**THE TWWWWWWWWWWWINS:** Have gone 4-0 through four games on their six-game roadtrip, going 3-0 at Baltimore from Tuesday-Thursday, followed by a win in Milwaukee last night... tonight, the Twins will play the second of three at American Family Field... they will complete the series and trip tomorrow before returning home for a six games in seven days homestand... they will host the Guardians from Monday-Wednesday, enjoy an off day on Thursday, then play the Royals for three next weekend.

☞ Twins are 18-5 in their last 23 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date... prior to that date, the Twins began the season 7-15.

☞ Over the last 23 games, the Twins have a run differential of +51 (110-59)... they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

☞ Last night's win moved the Twins out of fourth place and into third place for the first time since April 6.

**12-PACK OF MILWAUKEE'S BEST:** The Twins shut out the Brewers last night at American Family Field, winning by a score of 3-0... Joe Ryan (4-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 innings, with two hits allowed, one walk and nine strikeouts... Brock Stewart, Griffin Jax and Cole Sands combined for 3.0 scoreless innings of relief... the offense recorded nine hits and scored all three of their runs in the first two innings... Ty France drove in his 22nd run of the season and Kody Clemens drove in his seventh — both on singles.

☞ Marked the Twins fourth shutout of the season, second on this trip (Thursday at BAL).

☞ Marked their third win when scoring under four runs (3-17)... all three wins have come during this streak.

☞ Twins pitchers extended their scoreless inning streak to 24.1, their last runs allowed came in the third inning of game 2 on Tuesday at Baltimore, when the Orioles scored six... it marks their longest streak since 31.2 in August of 2022.

**A BALDELLI DOZEN:** Twins enter today with a 12-game winning streak, the longest in baseball since the Dodgers' 13-win streak from September 25, 2024-April 2, 2025 and longest single-season streak since the Rays' 13-win streak from March 30-April 13, 2023... Minnesota's last loss was a 6-1 defeat on May 2 at Boston... below are the Twins' longest winning streaks (since 1961):

☞ Last time an MLB team had winning streaks of 12-plus games in consecutive seasons was Cleveland, winning 14 in 2016 and 22 in 2017 (*Elias Sports Bureau*)... marks the 12th time in MLB history for a team to win 12-plus consecutively.

☞ The last three teams with a 12-plus game winning streak in back-to-back seasons in MLB, NBA, NFL or NHL: Warriors (2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17), Guardians (2016-17), Twins (2024-25).

**ABOUT THAT...:** Misc. numbers over the 12-game winning streak:

☞ Twins have hit .303 (27-for-89) with runners in scoring position.

☞ Twins pitching staff has posted a 2.23 ERA (109.0 IP, 27 ER) with 23 walks, 116 strikeouts and a .212 opponent batting average.

☞ Twins starters have gone 6-0, 3.11 ERA (66.2 IP, 23 ER) with 15 walks, 64 strikeouts and a .217 opponent batting average.

☞ The Twins' bullpen has gone 6-0, 0.85 ERA (42.1 IP, 4 ER) with nine saves (10 opportunities), one home run, eight walks, 52 strikeouts and a .205 opponent batting average.

**NATIONAL NEWS:** Twins have gone 6-7 in Interleague Play this season, going 0-3 at St. Louis (March 27-30), 2-1 vs. New York-NL (April 14-16), 0-3 at Atlanta (April 18-20), 3-0 vs. San Francisco (May 9-11) and 1-0 at Milwaukee... Twins are 6-3 after starting 0-4 vs. NL teams.

☞ They have now won four straight against NL opponents for the first time since September 19-30, 2023 (also 4)... last time they won five straight was July 28-August 5, 2020 (also 5).

**THE MOLITOR CUP:** The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the second of six games this season... Minnesota will host the Brewers for a three-game weekend series from June 20-22... Twins seeking back-to-back wins vs. Milwaukee for first time since June of 2023.

☞ The Twins are 244-236 all-time against the Brewers (since 1970) and are 71-62 against them in Interleague Play, since Milwaukee's move to the NL in 1998.

☞ Harrison Bader has 53 career hits against the Brewers (73 games), his second-most against any opponent (66 vs. CHC).

☞ Christian Vazquez is hitting .324 (11-for-34) with four doubles, one home run, five RBI, three walks and an .898 OPS in 11 career games vs. the Crew.

**SERIES-LY SPEAKING:** Twins are seeking their ninth series win today... they are 8-6-0 in series play, going 5-2-0 at home and 3-4-0 on the road... they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 7-2-0 in their last nine and are seeking their fifth straight.

☞ A win today would give the Twins their first series win over the Brewers since sweeping them in two games at Target Field from June 13-14, 2023... their last series win in Milwaukee came April 1-4, 2021, winning two of three.

**PITCH PERFECT:** Over four games on the roadtrip, the Twins' bullpen has thrown 14.1 scoreless innings, with 11 hits allowed, three walks and 20 strikeouts... since the start of their last homestand, on May 6, they have gone 5-0, 0.25 ERA (35.1 IP, 1 ER) with no home runs allowed, seven walks, 45 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 10 games... their one earned run allowed during this stretch was an Heliot Ramos eighth-inning RBI-single off Griffin Jax on May 11 vs. San Francisco... they also allowed an unearned run during this stretch, in that same game when Jhoan Duran allowed the ghost runner on second to score in the 10th.

