THE TWINS: Have gone 1-1 through two games on their current homestand...Minnesota began the homestand with a scheduled three-game series against the Guardians, but played just two games this week due to rainouts...they started the series on Monday night and played three innings before calling for a continuation of the game...they were rained out on Tuesday, then completed game one with a win early Wednesday afternoon...they followed that with game two immediately after and lost...tonight, they continue the homestand with the first of three against the Royals over the weekend.

☞ Twins are 16-7 through 23 home games this season, winning 10 of their last 11 and 14 of their last 16.

☞ Twins are 14-4 in May, tied with Detroit (14-6) for second-most wins in baseball for the month, and trailing Philadelphia (15-5).

TWINS PLAY 1 AND 2/3 AND SPLIT WITH GUARDS: The Twins split the day on Wednesday afternoon to complete the Guardians series, winning the continuation of Monday night's game with a 6-5 walk-off victory, followed by a 5-1 loss to Cleveland immediately following.

☞ Joe Ryan "started" the first game, pitching from the fourth inning through the eighth inning, allowing three runs on three hits in 5.0 innings pitched, with two walks and four strikeouts...the offense recorded 12 hits, three from Jonah Bride...Kody Clemens recorded the walk-off double in the bottom of the ninth, his third career walk-off hit.

☞ They dropped game two by a score of 5-1...Chris Paddack (2-4) was the starter and issued the loss, allowing two runs on seven hits in 5.1 innings pitched...the offense recorded just three hits, one going for extra-bases (Clemens double).

C4 ACTIVATED: The Twins have reinstated shortstop Carlos Correa from the 7-day Concussion Injured List...Correa sustained the injury on May 15 at Baltimore after colliding with outfielder Byron Buxton in short centerfield and missed the club's last five games...prior to landing on the 7-day IL, he hit .236 (35-for-148) with eight doubles, two home runs, 13 RBI, eight walks, 14 runs scored and a .605 OPS in 41 games for the Twins this season...to make room for Correa on the 26-man roster, the Twins optioned infielder Ryan Fitzgerald to Triple-A St. Paul...Fitzgerald appeared in two games for the Twins, including making his major league debut on May 16 at Milwaukee...additionally, the Twins returned utility player Mickey Gasper to St. Paul...Gasper was the 27th man for Wednesday afternoon's second game against the Guardians.

TWINNING WAYS: Twins are 20-7 in their last 27 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date, ahead of three second place teams in Detroit (19-9), Kansas City (19-9) and Philadelphia (19-8)...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

☞ Over the last 27 games, the Twins have a run differential of +52 (126-74)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.

☞ On the season, the Twins rank third in the AL in run differential at +32 (201-169), trailing New York's +95 (276-181) and Detroit's +78 (267-189).

ROYALTY CHECKS: The Twins are playing the fifth of 13 games against the Royals this season...these two met for a four-game series at Kauffman Stadium from April 7-10 as the Twins went 1-3, winning the third game with a 4-0 shutout, led by Joe Ryan.

☞ Twins have gone 29-18 in their last 47 against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 57-40 vs. Kansas City...57 wins are his second-most against any opponent (Chicago-AL - 59-40).

☞ Ty France is hitting .410 (48-for-117) with 10 doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, a .496 on-base percentage, a .675 slugging percentage and a 1.172 OPS in 31 career games against the Royals; the OPS is his highest against any opponent...France went 6-for-14 (.429) with two doubles and two home runs during the last four games series at Kauffman.

☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .296 (60-for-203) with 13 doubles, seven home runs, 23 RBI, 26 walks, a .376 on-base percentage and an .848 OPS in 53 games against the Royals since '19.

SOUTHPAW STORIES: Tonight marks the eighth time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 4-3 against lefty starters, their three losses against Martin Pérez (3/31 at CWS), Cole Ragans (4/8 at KC) and Chris Sale (4/19 at ATL), and their wins coming against Yusei Kikuchi (4/26 vs. LAA), Garrett Crochet (May 4 at BOS), Cade Povich (May 6 vs. BAL) and Logan Allen (May 19 vs. CLE).

☞ In their last 20 games, Twins are slashing .295/.372/.395 (.767 OPS) against lefties...prior to that stretch, they were .157/.222/.289 (.511 OPS) in their first 20 vs. lefties.

☞ Notable individuals in that 20-game stretch: Carlos Correa is hitting .462 (6-for-13) with one home run...Harrison Bader is hitting .429 (6-for-15) with an .714 slugging percentage...Ryan Jeffers is hitting .412 (7-for-17) with nine walks and a .615 on-base percentage...Jonah Bride is hitting .389 (7-for-18).

☞ On the season, Correa is hitting .391 (9-for-23) with two doubles, two home runs, a .739 slugging percentage and a 1.156 OPS vs. lefties.

HARRI, I TOOK CARE OF IT! Harrison Bader has reached base safely in 19 of his last 20 games (0-for-5 on 5/17 at MIL)...during the stretch, he is hitting .339 (21-for-62) with five doubles, one home run, eight RBI, eight walks, a .417 on-base percentage and an .884 OPS...over the stretch, he is hitting .429 (6-for-14) with a 1.244 OPS against left-handed pitching.

☞ He enters tonight with 99 career stolen bases...42 active players have reached the 100 stolen bases mark.

TOP JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has hit safely in five-straight games, his season-long being eight, from April 26-May 6...in his last 22 games, he is hitting .308 (24-for-78) with five doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .393 on-base percentage, a .487 slugging percentage and an .880 OPS.

☞ Tonight marks his fourth game this season from the leadoff spot and third consecutively...in his three starts from that spot he is 3-for-8 with five walks and one hit-by-pitch...he is 8-for-19 (.421) in the first inning in 2025...he led off 10 times in 2024.

- ⚔ Making ninth start of the season and 167th career start...eighth career start against the Royals.
- ⚔ López is 5-1 in seven career starts against Kansas City, posting a 2.23 ERA (44.1 IP, 11 ER), with five walks, 51 strikeouts and a .216 (35-for-162) opponent batting average.
- ⚔ Earned the win in Minnesota's 7-0 shutout over the Brewers in his last start on May 17...allowed two walks, six strikeouts and a .100 (2-for-20) opponent batting average in 6.0 quality innings.

KING PABLO: Last pitched on May 17 at Milwaukee, opposite Tobias Myers; earned the win in Minnesota's 7-0 victory...allowed two hits, two walks, six strikeouts and a .100 (2-for-20) opponent batting average over 6.0 quality innings...led the Twins to their third consecutive shutout win, the sixth time the team has recorded this feat in Twins/Senators (1901-) history, and the first time since July 5-7, 2004...also helped extend their scoreless streak to 33 innings, and their win streak to 13-straight games, the second longest winning streak in team history, behind the 1991 Twins who won 15 in a row from June 1-16.

- ⚔ Marked his sixth-straight outing with six-or-more strikeouts, the fourth time in his career accomplishing such a streak, and first time since April 23-May 9, 2024 (also 6 straight)...career-high is nine consecutive starts, accomplished twice.
- ⚔ Was his first time allowing no runs in an outing since August 18-30, 2024 where he threw 20.2 scoreless innings over three consecutive starts.
- ⚔ Recorded 14 whiffs on 49 swings (28.6%) as well as his highest single-game strikeout percentage since August 30, 2024 (69.5%).

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 11 at Target Field vs. the Giants, opposite Landen Roupp; did not factor into the decision of the Twins' 10-inning, walk-off win...allowed four runs on five hits, two walks and six strikeouts over 6.0 innings...allowed a season-high four earned runs; two sacrifice flies, from Heliot Ramos and Jung Hoo Lee, and a home run from Ramos scoring Matt Chapman...after allowing two hits and one walk in the first, Pablo then went on to retire eight-straight batters in the first through fourth innings.

- ⚔ This is the first time Pablo has recorded a 6.0-plus inning game that was not a quality start since April 28, 2023 vs. Kansas City where he allowed six earned runs in 6.0 innings...he has only had five total non-quality starts, 6.0-plus innings in his career.

