THE TWWWWWWWWWWWINS: Have gone 5-0 through five games on their six-game roadtrip, going 3-0 at Baltimore from Tuesday-Thursday, followed by consecutive wins in Milwaukee the last two nights...today, the Twins will play the three-game series finale at American Family Field...after today's game, they will travel home for a six games in seven days homestand...they will host the Guardians from Monday-Wednesday, enjoy an off day on Thursday, then play the Royals for three next weekend.
 ☞ Twins are 19-5 in their last 24 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to that date, the Twins began the season 7-15.
 ☞ Over the last 24 games, the Twins have a run differential of +58 (117-59)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.
 ☞ The Twins moved into second place in the division for the first time since April 5.

"THAT MAKES A BAKER'S DOZEN FOR ME": The Twins shut out the Brewers last night at American Family Field by a score of 7-0, their third consecutive shutout, tying a club record, previously done from July 5-7, 2004...Pablo Lopez (4-2) was the starter and winner, pitching 6.0 innings, with two hits allowed, two walks and six strikeouts...the offense recorded a season-high 18 hits as six players had multi-hit games...Ryan Jeffers set a career high with four hits and Kody Clemens tied his career high with three hits...Jeffers and Clemens each hit their third home run of the season, both solo shots.

BALDELLI'S 13: Twins enter today with a 13-game winning streak, the longest in baseball since the Dodgers' 13-win streak from September 25, 2024-April 2, 2025 and longest single-season streak since the Rays' 13-win streak from March 30-April 13, 2023...the last MLB team to reach 14-straight wins was Seattle, from July 2-17, 2022...Minnesota's last loss was a 6-1 defeat on May 2 at Boston...below are the Twins' longest winning streaks (since 1961):

TWINS CALL ON M & M BOYS: The Twins have recalled right-handed pitcher Zebby Matthews and selected the contract of outfielder Carson McCusker from Triple-A St. Paul.

☞ Matthews has made seven starts for the Saints this season, going 2-1, 1.93 ERA (32.2 IP, 7 ER), nine walks, 38 strikeouts and a 1.19 WHIP...Matthews, who made his major league debut in 2024, started nine games for the Twins from August 13-September 28 last year, going 1-4, 6.69 ERA (37.2 IP, 28 ER), 11 walks, 43 strikeouts and a 10.3 strikeouts-per-innings pitched ratio...he was named Jim Rantz Award winner as Twins minor league Pitcher of the Year after going 6-3 with a 2.60 ERA (97.0 IP, 28 ER), seven walks, 114 strikeouts, a .212 opponent batting average and a 0.87 WHIP in 18 games (17 starts) in the 2024 minor league season, split among High-A Cedar Rapids (4 games/starts), Double-A Wichita (10 games/9 starts) and Triple-A St. Paul (4 games/starts).
 ☞ McCusker has played in 38 games for the Saints this season, hitting .350 (48-for-137) with 11 doubles, 10 home runs, 36 RBI, 23 runs scored, 13 walks, a .412 on-base percentage and a 1.061 OPS. Defensively at St. Paul, he has played 30 games in rightfield and four games in leftfield...the Sparks, Nevada native was originally drafted by the Milwaukee Brewers in the 26th round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft out of community college but elected to continue playing at Oklahoma State University...he was signed by the Twins as a minor league free agent in June of 2023 and has played three seasons in their minor league system, hitting .290 (224-for-772) with 47 doubles, four triples, 43 home runs, 147 RBI, 120 runs scored, a .358 on-base percentage, a .528 slugging percentage and an .886 OPS in 207 games.
 ☞ To make room for Matthews on the 26-man roster, the Twins have placed left-handed pitcher Danny Coulombe on the 15-day Injured List with a left forearm extensor strain.
 ☞ To make room for McCusker on the 40-man roster, the Twins are transferring infielder Luke Keaschall (right forearm fracture) to the 60-day Injured List...McCusker takes the 26-man roster spot vacated by Byron Buxton, who was placed on the 7-day Concussion Injured List yesterday.

THIS ONE IS FOR ALL THE MOLITORS: The Twins and Brewers are playing each other for the third of six games this season...Minnesota will host the Brewers for a three-game weekend series from June 20-22...Twins seeking three-straight wins vs. Milwaukee for first time since taking four-straight in 2021.

DIRTY FLOORS REQUIRE A BROOM: Minnesota is seeking its fifth sweep of the season today and their fourth consecutively...the other four came April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field, May 6-8 vs. Baltimore at Target Field, May 9-11 vs. San Francisco at Target Field and May 16-18 at Baltimore...Twins had five sweeps all of '24.
 ☞ Only two times in their history have the Twins recorded four consecutive sweeps: 1991 (3 vs. BAL, 3 vs. CLE, 3 vs. NYY and 3 at CLE) and 1980 (3 vs. CWS, 3 vs. TEX, 3 vs. KC and 2 at TEX).
 ☞ Minnesota's last sweep over the Brewers came in two games, from June 13-14 at Target Field...their last three-game sweep was May 22-24, 2009 at the Metrodome...their last three-game sweep in Wisconsin was September 15-17, 1978 at County Stadium — one of four sweeps ever for the Twins in Milwaukee.
 ☞ The Twins have five times this season entered a series finale with a chance to sweep, going 4-1 in those instances...their one miss was the finale against Chicago-AL on April 24.

