THE TWINS: Have gone 4-0 through four games on their six-game homestand, going 3-0 against Baltimore from Tuesday-Thursday, followed by a win over the Giants last night... tonight, the Twins will play the second of three against San Francisco and finish the series/homestand tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, Minnesota will travel to Baltimore to enjoy an off-day on Monday before a six-game roadtrip with three against the Orioles (Tuesday-Thursday), then three against the Brewers (next weekend).
 ☞ Twins have gone 3-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20) and 1-0 vs. San Francisco.
 ☞ With a win today, the Twins will be .500 for the first time this season.

PADDACK, GIANT IN SERIES OPENER: The Twins beat the Giants last night at Target Field by a score of 3-1, making them 5-8 in series openers this season, 5-1 in their last six chances... the win marked Minnesota's first this season when scoring three runs-or-fewer (1-17)...Chris Paddack was the starter and winner, allowing one run on three hits in 7.1 innings pitched, with no walks and six strikeouts...Paddack carried a perfect game for 5.2 innings until allowing a Christian Koss single in the sixth inning...the offense recorded seven hits and went 3-for-8 with runners in scoring position...Byron Buxton went 2-for-3 with a walk and a leadoff triple.

APRIL ANNIVERSARIES: Twins are 12-5 in their last 17 games since April 22...since that date, only Kansas City (15-2) and Detroit (12-4) have won as many games in all of baseball.
 ☞ Over the 17 games, the Twins have a run differential of +37 (80-43)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.
 ☞ Last season, the Twins started 7-13 through April 21, then went 63-40 in their next 103 games (through August 17), the most wins in baseball in that span.

PICK SIX: The Twins enter tonight's game with a six-game winning streak, their last loss coming last Friday (May 2) at Boston, a 6-1 defeat...their last six-game winning streak came June 12-18, 2024 (also 6)...their last seven-game winning streak came April 22-May 4, 2024, when they won 12-straight.

LOOKALIKES VS. BIG PEOPLE: The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 25th, 26th and 27th times in their history this weekend...the Twins are 12-13 all-time against San Francisco, going 5-2 at Target Field, 6-9 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome...dating back to June of 2017, the Twins have won eight of their last 13 over the Giants.
 ☞ The 25 games played against the Giants are fourth-fewest for an opponent in Twins history (since 1961)...the only three teams they have played less are Washington (24), Colorado (24) and Miami (22).
 ☞ Carlos Correa has hit safely in seven-straight games against the Giants...in 16 career games vs. San Francisco, he is hitting .333 (21-for-63) with three doubles, one home run, nine RBI and an .820 OPS.
 ☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .370 (10-for-27) with two home runs and a 1.080 OPS in nine career games vs. SF.
 ☞ NorCal native Trevor Larnach is 5-for-17 (.417) in four career games against the Giants.
 ☞ Notables lifetime against Logan Webb: Harrison Bader is 3-for-7 (.429) with two walks... Ty France is 2-for-6 (.333) with a triple and a home run.

LAKES AND TREES: Twins are 13-6 through 19 home games this season, including a record of 11-1 in their last 12 here...their one loss was a 3-0 defeat by the White Sox on April 24... in those 12 games, they have posted a run differential of +38 (63-25).
 ☞ The last time the Twins had 11 wins in an 12-game span at home was in September of 2020...the last time they had 12 wins in a 13-game span was June-July of 2006.

BUCK AROUND, FIND OUT: Over his last 23 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits 13 times and is hitting .337 (31-for-92) with three doubles, three triples, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 20 runs scored, a .663 slugging percentage and a 1.033 OPS in that span.
 ☞ He has reached safely in each of his last 15 games the fifth-longest streak of his career... his career-long for an on-base streak is 24, from April 25-May 24, 2023.
 ☞ His 15 multi-hit games on the season are tied for fourth-most in baseball.

ALWAYS TIME FOR MEATLOAF (2 OUT OF 3 AIN'T BAD): Twins are seeking their seventh series win today...they are 6-6-0 in series play, going 4-2-0 at home and 2-4-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 5-2-0 in their last seven.
 ☞ Minnesota's last series win over San Francisco came August 26-28, 2022, when the Twins swept the Giants in three at Target Field.

PARDON MY FRENCH: Ty France went 1-for-4 last night, giving him seven hits in 15 at-bats through four games on this homestand...over his last 13 games, he is hitting .365 (19-for-52) with five doubles, one home run, nine RBI, a .519 slugging percentage and a .901 OPS.
 ☞ His 38 hits on the season are tied for 12th-most in the AL.
 ☞ He is hitting .405 (15-for-37) with runners in scoring position, eighth-best in the AL.
 ☞ His 13.7 strikeout percentage ranks seventh-lowest in the AL and 19th lowest in baseball.

- ☞ Making his eighth start of 2025 and 92nd of his career...did not factor into the decision of his last outing on May 2 at Boston (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 8 K).
- ☞ Missed scheduled start on May 8 vs. Baltimore due to illness.
- ☞ In three career starts against San Francisco, Marin County, CA native is 2-1 with a 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER), eight walks and 18 strikeouts.
- ☞ Is 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (17.0 IP, 5 ER), two home runs, three walks and 25 strikeouts in three home starts this season.

LAST TIME OUT: Pitched on May 2 at Fenway Park opposite Boston's Brayan Bello...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-1 loss to the Red Sox; Ryan exited the game in a 1-1 tie before the Twins' bullpen surrendered five runs in the seventh and eighth innings...allowed one run on four hits, including a home run, with one walk and eight strikeouts over 6.0 quality innings.

