**THE TWINS:** Have gone 3-1 through four games on their six-game homestand, going 2-1 against Chicago-AL this week, followed by a victory over Los Angeles-AL last night...today, they will play the second of three against the Angels and wrap the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, Minnesota will travel to Cleveland to begin a seven-game roadtrip with four against the Guardians (April 28-May 1) and three against the Red Sox at Fenway (May 2-4).  
❖ Twins are 7-6 at home this season and have gone 6-2 in their last eight at Target Field.  
❖ Due to NBA playoff scheduling conflicts (Wolves vs. Lakers at Target Center), tomorrow afternoon's game will start at 12:40 pm, 30 minutes ahead of the original 1:10 time.

**TWINS BRING THEIR BATS TO PABLO DAY:** The Twins beat the Angels last night at Target Field by a score of 11-4, setting a season-high in runs scored...Pablo López (2-1) was the starter and winner in his return from the 15-day IL, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded eight hits and drew a season-high eight walks...Trevor Larnach led the offense by going 2-for-4 with four RBI and his fourth home run of the season...Byron Buxton also homered, fitting his team-leading sixth.

**CLEMENS TIME:** The Twins have acquired infielder Kody Clemens from the Phillies in exchange for cash considerations...Clemens, 28, was designated for release or assignment by the Phillies on April 23 and has gone 0-for-6 with one walk in seven games...the Houston, Texas native was originally selected by Detroit in the third round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of the University of Texas at Austin and has hit .197 (74-for-376) with 20 doubles, one triple, 14 home runs, 48 RBI, 22 walks, 45 runs scored and a .611 OPS in 153 career major league games for the Tigers (2022) and Phillies (2023-25).

❖ To make room for Clemens on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed infielder Luke Keaschall on the 10-day Injured List with a right forearm fracture...Keaschall, who made his major league debut on April 18 and sustained the injury last night after being hit by a pitch in the first inning, played in seven games for the Twins, hitting .368 (7-for-19) with three doubles, two RBI, five walks, four runs scored, a .538 on-base percentage and a 1.064 OPS.

**ANGEL OF THE MORNING:** The Twins and Angels are playing the second of six games in 2025...Minnesota has gone 6-1 in their last seven against Anaheim.

❖ Since the start of last season, the Twins are hitting .326 (79-for-242) with 8.7 runs-per-game and a .977 OPS in seven games with Anaheim.

❖ Ty France is hitting .286 (22-for-77) with 16 RBI and a .908 OPS in his last 22 games against the Angels...additionally, he has 36 career RBI against LAA, his most vs. any opponent.

❖ Carlos Correa has reached safely in each of his last 10 games against the Angels...he is hitting .303 (106-for-350) with 25 doubles, 17 home runs, 70 RBI, a .383 on-base percentage, a .520 slugging percentage and a .903 OPS in 95 career games against the Angels...the 70 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 17 home runs are his second most (Texas - 21)...additionally, his 70 RBI are fifth most among actives.

❖ Trevor Larnach has reached base safely 14 times in his last 22 plate appearances against the Angels (.636 OBP, 8 hits, 6 walks).

**THE LEFTORIUM:** The Twins are hitting .157 (26-for-166) with 11 doubles and three home runs (.511 OPS) against left-handed pitching this season, compared to .234 (158-for-675) with 34 doubles and 18 home runs (.691 OPS) against right-handed pitching.

❖ In their last three games, Twins are slashing .282/.364/.564 against lefties.

❖ Minnesota's .422 slugging percentage vs. lefties last season ranked fourth in the AL and ninth in baseball...their .732 OPS ranked fourth in the AL and 10th in baseball.

❖ Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (4-for-13) with one triple, one home run, a .692 slugging percentage and a 1.000 OPS against lefties this season...he is 4-for-5 in his last two games vs. lefties.

❖ Carlos Correa is hitting .300 (3-for-10) with two doubles, one home run and an .800 slugging percentage against lefties...he is 3-for-7 (.429) with three extra-base hits in his last four games vs. lefties.

❖ Correa is 10-for-22 (.455) with two doubles, one triple and two walks lifetime against Kikuchi in the regular season...Correa recorded an RBI-single with the bases loaded in Game 2 of the 2023 ALWCS off Kikuchi (with the Blue Jays).

**MOM! THE MEATLOAF!:** Twins are seeking their fourth series win today...they are 3-5-0 in series play...their three series wins were: March 31-April 2 (2 of 3 at CWS), April 14-16 (2 of 3 vs. NYM) and April 22-24 (2 of 3 vs. CWS).

❖ Minnesota's last series win over the Angels came September 9-11, 2024, taking two of three...was also their final series win of last season...they are looking for their fourth-straight series win over Anaheim, dating back to September of 2023.

**11 POINT BUCK:** Over his last 11 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits six times and is hitting .318 (14-for-44) with two doubles, two triples, four home runs, nine RBI, 10 runs scored, a .727 slugging percentage and a 1.046 OPS in that span.

❖ Buck ranks in the 94th percentile in baseball in hard hit percentage (56.4%), the 86th percentile in bat speed (74.8) and 86th percentile in barrel percentage (16.4%).

❖ He has a 8.3% increase in his hard hit percentage from 2024 to 2025, improving from 48.1% to 56.4%...12th-best in the American League.

**I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS:** Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in a season-long 10-straight games (career-high is 13, 7/6-26/24)...during the streak he has posted a .410 on-base percentage (9 hits, 6 walks), a .688 slugging percentage and a 1.098 OPS.

❖ During this stretch he has posted a 93.7 average exit velocity (89.5 MLB average).

**WIN OR LEWIS, ROYCE IS ON THE FIELD:** Royce Lewis began his rehab assignment with Triple-A St. Paul last night, going 1-for-3 while playing six innings at third base...he is scheduled to have the day off today...Royce has missed all 26 Twins games with a left hamstring strain, an injury he suffered in spring training on March 16, running out a ground ball to third base.

**ON THIS DAY IN TWINS (AND ANGELS) HISTORY:** In 1986, the game between California and the Twins was delayed for nine minutes when strong winds tore a hole in the Metrodome roof, causing suspended lights and speakers to sag toward the field...the roof was reinflated and California rallied for six runs in the ninth inning to win, 7-6.
