THE TWINS: After completing their six-game roadtrip with a record of 5-1 (3-0 at Baltimore and 2-1 at Milwaukee), the Twins began their six-game homestand with a rain suspended game on Monday night against the Guardians...today, they will continue Monday night's game, then play today's originally scheduled 12:10 game approximately 30 minutes after the first game's final out...they will enjoy an off day tomorrow, then host the Royals for three games over the weekend.

☞ Last night's (Tuesday) originally-scheduled 6:40 pm (CT) game will be made up at 1:10 pm (CT) on Saturday, September 20 as part of a split doubleheader, followed by that night's originally-scheduled 6:10 pm game.

☞ Worth noting...today's games are not considered an official doubleheader.

HITTING PAUSE: Today's game one is a continuation of Monday night's game...that game was delayed for one hour and one minute in the second inning...play resumed and time was called again in the top of the fourth inning and eventually called at 9:09 pm...marked the third time in Target Field history for a game to be suspended and completed at a later time:

- ☞ May 25, 2010 vs. New York-AL...game was stopped by rain at 8:32 pm with the game scoreless at the end of five innings...at 9:55 pm the game was suspended and resumed at 4:05 pm the next afternoon prior to the regularly-scheduled game...the Yankees won the completed game 1-0.
- ☞ May 11, 2022 vs. Houston...before the top of the fourth inning, time was called at 7:56 pm because of incoming high winds and lightning...at 9:17 pm, the game was suspended until the next day...the game was resumed at 12:10 pm on May 12 prior to the regularly-scheduled game...the Astros won 5-0.

TWINNING WAYS: Twins are 19-6 in their last 25 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date, ahead of three second place teams in Detroit (18-8), Kansas City (18-9) and St. Louis (18-8)...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

- ☞ Over the last 25 games, the Twins have a run differential of +55 (119-64)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.
- ☞ On the season, the Twins rank third in the AL in run differential at +36 (196-160), trailing New York's +93 (271-178) and Detroit's +81 (262-181).

GUARD PLAY: The Twins are playing the Guardians today for the fifth and sixth of 13 games in 2025...these two met for a four-game series in Cleveland from April 28-May 1 as the Twins won the first game, then lost games two, three and four...Twins outscored the Guardians 17-11 in the series, thanks to an 11-1 victory in game one — their largest margin of victory in 2025.

- ☞ The next series between these two will be in Cleveland for three, from August 1-3.
- ☞ During the four-game series at Progressive Field, Twins starters combined to go 1-1, 2.28 ERA (23.2 IP, 6 ER), with six walks, 14 strikeouts and a .207 opponent batting average.
- ☞ Notable individuals last four-game series vs. Cleveland: Ty France went 9-for-17 (.529) with two doubles and one home run...Harrison Bader went 5-for-12 (.417) with one double...Ryan Jeffers went 3-for-8 (.375) with one double and one home run...Jonah Bride went 3-for-10 (.300) with two RBIs...Brooks Lee went 3-for-10 (.300) with one double and one home run.
- ☞ Bader (0-for-1 to start Monday night) is now hitting .298 (14-for-47) with four doubles, two home runs, four RBI, a .365 on-base percentage, a .511 slugging percentage and an .876 OPS in 17 career games against the Guardians.

MINNESOTA: Twins are 15-6 through 21 home games this season.

☞ They have won nine-straight and 13 of their last 14 at home...their one loss was a 3-0 defeat by the White Sox on April 24.

☞ Nine-straight is tied for longest winning streak in Target Field history (also April 22-May 8, 2022 and July 21-August 18, 2010)...in fact, the last Twins team with a longer home winning streak was the 2006 club, which won 13 straight at the Metrodome from June 11-July 2...the club record is 15, which spanned two seasons, from September 2, 2023-April 6, 2024.

