THE TWINS: Have gone 4-1 through five games on their six-game homestand, going 2-1 against Chicago-AL this week, followed by consecutive victories over Los Angeles-AL the last two days...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale against the Angels... after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Cleveland to begin a seven-game roadtrip with four against the Guardians tomorrow through Thursday, followed by three against the Red Sox at Fenway Park next weekend.

\*\*Due to NBA playoff scheduling conflicts (Wolves vs. Lakers at Target Center), today's game will start at 12:40 pm, 30 minutes ahead of the original 1:10 start time (Wolves up 2-1).

\*\*Twins are 8-6 at home this season and have gone 7-2 in their last nine at Target Field.

\*\*Twins are seeking their first three-game winning streak today...their last was August 15-17, 2024, taking the first three games of a four-game series at Texas.

TWINS TAKE IT FROM OPENING TIP: The Twins beat the Angels yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 5-1...Simeon Woods Richardson (2-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on four hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with no walks and a season-high seven strikeouts...the offense tied their season-high with 13 hits as five different Twins recorded multiple hits...Jonah Bride (2-for-4, BB) and Ryan Jeffers (1-for-3, 2 BB) each reached three times.

◆ The win gave the Twins back-to-back series victories for the first time since August 12-18, 2024, when they took two of three vs. Kansas City and three of four at Texas.

SEND ME AN ANGEL: The Twins and Angels are playing the third of six games in 2025...Minnesota has gone 7-1 in their last eight against Anaheim...these two will meet next for three games in California from September 8-10, during the Twins' penultimate roadtrip.

Since the start of last season, the Twins are hitting .330 (92-for-279) with 8.3 runs-pergame and a .958 OPS in eight games with Anaheim.

Tyrrance is hitting .293 (24-for-82) with 17 RBI and a .914 OPS in his last 23 games against the Angels...additionally, he has 37 career RBI against LAA, his most vs. any opponent.

Carlos Correa has reached safely in each of his last 11 games against the Angels...he is hitting .304 (108-for-355) with 25 doubles, 17 home runs, 72 RBI, a .383 on-base percentage, a .518 slugging percentage and a .901 OPS in 96 career games against the Angels...the 72 RBI are his most vs. any opponent and the 17 home runs are his second most (Texas - 21)...additionally, his 72 RBI are tied for fourth most among actives.

Trevor Larnach has reached base safely 15 times in his last 27 plate appearances against the Angels. (.556 OBP, 9 hits, 6 walks).

Ryan Jeffers is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with 10 RBI and a 1.088 OPS in his last eight games against the Angels.

SORI, NOT SORI: The Twins faced José Soriano exactly one year ago today at Angel Stadium, posting four runs on him on three hits and three walks as the Twins won 16-5...every Twin in the lineup had a hit that day, while seven had multiple hits...it marked win number six of their 12-game winning streak.

■ Ty France is 3-for-6 with a double, one walk and three RBI lifetime against Soriano.

SWEEPING SUCCESS: Minnesota is seeking its first sweep of the season today and first since August 2-4, 2024, when they took all three from the White Sox at Target Field...Twins recorded five sweeps all of 2024.

◆ Their last sweep of the Angels came in three games, from April 26-28, 2024 at Angel Stadium...their last sweep of the Angels in Minnesota came April 15-17, 2016 (3 games).

**PLUS-MINUS:** Through the Atlanta series on April 20, the Twins were at a 2025 low-water mark of -20 (75-95), in terms of run differential...over the last five games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +13 (26-13)...they now sit at -7 on the season (101-108).

I AM THE ONE WHO NACHS: Trevor Larnach has reached base safely in a season-long 11-straight games (career-high is 13, 7/6-26/24)...during the streak he has posted a .386 on-base percentage (10 hits, 6 walks), a .622 slugging percentage and a 1.008 OPS.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Double-A Wichita catcher/outfielder Ricardo Olivar and Low-A Fort Myers right-handed pitcher Cole Peschl as Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

♣ Olivar, 23, played in four games for the Wind Surge this week, going 8-for-17 (.471) with two doubles, one home run, four RBI and a 1.265 OPS...Olviar is ranked as the club's 16th-best prospect, per MLB.com.

♣ Peschl, 22, made the start on Friday at Clearwater, pitching 5.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and nine strikeouts...the Fairmont, WV native was selected by the Twins in the 15th round of the 2024 First-Year Player Draft out of Campbell University in Buies Creek, NC.

DISTRICT OF MO-LUMBIA, THE WASHINGTON MAU-NUMENT, THE LINCOLN MEM-MAU-RIAL, THE WHITE MAU-SE, THE NATIONAL MAU-LL: Twins Coordinator of Communications/Interpreter Mauricio Ortiz will be spending his last day with the Twins today...he accepted a job as Manager of Communications/Interpreter with the Washington Nationals and will start on Tuesday...the Twins went 147-138 under Ortiz and snapped their playoff losing streak of 18 in 2023, just a few months after Mauricio was hired.

