the Angels...Los Angeles-AL is one of nine teams (other than the Twins) Woods Richardson has yet to face in his career.

∉ He is 1-0 in five career starts against American League West opponents, posting a 3.91 ERA (25.1 IP, 11 ER), with 11 walks and 23 strikeouts, allowing 11 runs on 14 hits (4 HR).

BETTER AHEAD: SWR historically pitches better when he is ahead in the count...in his career, he has 79 strikeouts and allowed a .194 opponent batting average, .307 slugging percentage and .500 OPS when he is ahead, vs. 31 strikeouts and allowed a .331 opponent batting average, .537 slugging percentage and 1.033 OPS when he is behind.

MAKE MY DAY: In 34 career day games, Woods Richardson has posted a 3.73 ERA and allowed a .249 opponent batting average, .397 slugging percentage, with 25 walks, 77 strikeouts and 10 home runs; compared to a 5.01 ERA, .263 opponent batting average, .416 slugging percentage with 34 walks, 67 strikeouts and 11 home runs during night games.