TWINS MiLB WEEKLYS: Twins have named High-A Cedar Rapids outfielder Gabriel Gonzalez and Double-A Wichita right-handed pitcher John Klein as their minor league Player and Pitcher of the Week.

☞ Gonzalez, 21, played in six games for the Kernels, hitting .385 (10-for-26) with two doubles, one triple, three home runs, 10 RBI and a 1.336 OPS...on Wednesday vs. Peoria, he recorded three hits and on Thursday vs. Peoria, he went 4-for-6 with two doubles, one home run and six RBI...the Carupano, Venezuela native was acquired by the Twins in the Jorge Polanco trade with Seattle during the 2023-24 offseason.
 ☞ Klein, 23, made two relief appearances for the Wind Surge, allowing one unearned run in 6.0 innings, with three hits allowed, two walks and six strikeouts...the Brooklyn Park, Minnesota native was signed by the Twins as an undrafted free agent in August of 2022.

FINALLY...: Carlos Correa reaches 10 years of major league service today...he is currently on the 7-Day Concussion Injured List but is in Milwaukee celebrating with the team.

- ⚡ Making first MLB start of the season and 10th of his career...last pitched in the majors on September 28, 2024 vs. Baltimore, taking the loss in Minnesota's 2-9 defeat; allowed six runs on seven hits in 3.0 innings, with three walks and five strikeouts.
- ⚡ Has made seven starts at Triple-A St. Paul this year, going 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (32.2 IP, 7 ER), nine walks and 38 strikeouts.
- ⚡ Looking to break his four-game MLB losing streak (over nine starts)...seeking first MLB win since August 13, 2024 vs. Kansas City, his major league debut.

LAST START IN THE MAJORS: Last pitched in the majors on September 28, 2024 vs. Baltimore, opposite Matt Bowman, and took the loss in Minnesota's 2-9 defeat...allowed six runs on seven hits, with three walks and five strikeouts in 3.0 innings...allowed home runs to Ryan O'Hearn and Emmanuel Rivera, as well as an RBI single to Adley Rutschman and an RBI double to Rivera.

- ⚡ Induced 13 whiffs on 47 swings (27.7%)...has a 24.0 percent whiff rate at the MLB level.
- ⚡ Allowed four hard-hit balls...has a 42.1 percent hard-hit rate at the MLB level.

LAST START IN THE MINORS: Pitched on May 10 vs. the Buffalo Bisons, opposite Lazaro Estrada...he did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 2-1 victory, allowing one run on five hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in a season-high 5.1 innings...Buffalo's sole run allowed came after Kody Funderburk replaced Matthews in the sixth, then Will Robertson reached base on a throwing error from Ryan Fitzgerald and Davis Schneider scored, a run charged to Matthews.

MINOR LEAGUE RECAP: Has seven starts thus far for the Triple-A St. Paul Saints going 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (32.2 IP, 7 ER), with nine walks and 38 strikeouts.

- ⚡ Matthews holds the fourth lowest ERA in the International League among pitchers with at least seven starts, behind Joe Boyle (1.46), Jacob Misiorowski (1.49) and Bubba Chandler (1.91).
- ⚡ Is also one of four pitchers in the International League with 32.0-plus innings to only allow one home run, alongside Janson Junk (40.1), Dietrich Enns (38.0) and Wilkel Hernandez (36.2).
- ⚡ Is tied for most starts on the Saints' pitching staff with Andrew Morris...has the lowest ERA among Saints pitchers with at least 11.0 innings pitched.

ANOTHER NEW OPPONENT: Has not faced Milwaukee or any current Brewers hitters at the MLB level...has two career Interleague starts (San Diego & St. Louis); 0-1, 2.70 ERA (10.0 IP, 3 ER), two walks, eight strikeouts and a .205 (8-for-39) opponent batting average in those starts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Zebby has gone 1-2 with a 9.82 ERA (18.1 IP, 20 ER), five walks, 27 strikeouts and a .360 (31-for-86) opponent batting average in five career major league starts at home; compared to 0-2, 3.72 (19.1 IP, 8 ER), with six walks, 16 strikeouts and a .256 (20-for-78) opponent batting average in four career major league starts on the road.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through his first nine career major league starts in 2024, left-handed hitters have slashed .315/.382/.620 in 92 at-bats vs. Matthews, while righties have slashed .306/.333/.500 in 72 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 91.2 mph and a whiff rate of 20.3 compared to righties' 89.6 mph and 29.8 percent.

- ⚡ Hard-hit rate (MLB level): 44.9 percent vs. lefties, 38.5 percent vs. righties.

THE ARSENAL: Matthews uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...here is a look at his pitch breakdown from 2024:
