THE TWWWWWWWWWINS: Began their six-game roadtrip with a three-game sweep of the Orioles at Camden Yards this week, taking both games of a doubleheader Wednesday (rainout Tuesday) and the finale yesterday...tonight, Minnesota will continue the trip with the first of three against Milwaukee over the weekend.
 ☞ Twins are 17-5 in their last 22 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to that date, the Twins began the season 7-15.
 ☞ Over the last 22 games, the Twins have a run differential of +48 (107-59)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

SHERIFF ROLLS THROUGH AND SHUTS IT DOWN: The Twins shut out the Orioles yesterday afternoon in Baltimore by a score of 4-0, their third shutout of the season and second on the road (4-0, 4/9 at KC)...the win marked their fourth sweep of the season and third consecutively...Chris Paddack (2-3) was the starter and winner, pitching 7.0 shutout innings, with three hits allowed, one walk and three strikeouts on 89 pitches...the offense recorded seven hits, two apiece from Willi Castro and Royce Lewis...DaShawn Keirse Jr. hit his first home run of the season and Byron Buxton followed with his 10th — Minnesota's first back-to-back homers of 2025...Buxton and Carlos Correa each exited the game early after a collision on a pop-up in short rightfield, both entering MLB's concussion protocol.

BALDELLI'S 11: Twins enter today with an 11-game winning streak, the longest in baseball this season...their last loss was a 6-1 defeat on May 2 at Boston (exactly 2 weeks ago)...below are the Twins' longest winning streaks (since 1961):

☞ Last time an MLB team had winning streaks of 12+ games in consecutive seasons was Cleveland, winning 14 in 2016 and 22 in 2017 (Elias Sports Bureau).

I WANNA GET STREAKY WITH YOU: In 2024, the Twins started 7-13 before winning 12-straight...this season, they started 13-20 before winning 11-straight...they become the first team in baseball history to be below .500 then reel off 10-straight wins in consecutive seasons.

THE OTHER GUYS: Twins have gone 5-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20) and 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11)...Twins are 5-3 after starting 0-4 vs. NL teams.
 ☞ After their sweep of San Francisco, they have now won three-straight and are seeking their first four-game winning streak against NL opponents since September 19-30, 2023 (also 4).

THE MOLITOR CUP: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the first of six games this season...Minnesota will host the Brewers for a three-game weekend series from June 20-22...the Twins went 1-3 against the Brewers last season, going 1-1 at American Family Field, from April 2-3 and 0-2 at Target Field, from July 20-21.
 ☞ The Twins are 243-236 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 70-62 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998.
 ☞ Since 2020, the Twins have hit 33 home runs in 24 games against the Brewers, their most against any NL opponent...20 of those have come at American Family Field, also their most for an opposing NL ballpark.
 ☞ Willi Castro is a career .390 (16-for-41) hitter with three doubles, two triples, five RBI, eight runs scored and a .996 OPS in 14 games against the Brewers.
 ☞ Harrison Bader has 53 career hits against the Brewers (73 games), his second-most against any opponent (66 vs. CHC).
 ☞ Christian Vazquez is hitting .300 (9-for-30) with three doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks and an .853 OPS in 10 career games vs. the Crew.

HEADLINERS: The Twins' bullpen finished the three-game series in Baltimore with 11.1 scoreless innings, eight hits allowed, three walks and 13 strikeouts...since the start of their last homestand, on May 6, they have gone 5-0, 0.28 ERA (32.1 IP, 1 ER) with no home runs allowed, seven walks, 38 strikeouts and a .188 opponent batting average in nine games...their one earned run allowed during this stretch was an Heliot Ramos eighth inning RBI-single off Griffin Jax on May 11 vs. San Francisco...they also allowed an unearned run during this stretch, in that same game when Jhoan Duran allowed the ghost runner on second to score in the 10th.

LARNING TO FLY: Over his last seven games, Trevor Larnach is hitting .333 (10-for-30) with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .733 slugging percentage and a 1.088 OPS...in that same span, against right-handed pitching, he is hitting .375 (9-for-24) with an .833 slugging percentage and a 1.233 OPS.
 ☞ Against right-handed pitching since April 22, he is slashing .299/.356/.612 (.968 OPS).