THE ROYAL TREATMENT: In seven career starts vs. Kansas City, López is 5-1, 2.23 ERA (44.1 IP, 11 ER), with five walks, 51 strikeouts and a .216 (35-for-162) opponent batting average...last faced the Royals on April 8 at Kauffman Stadium, where he did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 1-2 defeat...allowed one run on three hits, with one walk and six strikeouts in 4.2 innings before he exited the game with two on and two outs due to a right hamstring strain, then placed on the 15-day Injured List.

- ⚔ His five wins against the Royals are tied for his most wins against an opponent, the other team being the New York Mets, for which his record is 5-5...his .833 win percentage is the highest among teams he has started against at least six times.
- ⚔ In 2024, López had two quality starts against the Royals, posting a 2.08 ERA (13.0 IP, 3 ER), with no walks and 12 strikeouts, allowing four runs off 10 hits...his 51 strikeouts are his most among American League teams.

ACE UP OUR SLEEVE: Since joining the Twins, López has had the most starts among all Twins pitchers...here are some of his numbers compared to other starters since 2023:

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since being traded to the Twins in 2023, López has gone 15-8 with a 3.86 ERA (207.1 IP, 89 ER), 10.42 K/9, 2.00 BB/9 and 0.95 HR/9 in 35 starts at home, compared to 17-12 with a 3.41 ERA (229.2 IP, 87 ER), 9.84 K/9, 2.16 BB/9 and 1.21 HR/9 in 39 road starts.

- ⚔ In his last five starts at home, dating back to September 10, 2024, López has gone 3-1, posting a 2.83 ERA (28.2 IP, 4 ER), with nine walks and 41 strikeouts; compared to 2-2, 1.55 ERA (29.0 IP, 5 ER), with four walks and 26 strikeouts in his last five road starts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through eight starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .253/.290/.345 in 87 at-bats vs. López, while righties have slashed .141/.190/.231 in 78 at-bats...lefties posted an average exit velocity of 87.6 mph and a whiff rate of 23.7 compared to righties' 88.0 mph and 29.9 percent.

- ⚔ He has a 30.2 percent hard hit rate against right-handed batters, and an all-time high hard hit rate of 40.0 against left-handed batters.

COOL UNDER PRESSURE: In his career, with runners in scoring position, López has a .245 (180-for-734) opponent batting average...with a runner on third, he puts up a .220 (20-for-91) opponent batting average and with runners on second and third, he allows just a .185 (10-for-54) opponent batting average.

THE ARSENAL: López uses a five-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 44% of the time, the highest of his career...primarily uses his sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ⚔ Currently ranks in the 98th percentile for fastball run value and 91st for breaking run value; compared to fifth percentile for offspeed run value.
- ⚔ Ranks in the 93rd percentile for extension and bottom three percent in max exit velocity at 116.5 mph.
- ⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 100 sweepers, Pablo has the second lowest hard hit percentage at 13.6 percent (behind Ryan Yarbough, 8.7 percent) and ranks 14th in strikeout percentage at 35.3 percent.
- ⚔ Among pitchers who have thrown at least 50 sinkers, López is tied for first in put away percentage (50.0), and third in opponent batting average (0.77) and slugging percentage (.067).

WALK THIS WAY: Pablo's 5.1 percent walk rate ranks in baseball's 87th percentile...he ranks third on the Twins pitching staff behind Danny Coulombe (3.3) and Joe Ryan (3.7)...his walk rate is at an all-time career low, with his average in the previous seven years being six percent.

Ks FOR A GOOD KAUSE: This season, Pablo is donating \$1,000 for every one of his strikeouts to the Minnesota Twins Community Fund...with 49 strikeouts this season, he has donated \$49,000 so far.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, made his third career Opening Day start, became the fourth different Twins pitcher to start at least three-straight Opening Days, joining Bert Blyleven (1972-76), Brad Radke (1999-05) and Dave Goltz (1977-79).
- In 2024, recorded his 800th career strikeout on June 6 at New York-AL, fanning Gleyber Torres in the second inning.
