THE TWINS: Have gone 5-0 through five games on their six-game homestand, going 3-0 against Baltimore from Tuesday-Thursday, followed by consecutive wins over the Giants the last two nights...today, the Twins will complete the series/homestand with the three-game series finale against San Francisco...after today's game, Minnesota will travel to Baltimore to enjoy an off-day tomorrow before beginning a six-game roadtrip with three against the Orioles (Tuesday-Thursday), then three against the Brewers (next weekend).

☞ Twins are 13-5 in their last 18 games since April 22...since that date, only Kansas City (15-3) has won more games in all of baseball.

☞ Over the last 18 games, the Twins have a run differential of +38 (82-44)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

☞ Twins have gone 4-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20) and 2-0 vs. San Francisco.

RYAN > GIANTS: The Twins beat the Giants last night at Target Field by a score of 2-1, securing their seventh series win of the season and fifth in their last six chances...the win was their fourth one-run win of the season (4-6) and second when scoring three runs-or-fewer (2-17)...Joe Ryan (3-2) was the starter and winner, allowing one run on two hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and seven strikeouts...the offense recorded just five hits, two from Trevor Larnach, who doubled and homered; his two-run homer in the third inning being the difference in the game.

I WANT TO SPEAK WITH YOUR MANAGER!: The Twins enter today's game with a seven-game winning streak, their last loss coming last Friday (May 2) at Boston, a 6-1 defeat...below are the Twins longest winning streaks under Rocco Baldelli (since 2019):

WE WERE GIANTS: The Twins and Giants are playing each other for the 27th time in their history today...the Twins are 13-13 all-time against San Francisco, going 6-2 at Target Field, 6-9 at Oracle Park and 1-2 at the Metrodome...dating back to June of 2017, the Twins have won nine of their last 14 over the Giants.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .323 (10-for-31) with two home runs and a .944 OPS in 10 career games vs. SF.

☞ NorCal native Trevor Larnach has hit safely in all five career games vs. San Francisco, hitting .438 (7-for-16) with two doubles, one home run, three RBI and a 1.188 OPS in those five.

MINNESOTA: Twins are 14-6 through 20 home games this season, including a record of 12-1 in their last 13 here...their one loss was a 3-0 defeat by the White Sox on April 24...in those 12 games, they have posted a run differential of +39 (65-26).

☞ The last time the Twins had 12 wins in an 13-game span at home was June-July of 2006...also was the last time they had 13 home wins in a 14-game span.

☞ A win today will give the Twins their first perfect 6-0 homestand since April 22-28, 2022, sweeping the White Sox and Tigers in three games apiece.

BIG BUCK HUNTER: Over his last 24 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits 13 times and is hitting .323 (31-for-96) with three doubles, three triples, seven home runs, 19 RBI, 20 runs scored, a .635 slugging percentage and a .991 OPS in that span.

☞ His 15 multi-hit games on the season are tied for fourth-most in baseball.

☞ Buck is leading off today for the seventh consecutive game...he is hitting .318 (7-for-22) with one double, one triple, three home runs, eight RBI, a .400 on-base percentage, an .864 slugging percentage and a 1.264 OPS in those previous six games.

SWEEPING SUCCESS: Minnesota is seeking its third sweep of the season today...the other two came April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field and May 6-8 vs. Baltimore at Target Field...Twins recorded five sweeps all of 2024.

☞ Their last — and only — sweep of the Giants came on August 26-28, 2022.

☞ The Twins have three times this season entered a series finale with a chance to sweep, going 2-1 in those instances...their one miss on a sweep was the finale against Chicago-AL on April 24.

CLOSING ACTS: The Twins bullpen has pitched 17.0 scoreless innings through five games on this homestand...over the five games they allowed 10 hits, walked two and struck out 21 (11.1 K/9.0 IP) and held opponents to a .175 batting average.

☞ In their last 19 games, since April 20, they have gone 4-3, 2.58 ERA (59.1 IP, 17 ER) with eight saves (9 opps), 15 walks, 72 strikeouts and a .213 opponent batting average...in 21 games prior to April 20, they were 3-8, 3.83 ERA (82.1 IP, 35 ER) with 29 walks, 81 strikeouts and a .229 opponent batting average, including five blown saves.

