THE TWINS: Completed their six-game homestand with a record of 6-0, sweeping both the Orioles and Giants in three games each...today, the Twins will begin a six-game roadtrip with two games at Camden Yards — a traditional doubleheader...they will complete the series tomorrow afternoon, then travel to Milwaukee to play the Brewers for three games over the weekend.

☞ Twins are 14-5 in their last 19 games since April 22...since that date, only Kansas City (16-5), Detroit (14-6) and St. Louis (14-5) have won as many games in all of baseball.

☞ Over the last 19 games, the Twins have a run differential of +39 (89-50)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

☞ Of the Twins' 20 road games, eight have now been affected by weather...two in St. Louis, two in Chicago-AL, two in Cleveland, one in Boston and yesterday's game in Baltimore.

A SAN FRANCISCO SWEEP: The Twins beat the Giants on Sunday afternoon by a score of 7-6 in 10 innings, completing their third sweep of the season and winning in extras for the second time this season (2-2)...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing four runs on five hits in 6.0 innings pitched, with two walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded 13 hits, three apiece from Trevor Larnach and Brooks Lee...Lee drove in two runs and hit his third home run of the season...DaShawn Keirse Jr. recorded the walk-off single in the bottom of the 10th, Keirse's first career walk-off and first hit since April 16 vs. New York-NL.

I WANT TO SPEAK WITH YOUR MANAGER! The Twins enter today's game with an eight-game winning streak, their last loss coming May 2 at Boston, a 6-1 defeat...below are the Twins longest winning streaks under Rocco Baldelli (since 2019):

NOTE: Twins are one of three teams in baseball this season with an eight-game winning streak, the others being Los Angeles-NL (March 18-April 2) and St. Louis (9-games, May 4-present)...a win in game one would give the Twins their 12th streak of at least nine-straight (since 1961)...two wins today would give them their eighth-ever streak of 10-straight wins.

CHARM CITY GAMES: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other today for the fourth and fifth of six games this season...these two last met for three games at Target Field to start Minnesota's last homestand, last Tuesday-Thursday, with the Twins taking all three.

☞ Twins scored 19 runs during the three-game series last week against the Orioles after scoring 22 runs in their previous 11 games against Baltimore, entering that series.

☞ Twins are seeking their first four-game winning streak against the O's since March 31, 2018-May 31, 2021, when they won 16-straight over Baltimore.

☞ The last time the Twins played in Baltimore came April 15-17, 2024; they were swept in three games...their last win at Camden Yards was July 1, 2023...four-straight losses here since.

☞ Since 2018, the Twins have hit 65 home runs in 41 games against the Orioles, tied for their most vs. any opponent outside of the AL Central (also 65 vs. Seattle).

FREE BIRDS: Notable individual numbers vs. the Orioles:

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .289 (35-for-121) with eight doubles, six home runs, 23 RBI, 10 walks, a .353 on-base percentage, a .504 slugging percentage and an .857 OPS in his last 33 games vs. the Orioles (since August of 2016)...Correa is hitting .333 (16-for-48) with five doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and a .985 OPS in his last 11 games at Camden Yards...he has reached safely in all of those 11.

☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .304 (7-for-23) with two doubles, two walks and a .360 on-base percentage in eight career games at Oriole Park.

☞ Byron Buxton is hitting .308 (16-for-52) with seven doubles, one triple, two home runs, 12 RBI and a .942 OPS in his last 13 games at Camden Yards.

☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI, a .656 slugging percentage and a 1.045 OPS in nine career games at Camden.

☞ Christian Vázquez has 76 career hits and 20 doubles in 89 career games vs. the Orioles, both his most against any opponent...Vázquez has 40 career hits at Camden Yards, his most of any opposing ballpark.

NOTE: Minnesota's last doubleheader vs. Baltimore was April 20, 2019 at Camden Yards as the Twins swept, winning by scores of 6-5 and 16-7.

HOME SICK: The Twins have gone 6-14 on the road this season, compared to their home record of 15-6...they won their last two road games on May 3 and 4 to finish the Boston series...a win in game one today would give them their first three-game road winning streak since taking three-straight at Texas, from August 15-17, 2024...two wins today would mark their first four-game road win-streak since April 26-May 10, 2024, when they won seven-straight.

