THE TWWWWWWWWWINS: Began their six-game roadtrip by sweeping their doubleheader in Baltimore yesterday...today, Minnesota will play the three-game series finale at Oriole Park...after today's game, they will travel to Milwaukee where they will play a three-game weekend series at American Family Field, with game one tomorrow night.
 ☞ Twins are 16-5 in their last 21 games since April 22...since that date, only Kansas City (16-6) has won as many games in all of baseball.
 ☞ Over the last 21 games, the Twins have a run differential of +44 (103-59)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

THE 'PEN AND THREE-RUN JIMMY JACKS LEAD TWINS TO SWEEP OF DAY: The Twins swept their doubleheader with the Orioles yesterday, winning by scores of 6-3 and 8-6...marked the Twins' third consecutive doubleheader sweep in Baltimore since 2008...also their eighth series win.
 ☞ Bailey Ober was the game one starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing three runs on two hits in 4.2 innings pitched, with three walks and three strikeouts...the bullpen combined to pitch 4.1 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, three walks and seven strikeouts...Christian Vázquez had the go-ahead RBI with a three-run homer in the fourth inning.
 ☞ Simeon Woods Richardson was the starter but did not factor into the decision in game two, allowing six runs on eight hits in 4.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...the 'pen combined for 5.0 scoreless innings, with three hits allowed and no walks...Kody Clemens highlighted the offense, hitting a go-ahead three-run homer in the eighth inning.

PERFECT 10: Twins enter today with a 10-game winning streak, the longest in baseball this season...their last loss was a 6-1 defeat on May 2 at Boston...below are the Twins' longest winning streaks (since 1961):

ROSTER MOVE: The Twins announced today that they have optioned right-handed pitcher Simeon Woods Richardson to Triple-A St. Paul...Woods Richardson made seven starts, eight appearances for the Twins this season, going 2-2, 5.02 ERA (37.2 IP, 21 ER), 14 walks, 35 strikeouts, eight home runs allowed and a .295 opponent batting average...to replace Woods Richardson, left-handed pitcher Kody Funderburk will remain on the active 26-man roster...Funderburk was added as the 27th man for yesterday's doubleheader and pitched 1.1 scoreless innings of relief in game two, earning the win.

BIRD BITS: The Twins and Orioles are playing each other today for the sixth and final time this season...yesterday's game one win secured the season series over Baltimore, their first since 2022 (4-3), after going 0-6 last season and 2-4 in 2023.
 ☞ Twins have scored 33 runs against the Orioles this season...they entered 2025 having scored just 22 runs in their previous 11 games against Baltimore.
 ☞ Twins are seeking their first six-game winning streak against the O's since March 31, 2018-May 31, 2021, when they won 16-straight over Baltimore.
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .346 (18-for-52) with five doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI and a .986 OPS in his last 12 games at Camden Yards...he has reached safely in all of those 12.
 ☞ Trevor Larnach is hitting .313 (10-for-32) with three doubles, three walks and a .371 on-base percentage in 10 career games at Oriole Park.
 ☞ Ryan Jeffers is hitting .333 (12-for-36) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs, eight RBI, a .639 slugging percentage and a 1.054 OPS in 10 career games at Camden Yards.

THE FLOOR HAS BEEN DIRTY LATELY: Minnesota is seeking its fourth sweep of the season today...the other three came April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field, May 6-8 vs. Baltimore at Target Field and May 9-11 vs. San Francisco at Target Field...Twins had five sweeps all of '24.
 ☞ Minnesota's last sweep at Camden Yards came in three games from April 20-21, 2019.
 ☞ Minnesota's last road sweep came April 20-May 1, 2024 at Rate Field against the White Sox (3 games).
 ☞ The Twins have four times this season entered a series finale with a chance to sweep, going 3-1 in those instances...their one miss was the finale against Chicago-AL on April 24.

CLOSING ACTS: The Twins bullpen pitched 9.1 scoreless innings yesterday, allowing five hits, walking three and striking out 10...since the start of their last fhomestand, on May 6, they have gone 5-0, 0.30 ERA (30.1 IP, 1 ER) with no home runs allowed, seven walks, 35 strikeouts and a .176 opponent batting average...on the season, they rank fifth in baseball in ERA (3.08).

BIRTHDAY...TRIPLETS?: Twins infielder Kody Clemens is celebrating his 29th birthday today, Twins Hall of Famer and Twins.TV analyst Justin Morneau is celebrating his 44th birthday and former Twin Brian Dozier is celebrating his 38th birthday today...Morneau's four homers on his birthday are most in Twins/Senators history...Clemens has played in one major league game on his birthday, going 0-for-1 with a strikeout on May 15, 2023.

MIÇ DROPS: Orioles-related notes on Twins radio analyst Glen Perkins and Twins.TV analyst LaTroy Hawkins.

☞ Perkins made his second and third career appearances in this ballpark on September 23-24, 2006, pitching 0.2 innings in the first game and 0.0 IP with one hit allowed in the second game...Perk earned his second-to-last career win at Camden on August 23, 2015 in a Twins 4-3 12-inning victory...he pitched the 11th inning as the Twins took the lead, then proven closer Tommy Milone saved the game in the 12th.

☞ Hawkins pitched one season for the Orioles in 2006...in 30 games at Camden Yards that season, he posted a 2.81 ERA (32.0 IP, 10 ER) with seven holds...Hawk made his major league debut against the Orioles on April 29, 1995 at the Metrodome...his first career appearance in this ballpark came in his eighth career game on April 13, 1996...his second-to-last major league appearance was here, on September 30, 2015 with Toronto...the final two strikeouts of his career were here, fanning Jimmy Paredes and Ryan Flaherty.

- ☞ Making his ninth start of the season and the 91st of his career (94th appearance).
- ☞ Earned his first victory of the season in his last outing on May 9 vs. San Francisco at Target Field, allowing one run on three hits (1 HR) over 7.1 quality innings, walking none and striking out six.
- ☞ Is facing Baltimore for the fourth time in his career and the third time at Oriole Park at Camden Yards; is 2-1 with a 6.19 ERA (16.0 IP, 11 ER), two home runs, four walks and 10 strikeouts.
- ☞ This season, is 0-1 with a 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP, 14 ER), five home runs, eight walks and 12 strikeouts in four road starts.

LAST TIME OUT: Earned the 3-1 victory vs. San Francisco on May 9 at Target Field opposite Jordan Hicks, allowing one run on three hits (1 HR) over 7.1 innings, walking none and striking out six... marked his first win of the season and his first since June 10, 2024 vs. Colorado...retired the first 17 batters of the game in order, avoiding a base runner until Christian Koss's two-out single in the sixth; combined with the final eight batters he retired in his May 4 start at Boston, retired 25-straight hitters from May 4-9...lone run allowed came via a solo home run to Matt Chapman in the seventh.

☞ Struck out the side in order in the third inning, his first 1-2-3 inning via strikeouts since the bottom of the third on June 5, 2024 at Yankee Stadium; since joining the Twins in 2022, Paddack has struck out the side in order just four times, compared to seven times with the Padres (2019-21).

☞ Marked the 20th start of his career in which he did not allow a walk...was the fourth time in his career without a walk in an outing of 7.0-or-more innings.

TWO STARTS AGO: Did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 5-4 victory on May 4 at Fenway Park; marked the first time that Minnesota has won a game that Paddack started since July 8, 2024 at Chicago-AL...opposite Boston's Garrett Crochet, Paddack allowed three runs on five hits over 5.0 innings of work, with two walks and two strikeouts...retired the final eight batters he faced in order, from the third-fifth innings.

☞ Walked Alex Bregman to lead off the third inning, who later scored on Romy González's sacrifice fly...was the seventh time this season that a runner has scored after being walked by Paddack (3x on 3/31, 1x on 4/6, 4/12, 4/24, 5/4).

MOVING FORWARD: Since opening the season with a nine-run, three homer outing at Chicago-AL, Paddack has posted a 2.97 ERA (36.1 IP, 12 ER) with 12 walks and 28 strikeouts in his last seven starts...in that span, opponents are slashing .218/.275/.323 with two doubles and four home runs in 133 at-bats against Paddack.