- ☞ First inning solo home run allowed to Alex Bregman was just the 15th opening-inning home run surrendered by Ryan...six home runs allowed this year mark his most through his first seven starts of a season (3 in 2022, 4 in 2023, 5 in 2024).
- ☞ Eight strikeouts recorded brought his season total to 47, tied with 2023 for his most through seven starts (46 in 2024, 36 in 2022).

TWO STARTS AGO: Earned his second victory of the season on April 28 vs. the Angels at Target Field; Twins won 5-0 against José Soriano and the Halos bullpen...Ryan allowed four hits over 7.0 shutout innings, walking one and striking out a season-high 11...tied season high 7.0 innings pitched, the 16th time in his career going 7.0-or-more innings...retired the first three batters of the game on foul pop flies...did not allow a base runner until the fourth inning.

- ☞ Recorded a career-high 26 whiffs...his 11 strikeouts match the second-highest single-start total of his career...has struck out 10+ in 10 starts; his career high is 12, recorded in Game 1 of a April 13 2024 doubleheader in Detroit.
- ☞ Struck out the side in the second inning, the third time this season he's retired all three batters in an inning via the strikeout and the 17th time in his career.

FACING THE GIANTS: The San Francisco native and California State University Stanislaus alumnus is facing the Giants for the fourth time in his career...is 2-1 with a 3.31 ERA (16.1 IP, 6 ER), eight walks and 18 strikeouts...took the loss in his last outing against San Fran on July 12, 2024 at Oracle Park, allowing five runs on six hits over 5.1 innings of work, with three walks and six strikeouts.

- ☞ Giants batters have hit .226 (14-for-62) against Ryan with a .329 on-base percentage and a .684 OPS...the Giants have not homered off of Ryan, one of two teams he's faced at least thrice and not allowed a homer to (also, LAA - 4 career starts).

CALIFORNIA DREAMIN': Following his April 27 start vs. the Angels, Ryan is 5-3 in 11 career starts against California teams with a 4.99 ERA (61.1 IP, 34 ER), eight home runs, 20 walks and 76 strikeouts (LAD-1, SD-1, A's- 2, SF-3, LAA-4)...here is how he ranks among Twins pitchers with at least five starts against California teams since 2021:

GOOD TO BE BACK JOE-ME: Is making his fourth home start of the season...is 1-1 with a 2.65 ERA (17.0 IP, 5 ER), two home runs, three walks and 25 strikeouts, compared to 1-1 with a 3.13 ERA (23.0 IP, 8 ER), four home runs, two walks and 22 strikeouts in four road starts...in his career, he is 20-13 in 46 home starts with a 3.65 ERA (263.2 IP, 107 ER), a 1.02 WHIP and a 5.11 strikeout-to-walk ratio, compared to 15-15 in 45 road starts with a 4.05 ERA (246.2 IP, 111 ER), a 1.11 WHIP and a 4.91 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ☞ In Ryan's starts at Target Field this season, opposing batters are slashing .197/.258/.361 in 61 at-bats.
- ☞ In two career starts against the Giants at Target Field (8/26/2022, 5/24/2023), Ryan is 2-0 with a 0.82 ERA (11.0 IP, 1 ER), with five walks and 12 strikeouts...threw 107 pitches in each start.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .238/.273/.381 with three doubles, two home runs, one walk and 13 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .188/.250/.376 with four doubles, four home runs, four walks and 34 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .209/.269/.363 with 63 walks and 222 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .234/.278/.446 with 51 walks and 350 strikeouts.

- ☞ In his three career starts against the Giants, lefties have slashed .258/.385/.387 in 31 at-bats with seven walks and six strikeouts, while righties have slashed .194/.265/.323 in 31 at-bats, with one walk and 12 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through seven starts in 2025, Ryan has relied on a five-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ☞ With 633 pitches thrown this season, Ryan's chase rate is 27.8 percent, his whiff rate is 29.4 percent and his strikeout rate is 29.7 percent...his average exit velocity is 90.9 mph while his hard hit rate is 44.6 percent.

GETTING UP TO SPEED: In his last start on May 2 at Boston, Ryan's fastest pitch thrown was a 95.8 mph four-seamer to Alex Bregman; his previous fastest pitch was a 95.4 mph four-seamer on April 9 in Kansas City...of his 92 pitches thrown at Fenway Park, 12 were above 95.0 mph, his most in a game all season; he had not thrown more than three pitches above 95.0 mph in any of his previous six starts.

- ☞ Ryan's overall pitch velocity in his last start averaged 90.6 mph, compared to 89.6 mph over his first six starts of the year...his average four-seamer velocity was 94.3 mph, up from 92.9 mph in his first six starts...his average sweeper was 80.3 mph, up from 79.8 mph...his average splitter was 88.1 mph, up from 87.1 mph...his average sinker was 93.3 mph, up from 92.5 mph...his average slider was 86.9 mph, up from 85.2 mph.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2025: 3-2, 2.18 ERA // CAREER: 57-51, 3.84 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is set to start tomorrow afternoon's series finale against San Francisco at Target Field...earned the win in his last start on May 6 vs. the Orioles, allowing one run on two hits over 5.0 innings pitched, with one walk and a season-high 11 strikeouts...in two home starts this season, he is 2-0 with a 2.70 ERA (10.0 IP, 3 ER), with three walks and 17 strikeouts...has faced the Giants five times in his career, going 0-1 with a 2.10 ERA (30.0 IP, 7 ER), seven walks, 33 strikeouts and a .173 (19-for-110) opponent batting average.
