HOME SICK: The Twins cracked open Target Field for its 16th season on Thursday afternoon and lost to the Astros by a score of 5-2...Minnesota got a two-run lead in the first inning but allowed five unanswered runs the rest of the way...Joe Ryan made his second career Home Opener start, allowing four runs on five hits (2 HR) in 5.0 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded five hits, two from Byron Buxton...Minnesota struck out 11 times and did not draw a walk.

SHOOTING STARS: The Twins and Astros are playing the second of six games in 2025...Minnesota went 4-2 against the Astros last season, going 2-1 at Minute Maid Park from May 31-June 2 and 2-1 at Target Field from July 5-7...they won the season series for the second-straight season (4-2 in 2023) and fourth time in their last five tries.

♣ After going 0-6 against the Astros in 2022, the Twins have gone 8-5 in regular season games vs. Houston since the start of 2023.

♣ The Twins are 43-47 all-time against the Astros in the regular season, including a record of 32-38 since Houston joined the American League in 2013.

♣ Jose Miranda is hitting .293 (17-for-58) with two doubles, two home runs and eight RBI in 16 career games against the Astros...since the start of last season, he is hitting .526 (10-for-19) with a 1.519 OPS in seven games against Houston.

♣ Christian Vázquez hit .364 (4-for-11) with one double, one home run and four RBI in three games against Houston last season...in 37 career games against the Astros, he is hitting .319 (38-for-119) with an .831 OPS.

♣ Byron Buxton has multiple hits in four consecutive games against the Astros, dating back to July 4, 2024...in that span he has eight hits in 16 at-bats, including one double, one home run, five runs scored and three RBI.

WEST WAS THE BEST: The Twins went 25-8 against the AL West last season, going 6-1 vs. Oakland, 5-2 vs. Seattle, 5-1 vs. Los Angeles, 5-2 vs. Texas and 4-2 vs. Houston...Minnesota's .758 winning percentage against that division was the highest in their history since MLB switched to the current divisional format in 1994...25 total wins was second to their 1996 total of 27.

WILL-TY CONSCIENCE: Willi Castro has reached base safely in all seven of the Twins games after hitting safely in each of his first four, getting hit-by-a-pitch in his next two at Chicago-AL, followed by a single on Thursday...he is one of 10 players in the AL to reach safely in all of their games played (min. 7 games), joining Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (8), Kristian Campbell (8), Cal Raleigh (8), Julio Rodríguez (8), Jacob Wilson (8), Adley Rutschman (8), Isaac Paredes (7), George Springer (7) and Alex Bregman (7).

THE WALKING'S DEAD: Minnesota has not drawn a walk in two consecutive games, first time doing that since September 16-17 (1), 2022...their last walk was a Ty France eighth inning free pass on Tuesday in Chicago...of their seven games, they have gone walk-less in three of those...on the season, they have walked 15 times, the fewest in baseball...MLB's leader is the Cubs with 50.

◆ The last time the Twins did not draw a walk in three-straight games came June 14-16, 2001.

MINOR MATTERS: High-A Cedar Rapids and Low-A Fort Myers both began their seasons last night. Double-A Wichita was scheduled to play at Springfield but was rained out.

© Cedar Rapids beat Wisconsin by a score of 4-1...Charlee Soto was the starter, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with two hits allowed, three walks and five strikeouts...Spencer Bengard pitched 4.0 no-hit innings of relief, walking one and striking out six...Gabby Gonzalez went 2-for-4 with a double.

© Fort Myers lost to Palm Beach by a score of 8-2...Eli Jones was the starter for the Mighty Mussels, making his professional debut, allowing four runs (3 earned) on seven hits in 4.1 innings pitched...outfielder Byron Chourio reached four times, going 1-for-2 with three walks.

ICYMI: Right-handed pitcher Randy Dobnak cleared waivers on Wednesday and accepted his assignment to Triple-A St. Paul...Dobnak was on the Opening Day roster and pitched 5.1 innings on March 30 at St. Louis...he was designated for assignment on March 31, creating roster space for Darren McCaughan.

IT AIN'T OBER TIL IT'S OBER: Last pitched on March 30 at Busch Stadium vs. the Cardinals...he took the loss in Minnesota's 0-11 defeat.. allowed eight runs (1 shy of his career high) on eight hits in 2.2 innings, with three walks and three strikeouts...allowed two home runs, one to right-centerfield from Victor Scott II and one to all to left-centerfield from Pedro Pagés.

This 2.2 innings was his shortest start since his first appearance in 2024 on March 31 when he pitched 1.1 at Kansas City.

The allowed a career-low strike percentage of 57.1, throwing 77 pitches (44 strikes).

SPRING TRAINING RECAP: Ober made five starts in spring training, going 2-1, 1.77 ERA (20.1 IP, 4 ER) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...allowed a 231 (18-for-78) opponent batting average, with four runs and two homers...he led Twins staff in total innings pitched at 20.1.

© This year marked his most innings pitched in spring training.

2024 SEASON RECAP: Made a career-high 31 starts on the season, going 12-9 with a 3.98 ERA (178.2 IP, 79 ER); allowed 136 total hits (27 HR), with 43 walks and 191 strikeouts...had career-high strikeouts (14) on June 23 at Oakland, career-high walks (4) on June 2 at New York-AL and career-high pitches (106) on August 9 vs. Cleveland.

Threw his first complete game on June 22 at Oakland, leading Minnesota to a 10-2 victory.

VS. H-TOWN: In two career regular season starts against the Astros, Ober has a 4.50 ERA (10.0 IP, 5 ER), with two walks and 12 strikeouts, allowing a five runs on 14 hits (3 HR).

His first start against the Astros on June 11, 2021 marked the third game of his rookie season and second at home.

Did not factor into the decision of either game.

Has two appearances (1 start) against the Astros in the 2023 ALDS where he posted a 12.46 ERA (4.1 IP, 6 ER), allowing six runs off eight hits (4 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts.

BACK AT HOME: In four seasons with the Twins, Ober has gone 14-9 with a 3.85 ERA (23.1.1 IP. 99 ER), 9.34 K/9. 2.22 B/9 and 1.56 HR/9 in 44 starts at home compared to 11-13 with a 3.93 ERA (242.2 IP. 106 ER), 9.16 K/9. 1.78 BB/9 and 1.30 HR/9 in 45 road starts.

© In 2024, allowed a 221 (69-for-312) batting average and .701 OPS at home, compared to a .195 (67-for-343) opponent batting average and .607 OPS away.

© Ober is 0-4 in his last five starts at home, posting an 8.03 ERA (24.2 IP. 22 ER) with nine walks and 27 strikeouts, allowing 22 runs off 27 hits (6 HR); compared to 5-0 in the previous five starts at home where he had a 1.67 ERA (32.1 IP 6 ER), with seven walks and 36 strikeouts, allowing eight runs off 21 hits (4 HR)...his most recent win at home took place on August 9, 2024 vs. Cleveland.
