TWINS BLOW BIG LEAD IN SERIES FINALE: The Twins lost to the Astros yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 9-7 in 10 innings, blowing a 7-1 lead...the previous time the Twins lost a six-plus-run lead was May 11, 2024, when they led the Blue Jays 7-1 at Rogers Centre in the middle of the third inning and lost, 10-8...Chris Paddack was the starter, allowing four runs (3 earned) on seven hits, with two walks and two strikeouts...Griffin Jax suffered a blown save by allowing two runs in the top of the ninth, which forced extras...the offense recorded a season-high 11 hits, four coming from Matt Wallner (single-game career-high)... Trevor Larnach drove in three runs and doubled once.

GREAT SCOTT!: The Twins have selected the contract of right-handed pitcher Scott Blewett from Triple-A St. Paul...Blewett appeared in two games for the Saints this season, allowing three runs on three hits in 2.1 innings pitched, with two walks and three strikeouts...to make room on both the 26-man and 40-man rosters, the Twins have designated right-handed pitcher Darren McCaughan for release or assignment.

◆ Blewett was selected by the Royals in the second round (56th overall) of the 2014 MLB Draft and made his major league debut with the Royals on September 18, 2020.

DRESSED TO THE NINES: After starting 0-4, the Twins have now won three of their last five games...below are some offensive and pitching comparisons over the first nine games overall:

ROYALTY CHECK: The Twins went 7-6 against the Royals last season, going 5-2 at Target Field and 2-4 at Kauffman Stadium...Minnesota was swept last time they visiting Kauffman, getting outscored 11-2 in the three games ₹ Twins have gone 28-15 in their last 43 against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022. ★ Twins have groped four-straight to the Royals, marking their longest losing streak to KC since September 29, 2019-August 9, 2020 (also 4). they are looking to avoid losing five-straight for the first time since August 14-September 6, 2016, when they lost seven-straight. ★ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 56-37 vs. Kansas City...56 wins are his second-most against any opponent (Chicago-AL - 57-39). ★ Trevor Larnach is hitting .302 (29-for-96) with three doubles, five home runs, 18 RBI, a .419 on-base percentage, a .490 slugging percentage and a .908 OPS in 31 career games vs. the Royals...in 16 career games at Kauffman, he is hitting .291 (16-for-55)...29 hits against the Royals and 16 hits at Kauffman are his most against any opponent/opposing ballpark. ★ Byron Buxton is hitting .303 (57-for-188) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 21 RBI, 33 runs scored and a 1.019 OPS in his last 37 games against the Royals.
★ Carlos Correa is hitting .303 (57-for-188) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBI, 25 walks, a .385 on-base percentage and an .864 OPS in 49 games against the Royals since 19. ★ Harrison Bader has reached safely in all 10 of his games played at Kauffman Stadium... in those 10 he is hitting .324 (12-for-37) with an .867 OPS.

CI-TY OF FOUNTAINS: Ty France is hitting .408 (42-for-103) with eight doubles, five home runs, 20 RBI, a .496 on-base percentage, a .631 slugging percentage and a 1.127 OPS in 27 career games against the Royals; the OPS is his highest against any opponent...of those 27 games, he has four three-hit games, a four-hit game and a five-hit game...in 11 career games at Kauffman, he is slashing .488/.611/.732 (1.343 OPS).

Among players with a minimum of 50 plate appearances at Kauffman since 2021, France ranks first in batting average, on-base percentage and OPS, and second in slugging.

THE MOOSE IS ON THE LOOSE: After going 4-for-5 yesterday and tying a career-high in hits, Matt Wallner raised his batting average 107 points from .160 to .267...below are Wallner's number comparisons over the first nine games of the season:

NIGHT SCHOOL: Twins are playing just their second night game of the season, their other was an 8-3 victory on Tuesday, April 1 at Chicago-AL...Minnesota and Chicago-AL are the only two teams in baseball to play just one night game so far.

◆ In 2024, the Twins went 43-53 in night games in 2024, tied for 23rd in wins in MLB.

◆ Twins pitchers posted a 4.65 ERA at night in 2024, compared to 3.69 during the day.

◆ Buxton hit .298 (61-for-205) with a .904 OPS in 57 night games in 2024.

FLIGHTS AND FIST BUMPS: After winning their final two games on the road last week at Chicago-AL, the Twins are now seeking their first three-game road winning streak since taking three-straight from August 15-17, 2024, when they won the first three games of the Texas series at Globe Life Field.

◆ Over those two wins at Rate Field, the pitching staff allowed four runs in 18.0 innings pitched (2.00 ERA) with 20 strikeouts...the offense scored 14 runs (7.0 R/G).

