THE TWINS: Completed their six-game roadtrip with a record of 5-1, going 3-0 at Baltimore and 2-1 at Milwaukee...tonight, the Twins will begin their fifth homestand of the season, with six games in seven days...they will host the Guardians from tonight through Wednesday afternoon, enjoy an off day on Thursday, then play the Royals for three over the weekend.

OFF WISCONSIN, BREWERS SNAP ALL THE STREAKS: The Twins lost to the Brewers yesterday afternoon at American Family Field, snapping their 13-game winning streak and losing their first game since May 2 — marked the second-longest winning streak in Twins history (15 in 1991)...Zebby Matthews (0-1) made his 2025 debut, allowing four runs on five hits in 3.0 innings pitched, with three walks and five strikeouts...all three walks were to consecutive batters in the third inning and all scored...the Brewers scored their first run of the series in the second inning, snapping the Twins' scoreless inning streak at a club record 34...the offense out-hit the Brewers 6-5...Royce Lewis hit his first home run of the season, a solo shot off Freddy Peralta in the fourth inning...Lewis' first home run in 141 plate appearances.

THE WINNIN' TWINS: Twins are 19-6 in their last 25 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date, ahead of three second place teams in Detroit (17-7), Kansas City (17-8) and St. Louis (17-7)...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.
 ☞ Over the last 25 games, the Twins have a run differential of +55 (119-64)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

GUARD PLAY: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the fifth of 13 games in 2025... these two met for a four-game series in Cleveland from April 28-May 1 as the Twins won the first game, then lost games two, three and four...Twins outscored the Guardians 17-11 in the series, thanks to an 11-1 victory in game one — their largest margin of victory in 2025.
 ☞ During the four-game series at Progressive Field, Twins starters combined to go 1-1, 2.28 ERA (23.2 IP, 6 ER), with six walks, 14 strikeouts and a .207 opponent batting average.
 ☞ Notable individuals last four-game series vs. Cleveland: Ty France went 9-for-17 (.529) with two doubles and one home run...Harrison Bader went 5-for-12 (.417) with one double...Ryan Jeffers went 3-for-8 (.375) with one double and one home run...Jonah Bride went 3-for-10 (.300) with two RBI...Brooks Lee went 3-for-10 (.300) with one double and one home run.
 ☞ Bader is hitting .304 (14-for-46) with four doubles, two home runs, four RBI, a .373 on-base percentage, a .522 slugging percentage and an .894 OPS in 16 career games against the Guardians.

MINNESOTA: Twins are 15-6 through 21 home games this season.
 ☞ They have won nine-straight at home and 13 of their last 14...their one loss was a 3-0 defeat by the White Sox on April 24.
 ☞ Nine-straight is tied for longest winning streak in Target Field history (also April 22-May 8, 2022 and July 21-August 18, 2010)...in fact, the last Twins team with a longer home winning streak was the 2006 club, which won 13 straight at the Metrodome from June 11-July 2...the club record is 15, which spanned two seasons, from September 2, 2023-April 6, 2024.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Tonight marks the seventh time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 3-3 against lefty starters, their three losses against Martin Pérez (3/31 at CWS), Cole Ragans (4/8 at KC) and Chris Sale (4/19 at ATL), and their wins coming against Yusei Kikuchi (4/26 vs. LAA), Garrett Crochet (May 4 at BOS) and Cade Povich (May 6 vs. BAL).
 ☞ In their last 18 games, Twins are slashing .299/.370/.409 (.778 OPS) against lefties...prior to that stretch, they were .157/.222/.289 (.511 OPS) in their first 20 vs. lefties.
 ☞ Notable individuals in that 18-game stretch: Harrison Bader is hitting .455 (5-for-11) with an .818 slugging percentage...Ryan Jeffers is hitting .400 (6-for-15) with seven walks and a .591 on-base percentage...Jonah Bride is hitting .357 (5-for-14).

CLEAN 'PENMANSHIP: The Twins bullpen finished the six-game roadtrip with an ERA of 0.40 (22.1 IP, 1 ER), no home runs, five walks and 26 strikeouts...since the start of their last homestand, on May 6, they have gone 5-0, 0.42 ERA (43.1 IP, 2 ER) with no home runs allowed, nine walks, 51 strikeouts and a .170 opponent batting average in 12 games.
 ☞ On the season, the Twins bullpen ranks first in baseball in fWAR (3.1), FIP (3.01), holds (39) and soft contact pct (21.8%), third in ERA (2.89) and WHIP (1.10), fifth in strikeouts (184) and seventh in opponent batting average (.214).

UNLOCKING LEWIS: Royce Lewis has hit safely in a season-long four-straight games...in his last seven games overall, he is hitting .308 (8-for-26) with one double, one home run, three RBI and an .819 OPS...since May 15, Lewis ranks 16th in the AL in avg. exit velocity (92.9 mph).

AMERICA'S NEXT TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers is hitting .301 (22-for-73) with five doubles, three home runs, 12 RBI, a .363 on-base percentage, a .493 slugging percentage and an .856 OPS in his last 20 games...tonight marks his second game this season from the leadoff spot, the previous being April 26 vs. Los Angeles-AL (1-for-3, 2 BB)...he is 7-for-17 (.412) in the first inning in 2025...he led off 10 times in 2024.