WHEN IN DOUBT, BARK IT OUT: The Twins bullpen finished the six-game roadtrip with an ERA of 0.40 (22.1 IP, 1 ER), no home runs, five walks and 26 strikeouts...since the start of their last homestand, on May 6, they have gone 5-0, 0.42 ERA (43.1 IP, 2 ER) with no home runs allowed, nine walks, 51 strikeouts and a .170 opponent batting average in 12 games.

☞ On the season, the Twins bullpen ranks first in baseball in IPWAR (3.1), FIP (3.01), and soft contact pct (21.3%), second in holds (39), third in WHIP (1.10), fourth in ERA (2.89), tied for sixth in strikeouts (183) and seventh in opponent batting average (.214).

ALL OR NOTHING (OR ONE A PIECE): Two wins today will give the Twins their fifth sweep of the season as well as make them 10-6-0 in series play...Twins are looking for six consecutive series wins for the first time since April 22-May 12, 2024, when they won series vs. Chicago-AL (3 games), at Los Angeles-AL (3 games), at Chicago-AL (3 games), vs. Boston (3 games), vs. Seattle (4 games) and at Toronto (3 games).

- ⚡ Making his 10th appearance of the season and first career major league appearance in relief... earned the win in his last outing on May 16 in Milwaukee, allowing two hits and a walk with nine strikeouts over 6.0 scoreless innings; Twins won 3-0.
- ⚡ Is 3-4 with a 2.32 ERA (54.1 IP, 14 ER), four homers, six walks and 44 strikeouts in nine career starts against Cleveland.
- ⚡ Among qualified American League pitchers entering today, he ranks ninth in ERA (2.42), tied for eighth in BAA (.186) and second in K/9.0 IP (10.90), K/BB (10.5) and WHIP (0.79).

LAST TIME OUT: Started on May 16 in Milwaukee opposite Chad Patrick...earned his fourth win of the season in Minnesota's 3-0 victory over the Brewers...allowed two hits and a walk while striking out nine over 6.0 scoreless innings...struck out six consecutive batters between the second and third innings...only threat against Ryan came in the sixth, when William Contreras doubled with one out and advanced to third on Christian Yelich's groundout; Ryan struck out Rhys Hoskins to escape the jam.

- ⚡ Prior to the game, the only other time in his career that Ryan has struck out the side in order in back-to-back innings was in the fourth and fifth innings on September 22, 2021 (struck out seven consecutive between the third and fifth innings).
- ⚡ Marked his eighth consecutive game allowing an extra-base hit, tied for the third most in his career; did so in 24-straight games in 2023-24, 12-straight games in 2022 and 2024, and eight-straight games in 2023.

TWO STARTS AGO: Faced San Francisco at home on May 10 opposite Logan Webb, earning the win in Minnesota's 2-1 victory...allowed one run on two hits (1 HR) over 6.0 quality innings, with no walks and seven strikeouts...lone run surrendered came on Heliot Ramos's solo home run in the second inning; was the only baserunner Ryan allowed through his first four innings.

- ⚡ His 76 pitches thrown were his fewest of the season and his fewest in a 6.0-or-more inning start since September 1, 2023 at Texas (74 pitches, 6.0 IP).
- ⚡ Marked the first time in his career that he's allowed seven home runs through his first eight starts of a season (6 in 2024, 4 in 2023, 2 in 2022).

FACING CLEVELAND: In nine career starts against the Guardians, Ryan is 3-4 with a 2.32 ERA (54.1 IP, 14 ER), four home runs, six walks and 44 strikeouts...his 54.1 innings against the Guardians is his second-highest mark against all 27 teams he's faced, trailing Kansas City (55.1 IP)...last faced Cleveland on April 6, 2024 at Target Field, taking the loss in Minnesota's 3-1 defeat; allowed three runs on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and seven strikeouts over 6.0 innings of work.

- ⚡ In his career, Cleveland batters are hitting .189 (37-for-196) with a .527 OPS against Ryan...his 7.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio against the Guards is his fourth best against other American League opponents, while his 0.79 WHIP is his fifth best among all 27 teams he's faced in his career.