WILL-MATIC: Willi Castro has reached base safely in all nine of the Twins games...he is one of six players in the AL to reach safely in all of their games played (min. 9 games), joining Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (10), Kristian Campbell (10), Jacob Wilson (10), Cal Raleigh (10), Adley Rutschman (9) and Isaac Paredes (9).

'PENSION PLAN: Despite allowing five runs (4 earned) in yesterday's loss to the Astros, over the last seven games, the Twins bullpen has posted a 1.97 ERA (32.0 IP, 7 ER) with five walks, 35 strikeouts, a .217 opponent batting average and a .599 opponent OPS.

◆ Over the three-game series against Houston, the bullpen allowed six runs (4 earned) on 16 hits in 15.0 innings (3.00 ERA), including just two walks to 21 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's first victory of the season, an 8-3 win over the White Sox in Chicago on April 1...in 4.0 innings, Woods Richardson allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk and five strikeouts...Twins scored five runs in the sixth inning after he exited the game...did not record a ground-ball out for the second time in his career; last such outing came on September 25, 2024 vs. Miami at Target Field (1.0 IP).

4 Marks the third consecutive season in which he has struck out five batters in his first outing of the year

of the year.

SPRING RECAP: Went 1-2 in five appearances (3 starts) in his fourth spring training with Minnesota (4.05 ERA, 13.1 IP, 18 H, 7 ER)...gave up two home runs, walked five and struck out 10...in the middle three appearances of his Grapefruit League season, went 1-1 with 9.0 scoreless innings, two walks and six strikeouts; of his six hits allowed, only one went for extra bases, an Austin Riley double on March 15 at Atlanta...earned his first career spring training victory in his start on March 15, allowing one hit over 4.0 scoreless innings, walking none and striking out two.

2024 RECAP: Began the season with Triple-A St. Paul (3 GS, 0-1, 6.08 ERA, 13.1 IP)...made his first ZUZ4 RECAP: Began the season with Iriple-A St. Paul (3 GS, U-1, 6.08 ERA, 13.1 IP)...made his first major league start of the season and secured his first career victory as the 27th man in game two of an April 13 doubleheader in Detroit (6.0 IP, 2 H, 1 R/ER, BB, 5 SO)...officially joined the starting rotation on April 25 vs. Chicago-AL (5.0 IP, 7 H, 2 R/ER, BB, 6 SO) and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-3 win...finished 5-5 in 28 starts with a 4.17 ERA over 133.2 innings (48 BB, 117 SO); Twins were 17-11 in Woods Richardson's starts.

4 Through first four starts, he held a 1.74 ERA (20.2 IP, 17 H), walking five and striking out 21...

was one of 12 American League pitchers and the only Twin to not allow a home run in their first four starts of the season.

this 2.70 ERA across eight starts in April/May led the team and ranked 15th among American League pitchers with at least five starts.

HERE TO STAY: Since joining the Twins rotation full-time on April 25, 2024, ranks third among current Twins starters in games started (28) and innings pitched (131.2)...has allowed the second fewest home runs (16) and the third lowest opponent batting average (.253)...in his 28 starts, Twins are 17-11.

AGAINST KANSAS CITY: Has gone 1-1 in two career starts against Kansas City with a 3.86 ERA...on May 28, 2024 at Target Field, earned his second career win while allowing two runs on three hits, walking two and striking out four over 5.0 innings...on September 8, 2024 at Kauffman Stadium, took the loss, allowed two runs on three hits, walked three and struck out two over 4.1 innings...has not allowed a home run vs. the Royals.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Making his second road start of the season...is 0-1 with three no-decisions in his last four road starts (4.32 ERA, 16.2 IP, 19 H, 8 ER, 7 BB, 15 S0)...in his career, is 4-4 in 17 starts on the road with a 4.08 ERA (79.1 IP, 36 ER), compared to 1-2 in 13 home starts (14 appearances), all last season, with a 4.63 ERA (68.0 IP, 35 ER)...in 2024, went 4-3 in 15 starts on the road with a 4.09 ERA (70.1 IP, 33 R/32 ER), 23 walks and 70 strikeouts.

◆ In seven career road starts in American League Central ballparks, including his start at Chicago-AL on April 1, Woods Richardson is 1-2 with a 2.73 ERA (33.0 IP, 10 ER), 10 walks and 25 strikeouts...has pitched twice in each AL-Central park except Kauffman Stadium.

PLATOON SPLITS: In 31 career games (30 starts), Woods Richardson has a .259 (61-for-236) opponent batting average against lefties with 24 walks and 53 strikeouts, compared to a .242 (79-for-326) opponent batting average against righties with 30 walks and 77 strikeouts...lefties are slugging .373 with seven home runs while righties are slugging .405 with 11 home runs.