RIDIN' WITH THE SHERIFF: After starting the season with a combined 7.1 innings in two outings, Paddack has gone 5.0-or-more innings in six consecutive starts...is the fourth-longest streak of his career, his high being nine straight (April 16-May 30, 2024)...his start on May 9 vs. San Francisco marked the second time this season that a Twins starter has pitched into the eighth inning; Bailey Ober went 7.2 innings in Cleveland on April 28...was just Paddack's third time going 7.0-or-more innings and his fifth quality start since joining the Twins in 2022.

☞ Prior to his 83-pitch start on May 9, the last Minnesota Twin to go 7.1-or-more innings with 85-or-fewer pitches was Scott Diamond on June 24, 2012 (82 pitches, 8.0 innings)...marks the first time in his career that Paddack has done so, with his closest effort being a 7.0-inning, 83-pitch start on April 24, 2019, the fifth game of his major league career.

FACING THE ORIOLES: In three career games against the O's (one with San Diego and two with Minnesota), he is 2-1 with a 6.19 ERA (16.0 IP, 11 ER), two home runs, four walks and 10 strikeouts...has gone 5.1 innings in each of his starts...in his most recent outing on April 16, 2024 in Baltimore, he took the loss, allowing nine runs on 12 hits (both career highs), with two homers, one walk and two strikeouts; the Twins lost 11-3...prior to the start, Paddack had allowed just two runs on a combined seven hits with no home runs over 10.2 innings against the Orioles.

☞ Has a .279 (19-for-68) opponent batting average vs. Baltimore, with a .324 on-base percentage and a .736 OPS.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In four road starts this season, is 0-1 with a 6.87 ERA (18.1 IP, 14 ER), five home runs, eight walks and 12 strikeouts, compared to 1-2 with a 2.95 ERA (21.1 P, 7 ER), two home runs, eight walks and 18 strikeouts in four starts at home...since his start at Chicago-AL on March 31, he has a 3.00 ERA (15.0 IP, 5 ER) on the road, with a .218 (12-for-55) opponent batting average...since joining the Twins in 2022, is 3-4 with a 5.82 ERA (72.2 IP, 47 ER) over 15 appearances on the road (14 starts)...in that span, is averaging 9.54 hits-per-nine innings with a 1.35 WHIP on the road, compared to 9.91 H/9 and a 1.33 WHIP in 18 home appearances (16 starts).

☞ In his career, Paddack is 11-14 with a 4.69 ERA (234.0 IP, 122 ER) with 55 walks and 213 strikeouts over 47 road appearances (46 starts).

☞ Including today, all three of his starts as a Twin will have come at Oriole Park at Camden Yards...the O's are slashing .340/.373/.532 with a double, a triple, two home runs, two walks and five strikeouts in 47 at-bats against him at Camden Yards.

PLATOON SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters are batting .182 (12-for-66) with three home runs, eight walks, 10 strikeouts and seven RBI against Paddack, while righties are batting .280 (23-for-82) with four home runs, eight walks, 20 strikeouts and 15 RBI...in his career, lefties are slashing .240/.288/.415 with 36 home runs and 3.31 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Paddack, while righties are slashing .260/.298/.440 with 38 home runs and 5.84 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

☞ Baltimore's lefties are slashing .333/.378/.452 with one home run, two walks and five strikeouts in 42 at-bats against Paddack, while righties are slashing .192/.241/.346 with one home run, two walks and five strikeouts in 26 at-bats against him.

THE ARSENAL: In 2025, Paddack has relied on a four-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

☞ With 690 pitches thrown so far this season, he has a 17.6 percent strikeout rate and a 9.4 percent walk rate...batters are chasing 28.9 percent of the time and whiffing 19.7 percent of the time, while hitting the ball hard 42.7 percent of the time with an average exit velocity of 90.5 mph.

☞ Prior to his recent start, Paddack's pitch velocity had not topped 96.0 mph since April 18 at Atlanta...on May 9, he threw five pitches over 96.0 mph and topped out at 96.6 mph; his average velocity on the day was 90.4 mph, his first start averaging 90-or-more mph this season and first time since August 30, 2021 with the Padres at Arizona (92.1 mph).

- 2025 marks his ninth professional season and fourth with the Twins...is seeking his first unabridged major league season since his rookie year in 2019.
- Finished 2024 season on 15-day IL with a right shoulder strain, retroactive July 20.