LAST TIME OUT: Started on April 20 at Truist Park in Atlanta opposite right-hander Grant Holmes... took the loss, his second of the season, allowing six runs on eight hits (3 HR), with one walk and five strikeouts over 5.0 innings...surrendered a run in each of his innings except the fourth, including two-run homers in the first and third, and a solo shot in the fifth...prior to the game, Ryan had not allowed six earned runs in an outing since September 29, 2023 at Colorado, when he also allowed eight hits and three home runs in 5.0 innings.

The Twins pitching staff entered the game with a major league best 20 two-out runs allowed until the first five runs scored by Atlanta came with two outs in their respective innings...Ryan had proviously allowed two two outs runs this caseson.

had previously allowed two two-out runs this season — on March 29 in St. Louis and April 14 vs. New York at Target Field.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on April 14 vs. New York-NL at Target Field opposite right-hander Clay Holmes...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-1 loss, allowed one run on three hits over honnes...util of tactor into the decision of Milliesota's 3-1 loss, anowed one for first over 15.0 innings, walking two and striking out eight...his one run allowed came on a Pete Alonso RBI single in the third inning...was his first outing of the year with 90+ pitches thrown (101) and his first outing allowing a walk since August 2, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL.

Struck out the side in the second inning, the second time this season he's retired all three batters in an inning via the strikeout; also did so in the first inning on April 3 vs. Houston.

FACING LOS ANGELES-AL: In three career starts against the Halos, Ryan is 1-0 with a 4.50 ERA (16.0 IP, 8 ER), four walks and 24 strikeouts...last outing came on September 24, 2023 at Target Field; earned the win, allowing three runs on seven hits, no walks and 10 strikeouts over 6.0 innings... the Angels are one of two teams that Ryan has faced at least twice and not allowed a home run to;

also, San Francisco…has allowed a base runner in 11 of his 16 innings pitched against the Angels. ₱ In 18 career starts against the American League West, Ryan is 5-8 with a 5.11 ERA (93.1 IP, 53 ER), 32 walks and 117 strikeouts.

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN': The San Francisco native and California State University alumnus is 4-3 in 10 career starts against California teams with a 5.63 ERA (54.1 IP, 34 ER), eight home runs, 19 walks and 65 strikeouts (A's-2, LAD-1, SD-1, SF-3, LAA-3)...here is how Ryan ranks among Twins pitchers with at least five starts against California teams since 2021:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his third home start of the season, last on April 14 vs. New York-NI in his last five home starts dating back to July 6, 2024 vs. Houston, he is 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (28.0 IP, 14 ER), five home runs, six walks, 35 strikeouts and a 1.04 WHIP; Twins are 2-3 and have been outscored 15-37...in his career, Ryan is 19-13 in 45 home starts with a 3.75 ERA (256.2 IP, 107 ER), 60 walks and 301 strikeouts, compared to 15-15 in 44 road starts with a 4.11 ERA (240.2 IP, 110 ER), 52 walks and 252 strikeouts; 20 of his 40 career quality starts have come at home.

 ♣ His 301 career strikeouts at home rank third all-time among pitchers at Target Field; Kyle Gibson (436) and José Berrios (432) lead the list...of pitchers with 10-or-more starts at Target Field, Ryan's 1.02 WHIP ranks first while his 5.02 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks fourth.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .224/.255/.388 with two home runs, no walks and eight strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .231/.310/.442 with three home runs, three walks and 20 strikeouts...in 2024, left-handed hitters slashed .203/.243/.373 with nine home runs, 11 walks and 61 strikeouts in 255 plate appearances, while right-handed hitters slashed .229/.269/.425 with 10 home runs, 12 walks and 86 strikeouts in 283 plate appearances.

© Over his career, lefties are batting .207 (185-for-892) with a .631 OPS...righties are .238 (234-for-983) with a .734 OPS.

- ₹ With 443 pitches thrown so far this season, Ryan's average exit velocity is 92.6 mph with a hard hit rate of 47.9 percent, compared to 88.3 mph and 36.6 percent in 2024...his strikeout
- and 11. Tate of 47.9 percent, compared to 86.3 mph and 36.6 percent in 2024...ms strikeout rate is 25.7 percent and his walk rate is 2.8 percent, compared to 27.3 percent strikeout rate and 4.3 percent walk rate in 2024.

THROUGH THE FIRST 90: Today's start marks the 90th of Ryan's career...among Twins pitchers THROUGH THE FIRST 90: loday's start marks the 90th of Ryan's career..among lwins pitchers (1961-present) through their first 90 career starts with the club, Ryan's 3.93 ERA through 89 starts ranks ninth behind teammate Bailey Ober's 3.88 ERA...his current 553 strikeouts rank second behind Johan Santana's 622 strikeouts; Dave Boswell is next closest with 529 strikeouts...his current 112 walks are the fourth fewest behind Kevin Tapani (107), Bailey Ober (107) and Kevin Slowey (81). 

▼ Ryan is one of five active starters in the major leagues with over 490 innings pitched in 90-orfewer starts...among such players, he ranks third in strikeouts (553), second in walks (112) and first in WHIP (1.068)...also, he is one of two such pitchers that has thrown a complete-game shutout (Nestor Cortes is the other).
