THE TWINS: After completing their first home series of the season by going 1-2 against Houston over the weekend, the Twins began their second roadtrip of the season with consecutive losses to the Royals in Kansas City Monday and Tuesday nights...tonight, the Twins will play the third of four at Kauffman Stadium...after tomorrow afternoon's series finale, the Twins will return home for a six-game homestand, playing three against Detroit over the weekend, followed by three against the Mets next Monday-Wednesday.

TWINS KICK IT AROUND IN KAUFFMAN: The Twins lost to the Royals last night at Kauffman Stadium by a score of 2-1, suffering their first one-run loss of the season...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one unearned run on three hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with one walk and six strikeouts...he exited the game in the fifth inning due to tightness in his right hamstring...the bullpen combined to pitch 3.1 innings, allowing one unearned run, no hits allowed, two walks and two strikeouts...Minnesota entered the game with just four fielding errors on the season and committed three on the night...three errors marked the first time since October 2, 2022 at Detroit; Twins lost without allowing an earned run for the first time since July 24, 2021.

RYAN xPERIENCE: Since the start of 2023, Joe Ryan has gone 18-18, 4.11 ERA (306.2 IP, 140 ER) with 57 home runs, 355 strikeouts, a 1.08 WHIP and a .235 opponent batting average in 54 starts...below are his ranks among AL pitchers (minimum of 300 innings pitched) in that span in a few categories:

ROYALE WITH CHEESE: The Twins are playing the third of 13 games against the Royals this season and third of seven games at Kauffman Stadium.

♣ Twins have gone 28-17 in their last 45 against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022.

♣ Twins have dropped six-straight to the Royals, marking their longest losing streak to KC since August 14-September 6, 2016, when they lost seven-straight.

♣ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 56-39 vs. Kansas City...56 wins are his second-most against any opponent (Chicago-AL - 57-39).

♣ Carlos Correa is hitting .301 (59-for-196) with 12 doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, 25 walks, a .380 on-base percentage and an .860 OPS in 51 games against the Royals since 19.

♣ Harrison Bader has reached safely in all 12 of his games played at Kauffman Stadium... in those 12 he is hitting .341 (15-for-44) with an .865 OPS.

♣ Notable career numbers against Seth Lugo: Willi Castro is 4-for-8 with two doubles...Jose Miranda is 2-for-5 with a double.

CI-TY OF FOUNTAINS: Ty France is hitting .400 (44-for-110) with 10 doubles, five home runs, 20 RBI, a .488 on-base percentage, a .627 slugging percentage and a 1.116 OPS in 29 career games against the Royals; the OPS is his highest against any opponent...in 13 career games at Kauffman, he is slashing .458/.581/.708 (1.289 OPS).

■ Among players with a minimum of 50 plate appearances at Kauffman since 2021, France ranks first in batting average, on-base percentage and OPS, and second in slugging.

TO THE WINDOW, TO THE WALL: After going 2-for-3 Monday night, Matt Wallner has now recorded six hits in his last eight at-bats over his last two games...below are Wallner's number comparisons over the first 10 games of the season:

WILL-MATIC: Willi Castro has reached base safely in all 10 of his games played, tied with Jonathan India for fifth-longest active on-base streak in the AL, trailing Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (12), Jacob Wilson (12), Kristian Campbell (11) and Adley Rutschman (11).
₱It marks the longest on-base streak for a Twin to start a season since Trevor Larnach reached safely in his first 11 of 2023.

EXCELLENT 'PENMANSHIP: The Twins bullpen has pitched 5.2 innings this series without allowing an earned run, while allowing one hit, walking two and striking out four...over the last nine games, the Twins 'pen has posted a 1.67 ERA (37.2 IP, 7 ER) with seven walks, 39 strikeouts, a .194 opponent batting average and a .545 opponent OPS.

PLAYER BADERS BALL: Harrison Bader recorded his team-leading 10th RBI of the season last night...his 10 RBI rank tied for fifth in the AL...over Bader's last three games, he has gone 5-for-11 (.455) with one walk, two RBI and a .955 OPS.