SAY HI TO YOUR MOTHER FOR ME: The Twins are 29-35 all-time on Mother's Day (since '61)...they won on Mom's Day last season, on May 12, by a score of 5-1 over the Blue Jays at Rogers Centre...Twins have won each their last three after a five-year losing streak from 2015-19.

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Triple-A St. Paul utility player Mickey Gasper and Double-A Wichita left-handed pitcher Connor Prielipp have been named Twins minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Gasper played in four games for the Saints, hitting .529 (9-for-17) with two doubles, three home runs, five RBI, three walks, seven runs scored and a 1.777 OPS...he hit the walk-off three-run homer on Thursday vs. Buffalo and followed that with four hits on Friday.

☞ Prielipp, 24, made the start for the Wind Surge on Thursday at Northwest Arkansas, pitching 4.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, no walks and six strikeouts...the Tomah, Wisconsin native was selected by the Twins in the second round (48th overall) in the 2022 First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Alabama...he is ranked as the organization's fifth-best prospect, per MLB.com, and number one pitcher.

- ⚔ Making seventh start of the season and 165th career start...sixth career start against the Giants.
- ⚔ López is 0-1 in five career starts against the Giants, posting a 2.10 ERA (30.0 IP, 7 ER), with seven walks, 33 strikeouts and a .173 (19-for-110) opponent batting average...has never faced the Giants as a Minnesota Twin.
- ⚔ Earned the win in his last start against the Orioles on May 6 in Minnesota's 9-1 victory...allowed one run on two hits, with one walk and 11 strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

**LIFE OF PABLO:** Last pitched on May 6 at Target Field vs. the Orioles, opposite Cade Povich...allowed one run on two hits, one walk and 11 strikeouts over 5.0 innings...allowed two or less hits for the first time since June 23, 2024...lone run allowed came off an RBI double from Ryan Mountcastle, scoring Gunnar Henderson.

- ⚔ Recorded double digit strikeouts for the 10th time in his career...first time registering 11-plus strikeouts since June 23, 2024.
- ⚔ Marked his fourth straight outing with six-or-more strikeouts, the sixth time in his career accomplishing such a streak...career-high is nine consecutive starts, accomplished twice.
- ⚔ 18 total batters faced are the fewest by a Twin in a 10-plus-strikeout game since Joe Ryan faced 18 while striking out 11 on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on April 30 at Progressive Field vs. the Guardians, opposite Luis Ortiz...allowed two runs on four hits, no walks and six strikeouts over 6.1 quality innings...was dealt his second loss of the season in Minnesota's 2-4 defeat.

- ⚔ His two runs allowed came off a throwing error from López to first, scoring José Ramírez and a home run from Bo Naylor off Brock Stewart, scoring Carlos Santana, an inherited run.

**FACING SAN FRAN:** López is 0-1 in five career starts against the Giants, posting a 2.10 ERA (30.0 IP, 7 ER), with seven walks and 33 strikeouts...has a .173 (19-for-110) opponent batting average...he has never faced the Giants as a Minnesota Twin.

- ⚔ Last faced San Francisco on June 4, 2022 at LoanDepot Park with the Marlins where he did not factor into the decision of Miami's 5-4 victory...allowed four runs on four hits (1 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts in 7.0 innings...compared to his previous four starts against the Giants where he allowed four runs (1 HR) on 15 hits in 23.0 innings.
- ⚔ Pablo's .173 opponent batting average against the Giants is his second-lowest among teams he has faced at least twice, behind only the Orioles (.152)...also his third lowest all-time behind the Orioles and Miami Marlins (.136) who he has faced just once.

**ACE UP OUR SLEEVE:** Since joining the Twins, López has had the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2023:

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 15-8 with a 3.80 ERA (201.1 IP, 85 ER), 10.46 K/9, 1.97 BB/9 and 0.94 HR/9 in 34 starts at home, compared to 16-12 with a 3.50 ERA (223.2 IP, 87 ER), 9.86 K/9, 2.13 BB/9 and 1.25 HR/9 in 38 road starts.

- ⚔ In his last five starts at home, dating back to August 30, 2024, López has gone 4-1, posting a 1.48 ERA (30.1 IP, 4 ER), with seven walks and 38 strikeouts; compared to 1-3, 4.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 12 ER), with three walks and 23 strikeouts in his last five road starts.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through six starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .246/.278/.362 in 69 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .161/.190/.214 in 56 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 88.1 mph and a whiff rate of 25.2 compared to righties' 88.0 mph and 27.6 percent.

