The Over the last nine games, since April 22, the Twins have a run differential of +25 (45-20)... they now sit at +5 overall on the season (120-115).

SEVENTH INNING DOES IN THE TWINS: The Twins lost to the Guardians last night at Progressive Field by a score of 4-2...Pablo López (2-2) was the starter and was issued the loss, allowing two runs on four hits in 6.1 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded six hits, two coming from Trevor Larnach...Brooks Lee hit his second home run of the season, a solo shot off Hunter Gaddis in the eighth inning...Byron Buxton stole his 100th career base in the sixth inning — the eighth Twin to ever reach that mark.

GREAT LAKES GAMES: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the fourth of 13 games in 2025...after this series, these two will meet again for a three-game series at Target Field from May 19-21...Twins will come back to Cleveland for three games from August 1-3.

◆ Carlos Correa is hitting .302 (42-for-139) with seven home runs, 18 RBI, a .386 on-base percentage, a .482 slugging percentage and an .868 OPS in 37 games against the Guardians since the start of 2022 (since he joined the Twins).

◆ Christian Vázquez is hitting .297 (38-for-128) with 10 doubles, two home runs, eight RBI and a .357 on-base percentage in 41 career games vs. the Guards.

◆ Since 2019, the Twins have hit 73 home runs at Progressive Field, their second-most of any opposing ballpark, trailing Rate Field (91)...also in that span, no opponent has homered more in this ballpark (next: Royals with 55).

AGAINST THE GUARDS: Is 0-1 in three career starts against the Guardians, posting a 2.12 ERA (17.0 IP, 4 ER), with one walk and 15 strikeouts...has a .206 (13-for-63) opponent batting average...all starts came in 2024.

◆Last faced Cleveland at Progressive Field on September 19, 2024 and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-3 loss...allowed one run on five hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings....lone run allowed was a solo homer from Kyle Manzardo in the first...was Woods Richardson's third time allowing a home run in the first inning in his career, and second time allowing a first inning homer to the Guardians.

BETTER AHEAD: SWR historically pitches better when he is ahead in the count...in his career, he has 82 strikeouts and a .193 opponent batting average, .303 slugging percentage and .496 OPS when he is ahead, vs. 33 strikeouts and a .333 opponent batting average, .546 slugging percentage and 1.038 OPS when he is behind.

MAKE MY DAY: In 17 career day games (16 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 3.60 ERA and a .246 opponent batting average, .394 slugging percentage, with 25 walks, 84 strikeouts and 11 home runs; compared to a 5.01 ERA, .263 opponent batting average, .416 slugging percentage with 34 walks, 67 strikeouts and 11 home runs in 18 night games (17 starts)...so far this season, SWR is 2-0 in day games, posting a 1.74 ERA (10.1 IP, 2 ER), with no walks and 12 strikeouts.