◆ Against right-handed pitching this season, Bader is hitting .381 (8-for-21) with one double, three home runs, nine RBI and a 1.266 OPS.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2000, at Kauffman Stadium, the Twins beat the Royals, 13-7, as both teams each hit three consecutive home runs in the same game for the first time in major league history...Ron Coomer, Jacque Jones and Matt LeCroy connect consecutively in the sixth inning for Minnesota, followed by three in a row by Carlos Beltrán, Jermaine Dye and Mike Sweeney of Kansas City two innings later.

LAST TIME OUT: On April 3, took the loss vs. Houston at Target Field, his first loss at Target Field since May 16, 2024 vs. New York-AL...allowed four runs on five hits and struck out five over 5.0 innings... extended his streak to three outings without allowing a walk, dating back to August 7, 2024 at Chicago-NL; marked his 14th career start with six-plus strikeouts and no walks allowed...surrendered back-to-back home runs to Christian Walker and Jeremy Peña in the second inning, the first time in his career yielding back-to-back homers at Target Field.

© Struck out Jose Altuve, Isaac Paredes and Yordan Alvarez to start the game, becoming the first Twins starter to strikeout the side in the opening inning of the home opener.

© His four runs and five hits were his most allowed since July 21, 2024 vs. Milwaukee (6.0 IP, 7 H, 4 ER)...has not given up multiple home runs in an outing since April 24, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL.

2024 RECAP: Went 7-7 in 23 starts with a 3.60 ERA (135.0 IP, 54 ER), 23 walks and 147 strikeouts; Twins were 11-12 in Ryan's starts...allowed four earned runs or less in 18 games...third season with an ERA below 3.00 through May...his 135.0 innings ranked first among pitchers with 23 or fewer starts while his 147 strikeouts ranked third behind Paul Skenes (170) and Tyler Glasnow (168).

RYAN'S REIGN: Is 6-0 in eight career starts against Kansas City, posting a 1.49 ERA (48.1 IP, 8 ER), his lowest against all other opponents faced two-or-more times...last took on the Royals at Target Field on May 27, 2024, earning his fourth win of the season while allowing one run over 7.0 innings,

walking none and striking out nine...has struck out five-or-more while walking two-or-less in every game vs the Royals.

Five of his eight starts vs. Kansas City have been quality starts...of the 26 teams he has faced in his career, Ryan has only pitched more quality outings against Cleveland (7 GS).

His ERA ranks first among active players with at least eight starts against Kansas City...of such players, only Joe Ryan and Sonny Gray (9-0) are undefeated against the Royals.

BACK ON THE ROAD: Is making his second road start of the season (0-0, 5.0 IP, 5 H, 1 ER, 5 K)...in last eight road starts dating back to June 1, 2024 at Houston, is 0-4 with a 4.50 ERA (42.0 IP, 21 ER) with eight walks and 48 strikeouts...at Kauffman Stadium, is 3-0 in four career starts with a 1.17 ERA (23.0 IP, 3 ER), five walks and 33 strikeouts...has not allowed a home run...last pitched in Kansas City on March 30, 2024, did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-1 win...allowed one run on

◆ Has not pitched a night game at Kauffman Stadium since May 21, 2022...earned the win, going 5.2 innings with one run allowed on five hits, two walks and six strikeouts.

◆ His 1.17 ERA at Kauffman is third lowest among active players (minimum of 20.0 IP), behind

Gerrit Cole (0.84 ERA) and Jack Flaherty (0.90 ERA).

EFT-RIGHT SPLITS: Over his first two starts of 2025, righties have slashed .286/.333/.286 with two strikeouts while lefties have slashed .250/.333/.500 with two homers and nine strikeouts...in 2024, left-handed hitters slashed .203/.243/.373 with nine home runs, 11 walks and 61 strikeouts in 255 plate appearances vs. Ryan, while right-handed hitters slashed .229/.269/.425 with 10 home runs, 12 walks and 86 strikeouts in 283 plate appearances.