☞ Over his last nine road games, Byron Buxton is hitting .385 (15-for-39) with one double, one triple, two home runs, five RBI, a .615 slugging percentage and a 1.020 OPS.

FEELING LIKE A MILLION BUX: Over his last 25 games, Byron Buxton has recorded multiple hits 13 times and is hitting .310 (31-for-100) with three doubles, three triples, seven home runs, 20 RBI, 20 runs scored, a .610 SLG and a .949 OPS in that span...Twins 16-9.

☞ Buck is leading off today for the eighth consecutive game...he has posted a .333 on-base percentage with a 1.064 OPS in those previous seven games.

RIP, RICH ROLLINS: Former Twin Rich Rollins passed away yesterday at age 87...Rollins was part of the first Twins team during the 1961 season and played eight years for Minnesota from 1961-68...he was named to the American League All-Star team in 1962.

THIS AND THAT:

☞ Trevor Larnach has hit safely in four-straight and in eight of his last nine...over his last 22 games, he has hit .291 (25-for-86) with three doubles, six home runs, 16 RBI, a .337 on-base percentage, a .535 slugging percentage and an .872 OPS.

☞ Brooks Lee is hitting .300 (6-for-20) with one double, one home run, four RBI and an .800 OPS in his last five games.

☞ Since April 8, Twins starters lead baseball in ERA (2.39), WHIP (1.04), BB% (5.4), opponent OPS (.612) and FIP (3.04)...third in K% (24.9).

- ☞ Making ninth start of the season and 97th career start...fifth start against the Orioles.
- ☞ Ober is 1-1 in four career starts against Baltimore, posting a 1.96 ERA (23.0 IP, 5 ER), with four walks, 23 strikeouts and a .224 (19-for-85) opponent batting average.
- ☞ Looks to earn his fifth consecutive win today...would be the first time in his career he would have a five-plus win streak.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on May 8 vs. the Orioles, opposite Dean Kremer...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-2 victory...allowed two runs on a season-high-tying eight hits, with one walk and a season-high-tying six strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work, ending his quality start streak at four games...runs came off an RBI double from Emmanuel Rivera, scoring Ramón Laureano and a sacrifice fly from Ryan Mountcastle, scoring Jackson Holliday; marked Ober's first unearned run allowed of the season...first time in his career Ober has allowed seven-plus hits in four consecutive starts...plunked Ryan O'Hearn in the fifth, his second hit batter of the season.

- ☞ Ober recorded five of his six strikeouts with runners in scoring position, and four came with a runner on third.
- ☞ Has not allowed a home run in four consecutive starts; the third time in his career, and the first time since April 8-26, 2024.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 3 vs. the Red Sox, opposite Hunter Dobbins...earned his fourth win of the season in Minnesota's 4-3 victory...first time earning four consecutive wins since July 28-August 9, 2024, and fifth time in his career...also recorded his fifth consecutive quality start, first time doing so since his career-best 11-game quality start streak from June 16-August 20, 2024...allowed one run on seven hits in 6.0 innings, with one walk and six strikeouts...lone run allowed came off an RBI single from Rafael Devers in the third, scoring Jarren Duran.

- ☞ In his first outing of the season, Bailey allowed eight runs in 2.2 innings...in the following six games, he allowed eight runs in 36.0 innings.

OPPOSITE THE ORIOLES: Ober is 1-1 in four career starts against Baltimore, posting a 1.96 ERA (23.0 IP, 5 ER), with four walks and 23 strikeouts...has a .224 (19-for-85) opponent batting average...1.96 is his third lowest ERA among teams he has faced at least three times, behind the Athletics (1.33) and the Boston Red Sox (1.57).

- ☞ Faced Baltimore in his last start on May 8, where he allowed two runs off eight hits, with one walk and six strikeouts...this is the ninth time in his career he faces an opponent in back-to-back starts, most recently June 16-22, 2024 vs. the Athletics.
- ☞ Sole start at Oriole Park at Camden Yards came July 1, 2023 where he earned the win in Minnesota's 1-0 victory...pitched 7.0 scoreless innings, allowing just two hits, with no walks and eight strikeouts.

☞ Bailey is 4-7 in 15 career starts against American League East opponents, posting a 2.49 ERA (83.0 IP, 23 ER) with 19 walks, 86 strikeouts, a .207 (63-for-305) opponent batting average and a .595 OPS...his ERA and OPS are his lowest among all divisions.

LEADING THE PACK: Since debuting with the Twins, Ober has had the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2021:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-9 with a 3.83 ERA (254.0 IP, 108 ER), 9.35 K/9, 2.20 BB/9 and 1.59 HR/9 in 49 games (48 starts) at home compared to 13-14 with a 3.80 ERA (265.1 IP, 112 ER), 8.85 K/9, 1.70 BB/9 and 1.26 HR/9 in 49 road starts.

- ☞ Ober is 2-1 in four starts on the road so far this season, posting a 4.43 ERA (22.1 IP, 11 ER), with five walks, 15 strikeouts and a .298 (28-for-94) opponent batting average.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through eight starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .284/.323/.375 in 88 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .300/.337/.511 in 90 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 86.8 mph and a whiff rate of 21.8 compared to righties' 92.0 mph and 38.9 percent.

- ☞ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at 27.4 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 55.7 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 38% of the time...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ☞ He currently ranks fifth in baseball for extension...ranks in the bottom three percent for max exit velocity at 116.6.
- ☞ His slider strikeout percentage is at an all-time low of 11.9 percent, while his sweeper is at an all-time high of 33.3 percent.

THRILL OF THE CHASE: Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 35.7 chase percentage this season, ranking in the 93rd percentile...ranks fourth on the Twins pitching staff, behind Danny Coulombe (40.7), Griffin Jax (40.1), and Louis Varland (35.9).

UNDER PRESSURE: This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .211 (8-for-38) with two home runs, three walks and 13 strikeouts; with runners in scoring position and two outs, opponents are hitting .059 (1-for-17) with two walks and five strikeouts.

FIXING THE FASTBALL: Through 2024, opponents were steadily hitting Ober's 4-seam fastball harder and more often than in previous seasons...through eight starts this season, Ober has lowered hard hit percentage and slugging percentage...here are some of his fastball numbers since his 2021 debut:

DOUBLEHEADERS: This marks Bailey's fourth start in a doubleheader, all in the first game...all three previous appearances came in 2024, where he went 2-1, allowing four runs on 12 hits (2 HR), with five walks and 23 strikeouts.

OUT OF THE WOODS: Last pitched on May 7 in his first career start against the Orioles at Target Field, opposite Charlie Morton...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-2 victory...allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with one walk and one strikeout in 4.2 innings of work...permitted a solo home run to Ramón Laureano in the third inning, and an RBI single to Heston Kjerstad, scoring Laureano in the fifth.

- ⚡ Has allowed a home run in each of his last six outings, the longest streak of his career, and tied for the longest active streak in baseball, with Cincinnati's Brady Singer (6 HR since April 11).

BACK FOR MORE?: Is facing the Baltimore Orioles for the second time in his career and second time in a row...this is the second time in his career he has faced the same opponent in back-to-back starts (also, Chicago White Sox, April 25-30, 2024)...in his last start he allowed two runs on five hits, with one walk, one strikeout and a .294 (5-for-17) opponent batting average in 4.2 innings.

- ⚡ SWR has posted a 5.79 ERA (18.2 IP, 12 ER), with six walks and 11 strikeouts in four career starts against American League East opponents...AL East batters are hitting .307 (23-for-75) against him...both his ERA and BAA against the AL East are his second-highest against any division, behind the National League East (seven games/five starts, 6.59 ERA, .313 BAA).

- ⚡ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 4-seam fastballs this season, SWR's 61.9 percent hard hit rate is the second highest in baseball, behind AJ Smith-Shawver (62.7).

NIGHTMARES: In 19 career night games (18 starts), Woods Richardson has posted a 4.95 ERA and a .264 opponent batting average, .421 slugging percentage, with 35 walks, 68 strikeouts and 12 home runs; compared to a 3.61 ERA, .241 opponent batting average, .391 slugging percentage with 30 walks, 88 strikeouts and 12 home runs in 18 day games (17 starts)...so far this season, SWR is 0-2 in four night games (3 starts), posting a 5.30 ERA (18.2 IP, 11 ER), with seven walks, 15 strikeouts and a .333 (25-for-75) opponent batting average.