- ⚔ Making 10th start of the season and 98th career start...sixth start against the Guardians.
- ⚔ Ober is 3-2 in nine career starts against Cleveland, posting a 2.05 ERA (52.2 IP, 12 ER), with five walks, 48 strikeouts and a .212 (41-for-193) opponent batting average.
- ⚔ Looking to earn his fifth consecutive win today...would be the first time in his career he would have a five-plus win streak.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on May 14 in Game 1 of the Twins' doubleheader against the Orioles, opposite Dean Kremer...was scheduled to start a night game on May 13 in Baltimore, but a rainout forced a doubleheader the next day...Ober did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed two runs on three hits, with a season-high-tying three walks and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...runs came off back-to-back hits in the third; an RBI double from Ryan Mountcastle, scoring Ramón Urias and a home run from Gunnar Henderson, scoring Mountcastle...was Ober's first home run allowed since April 15.

⚔ Was the ninth time in his career he faced an opponent in back-to-back starts...also his fifth start in a doubleheader, all five being in the first game.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 8 vs. the Orioles, opposite Dean Kremer...he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 5-2 victory...allowed two runs on a season-high-tying eight hits, with one walk and a season-high-tying six strikeouts in 5.0 innings of work, ending his quality start streak at four games...runs came off an RBI double from Emmanuel Rivera, scoring Ramón Laureano and a sacrifice fly from Ryan Mountcastle, scoring Jackson Holliday; marked Ober's first unearned run allowed of the season...was first time in his career Ober had allowed seven-plus hits in four consecutive starts...plunked Ryan O'Hearn in the fifth, his second hit batter of the season.

⚔ Ober recorded five of his six strikeouts with runners in scoring position, and four came with a runner on third.

⚔ Had not allowed a home run in four consecutive starts; the third time in his career, and the first time since April 8-26, 2024.

AGAINST THE GUARDS: Ober is 3-2 in nine career starts against Cleveland, posting a 2.05 ERA (52.2 IP, 12 ER), with five walks and 48 strikeouts...has a .212 (41-for-193) opponent batting average.

⚔ Last faced Cleveland on April 28, where he earned the win in Minnesota's 11-1 victory, allowed one run on eight hits, with no walks and two strikeouts in a season-high 7.2 quality innings.

⚔ Bailey is 1-1 in three career starts against the Guardians at home, posting a 1.00 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER), with two walks and 15 strikeouts...1.00 is his second lowest ERA when facing teams at home, behind only the Athletics (0.79).

⚔ Bailey is 13-10 in 45 career starts against division opponents, posting a 3.64 ERA (240.0 IP, 97 ER), 9.07 K/9, 1.43 BB/9 and 1.31 HR/9.

LEADING THE PACK: Since debuting with the Twins on May 18, 2021, Ober has made the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2021:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-9 with a 3.83 ERA (254.0 IP, 108 ER), 9.35 K/9, 2.20 BB/9 and 1.59 HR/9 in 49 games (48 starts) at home compared to 13-14 with a 3.83 ERA (270.0 IP, 115 ER), 8.80 K/9, 1.77 BB/9 and 1.27 HR/9 in 50 road starts.

⚔ Ober is 2-0 in four starts at home so far this season, posting a 2.53 ERA (21.1 IP, 6 ER), with four walks, three home runs, 22 strikeouts and a .286 (24-for-84) opponent batting average.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through nine starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .263/.298/.374 in 99 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .292/.346/.500 in 96 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.7 mph and a whiff rate of 21.5 compared to righties' 91.8 mph and 30.0 percent.

⚔ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at his highest since 2021, 31.1 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 54.1 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 38% of the time...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

⚔ His 7.5 foot extension currently ranks in baseball's 99th percentile...ranks in the bottom three percent for max exit velocity at 116.6.

⚔ His slider strikeout percentage is at an all-time low of 10.9 percent, while his sweeper is at an all-time high of 33.3 percent.

THRILL OF THE CHASE: Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 34.0 chase percentage this season, ranking in baseball's 90th percentile; ranks fifth on the Twins pitching staff and first among the team's starting rotation.

UNDER PRESSURE: This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .225 (9-for-40) with three home runs, three walks and 14 strikeouts; with runners in scoring position and two outs, opponents are hitting .105 (2-for-19) with one home run, two walks and six strikeouts.

FIXING THE FASTBALL: Through 2024, opponents were steadily hitting Ober's 4-seam fastball harder and more often than in previous seasons...through eight starts this season, Ober has lowered hard hit percentage and slugging percentage...here are some of his fastball numbers since his 2021 debut:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - CHRIS PADDACK (2025: 2-3, 4.05 ERA // CAREER: 29-27, 4.34 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Paddack is set to start tomorrow night's game against the Guardians at Target Field...earned his second win of the year in his last start on May 15 in Baltimore, allowing three hits and a walk with three strikeouts over 7.0 scoreless innings...is 0-0 with a 2.08 ERA (13.0 IP, 3 ER), two home runs, one walk and eight strikeouts in two career starts against Cleveland; is facing the Guardians for the first time at home...in four home starts this season, Paddack is 1-2 with a 2.95 ERA (21.2 IP, 7 ER), two home runs, eight walks and 18 strikeouts.