CENTRALIZED FORCE: In 33 career starts against the AL Central, Ryan is 17-6 with a 2.52 ERA (196.2 IP, 55 ER), 18 home runs, 35 walks and 212 strikeouts...AL Central batters are hitting .191 (136-for-712) with a .554 OPS against Ryan...is making his second start of the season against the division (also, April 9 at KC)...since 2021, he leads Twins starters with a 2.52 ERA against American League Central teams (minimum 50.0 IP)...among such pitchers, he ranks first in WHIP (0.87) and wins (17), second in strikeouts (212) and strikeouts-per-walk (6.06).

- ⚡ Among all active starters since 2021 with a minimum 50.0 IP against the AL Central, his ERA ranks 14th, his 6.22 hits-per-9.0 innings pitched rank sixth and his strikeouts rank seventh.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Is making his fifth home appearance of the year...is 2-1 with a 2.35 ERA (23.0 IP, 6 ER), three home runs, three walks and 32 strikeouts in four home starts, compared to 2-1 with a 2.48 ERA (29.0 IP, 8 ER), four home runs, three walks and 31 strikeouts in five road starts...in his career, is 21-13 in 47 starts at Target Field with a 3.60 ERA (269.2 IP, 108 ER), a 1.00 WHIP and a 5.23 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ⚡ In his four home starts this season, opposing batters are slashing .173/.221/.333 in 81 at-bats.
- ⚡ In six career starts against the Guardians at Target Field, Ryan is 1-2 with a 3.03 ERA (29.2 IP, 10 ER), a .194 (21-for-108) opponent batting average, including four home runs, and a 9.33 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS: This season, lefties have slashed .198/.235/.309 with three doubles, two home runs, one walk and 18 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .178/.235/.364 with five doubles, five home runs, five walks and 45 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .206/.266/.357 with 63 walks and 227 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .232/.276/.443 with 52 walks and 361 strikeouts.

- ⚡ Cleveland's lefties have slashed .218/.252/.355 in 110 at-bats against Ryan, with three home runs, three walks and 18 strikeouts, while righties have slashed .151/.180/.244 in 86 at-bats, with one homer, three walks and 26 strikeouts.

THE ARSENAL: Through eight starts in 2025, Ryan has relied on a five-pitch mix...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

- ⚡ With 808 pitches thrown this season, Ryan's chase rate is 26.9 percent and his whiff rate is 29.6 percent...his walk rate is 3.0 percent, which ranks in baseball's 98th percentile, and his strikeout rate is 31.5 percent, ranks in baseball's 91st percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.6 mph while his hard hit rate is 44.0 percent.

MOW-'EM-DOWN MAY: In his three starts this May, Ryan is averaging 12.00 strikeouts-per-nine innings pitched, compared to 10.32 K/9 in six starts in March and April...his 267 pitches in May are averaging 90.6 mph with a 31.3 percent whiff rate, compared to 89.6 mph and a 28.8 percent whiff rate over 541 pitches in March/April.

- ⚡ Over his last three starts, his fastball velocity is averaging 93.5 mph, compared to 92.9 mph over his first six starts; his sinker is averaging 93.1 mph, compared to 92.5 mph; his splitter is averaging 88.2 mph, compared to 87.1 mph; his slider is averaging 86.7 mph, compared to 85.2 mph; his sweeper is averaging 80.4 mph, compared to 79.8 mph.

LAST TIME OUT: Last pitched on May 15 at Baltimore opposite Tomoyuki Sugano...earned the victory in Minnesota's 4-0 win, their 11th in a row...allowed three hits and a walk, striking out three in 7.0 scoreless innings...in the fourth, Ryan Mountcastle doubled but was thrown out by Kody Clemens in rightfield when he tried to stretch the hit into a triple; the only other base runner to move into scoring position was **Adley Rutschman**, who was hit by a pitch in the fifth and advanced to second on a single by **Ryan O'Hearn**...Paddack retired the final nine batters he faced, from the fifth-seventh innings; in that stretch, Mountcastle's sixth-inning lineout to center field was the only ball that left the infield.