DO YOU EVEN LIFT, BRO?: Twins have homered in five-straight games, one short of their season-long of six, done May 2-8...additionally, they have homered multiple times in each of their last three games (2, 3, 2 at BAL)...the last time the Twins had multiple homers in four-straight was September 11-14, 2023 (also four-straight).

IN THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 2010, Jason Kubel hit an eighth-inning grand slam off Mariano Rivera for a 6-3 win at new Yankee Stadium...Rivera had converted a record-tying 51-consecutive save opportunities at home and had not given up a grand slam since 2002, the runs were also the first he allowed that season.

HBD, BLACK JACK: Hall of Famer Jack Morris is celebrating his 70th birthday today...during his 18-year major league career, he pitched one game on his birthday, that coming in 1987, pitching a complete game over Cleveland at Tiger Stadium, allowing three runs on five hits with 11 strikeouts...he shares a birthday with University of Minnesota baseball coach John Anderson (70).

- ☞ Making his ninth start of 2025 and the 93rd of his career...earned his third win of the season in his last outing on May 10 vs. San Francisco, allowing one run on two hits (1 HR), walking none and striking out seven; Twins won 2-1.
- ☞ Is decision-less in two career starts vs. Milwaukee, with a 3.97 ERA (11.1 IP, 5 ER), two home runs, two walks and 11 strikeouts; both starts have come at Target Field.
- ☞ In four Interleague starts this season, is 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER), four home runs, three walks and 25 strikeouts.
- ☞ Among qualified American League pitchers entering today, he ranks 10th in ERA (2.74), 8th in BAA (.196), 4th in K/9.0 IP (10.56), 3rd in K/BB (10.8) and tied for 2nd in WHIP (0.83).

LAST TIME OUT: Earned his third win of the season on May 10 vs. San Francisco, opposite Logan Webb...was originally scheduled to pitch on May 8 vs. Baltimore but was scratched due to illness...allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) over 6.0 quality innings, with no walks and seven strikeouts...lone run surrendered came on Heliot Ramos's solo home run in the second inning; was the only baserunner Ryan allowed through his first four innings.

- ☞ His 76 pitches thrown were his fewest of the season and his fewest in a 6.0-or-more inning start since September 1, 2023 at Texas (74 pitches, 6.0 IP).
- ☞ Marked the first time in his career that he's allowed seven home runs through his first eight starts of a season (6 in 2024, 4 in 2023, 2 in 2022).

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 2 at Fenway Park opposite Boston's Brayan Bello...did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-1 loss to the Red Sox; Ryan exited the game in a 1-1 tie before the Twins' bullpen surrendered five runs in the seventh and eighth innings...allowed one run on four hits (1 HR), with one walk and eight strikeouts over 6.0 quality innings.

- ☞ First-inning solo home run allowed to Alex Bregman was just the 15th opening-inning home run surrendered by Ryan in his career.

FACING THE BREWERS: In two career starts against the Brewers, has posted a 3.97 ERA (11.1 IP, 5 ER) with two home runs, two walks and nine strikeouts; the Twins are 1-1 while Ryan is seeking his first decision...is making his first appearance at American Family Field...his most recent start came on July 21, 2024 at Target Field, allowed four runs on seven hits while walking none and striking out six over 6.0 innings; Eric Haase drove in two on a solo home run and an RBI single, while Jackson Chourio doubled in the other pair of runs.

INTERLEAGUE ACTION: In four starts against the National League this season, Ryan is 1-1 with a 3.86 ERA (21.0 IP, 9 ER), four home runs, three walks and 25 strikeouts...in his career, he is 7-9 with a 5.55 ERA (118.1 IP, 73 ER), 30 home runs and a 4.52 strikeout-to-walk ratio in 23 Interleague starts...in that span, NL batters are slashing .255/.307/.521 in 466 at-bats against Ryan.