**HARRI, I TOOK CARE OF IT!** Harrison Bader has reached base safely in a career-high 16-straight games... during the streak, he is hitting .396 (19-for-48) with five doubles, one home run, six RBI, seven walks, a .473 on-base percentage, a .563 slugging percentage and a 1.035 OPS... over the stretch, he is hitting .350 (14-for-40) with an .885 OPS against right-handed pitching.

⚡ Making eighth start of the season and 166th career start...eighth career start against the Brewers.  
 ⚡ López is 1-1 in seven career starts against Milwaukee, posting a 3.07 ERA (44.0 IP, 15 ER), with 13 walks, 49 strikeouts and a .175 (27-for-154) opponent batting average.  
 ⚡ Did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 7-6 victory over the Giants in his last start on May 11...allowed four runs on five hits (1 HR), with two walks and six strikeouts in 6.0 innings.

**LIFE OF PABLO:** Last pitched on May 11 at Target Field vs. the Giants, opposite Landen Roupp; did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 10-inning, walk-off win...allowed four runs on five hits, two walks and six strikeouts over 6.0 innings...allowed a season-high four earned runs; two sacrifice flies, from Heliot Ramos and Jung Hoo Lee, and a home run from Ramos scoring Matt Chapman... after allowing two hits and one walk in the first, Pablo then went on to retire eight-straight batters in the first through fourth innings.

⚡ Marked his fifth-straight outing with six-or-more strikeouts, the fifth time in his career accomplishing such a streak, and first time since April 23-May 9, 2024...career-high is nine consecutive starts, accomplished twice.  
 ⚡ This is the first time Pablo has recorded a 6.0-plus inning game that was not a quality start since April 28, 2023 vs. Kansas City where he allowed six earned runs in 6.0 innings...he has only had five total non-quality start, 6.0-plus innings in his career.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Pitched on May 6 at Target Field vs. the Orioles, opposite Cade Povich...allowed one run on two hits, one walk and 11 strikeouts over 5.0 innings...allowed two or less hits for the first time since June 23, 2024...lone run allowed came off an RBI double from Ryan Mountcastle, scoring Gunnar Henderson.

⚡ Recorded double digit strikeouts for the 10th time in his career...first time registering 11-plus strikeouts since June 23, 2024.  
 ⚡ 18 total batters faced are the fewest by a Twin in a 10-plus strikeout game since Joe Ryan faced 18 while striking out 11 on September 22, 2021 at Chicago-NL.

**MEETING MILWAUKEE:** López is 1-1 in seven career starts against the Brewers, posting a 3.07 ERA (44.0 IP, 15 ER), with 13 walks and 49 strikeouts...has a .175 (27-for-154) opponent batting average..

⚡ Faced Milwaukee just one time in 2024 where he allowed one run four hits, with one walk and seven strikeouts in an 8-4 Twins loss on July 20 at Target Field...is 1-0 in two career starts at American Family Field, posting a 0.00 ERA (13.0 IP, 0 ER), with four walks and 14 strikeouts... has a .119 (5-for-42) in that ballpark.  
 ⚡ Pablo's .175 opponent batting average against the Brewers is his second-lowest among teams he has faced at least twice, behind only the Orioles (.152)...also his third lowest all-time behind the Orioles and Miami Marlins (.136) who he has faced just once...his .119 opponent batting average at American Family Field is his lowest among any ballpark.

**ACE UP OUR SLEEVE:** Since joining the Twins, López has had the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2023:

**HOMESICK:** Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 15-8 with a 3.86 ERA (207.1 IP, 89 ER), 10.42 K/9, 2.00 BB/9 and 0.95 HR/9 in 35 starts at home, compared to 16-12 with a 3.50 ERA (223.2 IP, 87 ER), 9.86 K/9, 2.13 BB/9 and 1.25 HR/9 in 38 road starts.

⚡ In his last five starts on the road, dating back to September 22, 2024, López has gone 1-3, posting a 4.00 ERA (27.0 IP, 12 ER), with three walks and 23 strikeouts; compared to 3-1, 2.83 ERA (28.2 IP, 9 ER), with nine walks and 41 strikeouts in his last five home starts, dating back to September 10, 2024.

**LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS:** Through seven starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .256/.289/.359 in 78 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .164/.208/.269 in 67 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 88.0 mph and a whiff rate of 24.0 compared to righties' 87.8 mph and 29.1 percent.

⚡ He has a 31.1 percent hard hit rate against right-handed batters, and an all-time high hard hit rate of 40.7 against left-handed batters.

**COOL UNDER PRESSURE:** With runners in scoring position, López has a .246 (180-for-732) opponent batting average...with a runner on third, he puts up a .220 (20-for-91) opponent batting average and with runners on second and third, he allows just a .185 (10-for-54) opponent batting average.

**THE ARSENAL:** López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 43% of the time, the highest of his career...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

⚡ Currently ranks in the 96th percentile for fastball run value and 89th for breaking run value; compared to sixth percentile for offspeed run value.  
 ⚡ Ranks in the 92nd percentile for extension and bottom three percent in max exit velocity at 116.5 mph.  
 ⚡ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sweepers, Pablo ranks 14th in strikeout percentage at 35.5 percent.  
 ⚡ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 50 sinkers, López is tied for first in put away percentage (50.0) with Luis L. Ortiz, eighth in whiff percentage (29.6) and eighth in opponent batting average (.100).

**WALK THIS WAY:** Pablo's 4.5 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 90th percentile...he ranks third on the Twins pitching staff behind Joe Ryan (3.0%) and Danny Coulombe (3.3%)...his walk rate is at an all-time career low, with his average in the previous seven years being six percent.

**Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE:** This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund...with 43 strikeouts this season, he has donated \$43,000 so far.