- ⚔ His 28.9 percent hard hit rate against left-handed batters is at an all-time low while his 42.0 percent hard hit rate against right-handed batters is at an all-time high.

**COOL UNDER PRESSURE:** With runners in scoring position, López has a .245 (179-for-730) opponent batting average...with a runner on third, he puts up a .220 (20-for-91) opponent batting average and with runners on second and third, he allows just a .185 (10-for-54) opponent batting average.

**THE ARSENAL:** López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 43% of the time, the highest of his career...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ⚔ Currently ranks in the 96th percentile for fastball run value and 91st for breaking run value; compared to seventh percentile for offspeed run value.
- ⚔ Ranks in the 92nd percentile for extension and bottom three percent in max exit velocity at 116.5 mph.
- ⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sweepers, Pablo ranks 10th in strikeout percentage at 37.0 percent.

**WALK THIS WAY:** Pablo's 3.8 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 95th percentile...he ranks third on the Twins pitching staff behind Danny Coulombe (1.9%) and Joe Ryan (2.8%)...his walk rate is at an all-time career low, with his average in the previous seven years being six percent.

**PRACTICE MAKES PERFECT:** Pablo historically pitches better the deeper into games he works...when on pitch 101+, he has just a .194 (7-for-36) opponent batting average, with five walks, 13 strikeouts and no home runs...on pitches 76-100, he has a .229 (150-for-654) BAA, with 47 walks, 185 strikeouts and 16 home runs...compared to pitches 1-25 where he allows a .261 (237-for-908) BAA, 54 walks, 233 strikeouts and 40 home runs.

**Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE:** This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund...with 37 strikeouts this season, he has donated \$37,000 so far.

**CAREER NOTES**

- In 2025, made his third career Opening Day start, became the fourth different Twins pitcher to start at least three-straight Opening Days, joining Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Brad Radke (1999-05) and Dave Goltz (1977-79).
- In 2024, recorded his 800th career strikeout on June 6 at New York-AL, fanning Gleyber Torres in the second inning.
- Tied career high and set 2024 season high with 14 strikeouts on June 23 at Oakland (6.0 IP)...also pitched 8.0 shutout innings with two hits allowed and one walk during the start, earning the win in a 3-0 Twins victory.
- Earned 50th career win in 150th career start on August 12, 2024 vs. Kansas City, allowing three runs on six hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts.
- 2023 recipient of Mike Augustin "Media Good Guy" Award and Carl R. Pohlad Outstanding Community Service Award.
- Won both 2023 Postseason starts, allowing one run in 12.2 total innings and helping Twins snap 18-game Postseason losing streak with a G1 win in the ALWCs vs. Toronto.
- In 2023, earned first All-Star selection and finished seventh in AL Cy Young Award voting after posting career highs in innings (194.0) and strikeouts (234).
- On April 21, 2023, signed a four-year contract extension through the 2027 season with Minnesota.
- In 2022, set career highs in wins (10), games started (32), innings (180.0) and strikeouts (174) as No. 2 starter for Miami.
- 489 career strikeouts with Miami are 11th on their all-time list and is one of 16 pitchers in Marlins history to reach 500.0 innings pitched.
- In 2021, spent fourth season with Miami, holding opponents to two-or-fewer runs in 15 of his 18 starts and posting a career-low 1.12 WHIP.
- Made first career Postseason appearance October 7, 2020, going 5.0 innings in a loss to Atlanta in Game 2 of the National League Division Series.
- Received 2020 Marlins Charlie Hough Good Guy Award, voted on by Miami chapter of BBWAA recognizing a Miami player who fostered a strong relationship with reporters.
- In 2020, spent entire season on active roster and led Marlins in innings pitched (57.1), games started (11), wins (6) and strikeouts (59).
- Made only 21 starts in 2019 after missing over two months on the Injured List with a right shoulder strain, posting a 5.09 ERA in 111.1 innings pitched with 95 strikeouts.
- Made major league debut on June 30, 2018 vs. New York-NL and earned first career victory, tossing 6.0 innings with five strikeouts while limiting the Mets to two runs.
- Acquired by Miami along with outfielder Brayan Hernandez, right-handed pitcher Brandon Miller and right-handed pitcher Lukas Schiraldi from Seattle in exchange for right-handed pitcher David Phelps on July 20, 2017.