- ☞ Ryan is facing the National League Central for the second time this season and the 11th time in his career...is 2-4 with a 4.47 ERA (50.1 IP, 25 ER), a .219 (41-for-187) opponent batting average and a 5.36 strikeout-to-walk ratio over 10 career starts; the Twins are 3-7...Ryan has allowed a home run in seven of his 10 career starts against the NL Central.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his fifth road start of the year...is 1-1 with a 3.13 ERA (23.0 IP, 8 ER), four home runs, two walks and 22 strikeouts, compared to 2-1 with a 2.35 ERA (23.0 IP, 6 ER), three home runs, three walks and 32 strikeouts in four home starts...in his career, is 15-15 in 45 road starts with a 4.05 ERA (246.2 IP, 111 ER), a 1.11 WHIP and a 4.91 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ☞ In his four road starts this season, opposing batters are slashing .218/.261/.391 in 87 at-bats.
- ☞ In six career starts in NL Central ballparks, Ryan is 1-3 with a 5.46 ERA (28.0 IP, 17 ER), a .238 (25-for-105) opponent batting average and a 5.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio...Milwaukee is the only NL Central team that Ryan has not faced on the road (2x at Chicago and St. Louis, 1x at Pittsburgh and Cincinnati).

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .208/.240/.333 with three doubles, two home runs, one walk and 15 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .188/.243/.385 with four doubles, five home runs, four walks and 39 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .207/.266/.360 with 63 walks and 224 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .234/.277/.446 with 51 walks and 355 strikeouts.

- ☞ In his two career starts against the Brewers, lefties have slashed .167/.250/.333 in 18 at-bats with two walks and two strikeouts, while righties have slashed .250/.250/.458 in 24 at-bats, with no walks and seven strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through eight starts in 2025, Ryan has relied on a five-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

Note: Ryan struck out Kyren Paris in the sixth inning on 4/27 vs. LAA...the pitch type of the third strike has not been specified by Savant.

- ☞ With 709 pitches thrown this season, Ryan's chase rate is 27.4 percent and his whiff rate is 30.0 percent...his walk rate is 2.8 percent and his strikeout rate is 30.3 percent...his average exit velocity is 90.4 mph while his hard hit rate is 43.9 percent.

A GIANT RECOVERY: After missing his scheduled start on May 8 vs. Baltimore with illness, Ryan averaged 90.2 mph over 76 pitches on May 10 vs. the Giants...marked the fourth time this season and second consecutive time he's averaged 90.0-plus mph in an outing (90.6 mph on 5/2)...against San Francisco, he used his four-seamer 72.4 percent of the time with an average velocity of 92.3 mph; during his 1-2-3 first inning, his fastball ranged from 93.2-94.6 mph.

- ☞ His perceived velocity was 90.9, his third highest in a start this season (91.4 mph on 5/2, 91.0 mph on 3/29).
- ☞ His 35.3 percent whiff rate was his second highest in a start this season (46.4% on 4/27).

TAKE A WALK: Ryan has not given up a walk in 23 of his 92 career starts; ranks tied for 22nd in Twins history (1961-present) for the most starts without a free pass allowed...only two other Twins starters have allowed fewer walks than Ryan (114) through the first 92 starts of their career: Bailey Ober walked 108 and Kevin Tapani walked 110.

- ☞ Since 2000, only 10 major league starters, including Ryan, have allowed 114-or-fewer walks through their first 92 starts...of such pitchers, Ryan's 579 strikeouts are the most, his 429 hits allowed are the second fewest behind Ober (422) and his 3.82 ERA is the fourth lowest.

TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2025: 3-2, 2.77 ERA // CAREER: 57-51, 3.86 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is set to start tomorrow night's game against the Brewers at American Family Field...last pitched on May 11 vs. the Giants at Target Field and did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 extra-inning walk-off win; allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR) with two walks and six strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work...has faced the Brewers eight times in his career, going 1-1 with a 3.07 ERA (44.0 IP, 15 ER), three homers, 13 walks and 49 strikeouts...is making his third career start in Milwaukee and his first since joining the Twins in 2023.
