**THE TWINS:** Have gone 2-1 through three games on their current homestand, splitting two games with Cleveland earlier in the week, followed by a win over Kansas City last night... today, the Twins will play the second of three against the Royals at Target Field...following tomorrow afternoon's series finale, Minnesota will travel to Tampa Bay to begin a 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with stops in Tampa (3 games), Seattle (3 games) and Sacramento (4 games).  
 ☞ Twins are 17-7 through 24 home games this season, winning 11 of their last 12 and 15 of their last 17.  
 ☞ Twins are 15-4 in May, the second-most wins in baseball for the month, and trailing Philadelphia (16-5)...Twins are 95-67 all-time in May wins under Rocco Baldelli (since 2019), their highest of any month.

**TY GAME AND FRANCE CALLS IT:** The Twins walked-off the Royals last night Target Field, winning by a score of 3-1...Pablo López was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on seven hits in 5.2 innings pitched, with no walks and eight strikeouts...the bullpen combined for 3.1 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed, and one walk...the offense recorded six hits, three going for extra bases (Jeffers - 2B, Correa - HR, France - HR)...Carlos Correa made his return from the 7-day Concussion IL and had two hits, including his third home run of the season...Ty France hit the walk-off homer, the fifth walk-off hit of his career (2nd this season - also 4/16 vs. NYM) and first home run.

**MINNESOTA:** Twins are 21-7 in their last 28 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.  
 ☞ Over the last 28 games, the Twins have a run differential of +54 (129-75)...they had a run differential of -20 (75-95) through 22 games up to April 21.  
 ☞ On the season, the Twins rank third in the AL in run differential at +34 (204-170), trailing New York's +94 (278-184) and Detroit's +76 (268-192).

**ROYALE WITH CHEESE:** The Twins are playing the sixth of 13 games against the Royals this season...Minnesota is 2-3 against the Royals, going 1-3 at Kauffman and 1-0 at Target Field.  
 ☞ Twins are 19-3 in their last 22 home games against the Royals.  
 ☞ Twins have gone 30-18 in their last 48 against the Royals, dating back to April 21, 2022.  
 ☞ Rocco Baldelli has a career managerial record of 58-40 vs. Kansas City...58 wins are his second-most against any opponent (Chicago-AL - 59-40).  
 ☞ Ty France is hitting .405 (49-for-121) with 10 doubles, eight home runs, 25 RBI, a .489 on-base percentage, a .686 slugging percentage and a 1.175 OPS in 32 career games against the Royals; the OPS is his highest against any opponent...France has hit safely in all five games against the Royals this season, hitting .389 (7-for-18) with two doubles, three home runs and a 1.450 OPS...three of France's four homers are against the Royals (off Stratton, Wacha and Erceg)...the other came against the Guardians.  
 ☞ Carlos Correa is hitting .300 (62-for-207) with 13 doubles, one tripl, eight home runs, 24 RBI, 26 walks, a .378 on-base percentage and an .866 OPS in 54 games against the Royals since '19.  
 ☞ Career notables vs. Michael Wacha: France is 11-for-22 (.500) with five doubles and one home run...Christian Vázquez is 5-for-11 (.455)...Bader is 4-for-13 (.308).

**BADER TOTS:** Harrison Bader has reached base safely in 20 of his last 21 games (0-for-5 on 5/17 at MIL)...during the stretch, he is hitting .338 (22-for-65) with five doubles, one home run, eight RBI, eight walks, a .413 on-base percentage and an .875 OPS.  
 ☞ He enters today with 99 career stolen bases...42 active players have reached the 100 stolen bases mark.

**SIRI, TELL ME ABOUT SERIES:** Twins are seeking their 10th series win today...they are 9-6-1 in series play, going 5-2-1 at home and 4-4-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 8-2-1 in their last 11.  
 ☞ With a win today the Twins will take their first series against Kansas City since August 12-14, 2024, when they took two of three at Target Field...it will mark their eighth consecutive series win against the Royals at home, dating back to August of 2022.

**CLEMENS TIME:** Kody Clemens has hit safely in each of his last five games, one short of his career-high of six, done from June 4-11, 2023 (with Philadelphia)...over the streak, he is hitting .450 (9-for-20) with three doubles, one triple, one home run, four RBI and a 1.300 OPS.  
 ☞ In his last nine games overall he is hitting .414 (12-for-29) with a 1.296 OPS, since May 11...since that date, he ranks fifth in baseball in OPS and sixth in batting average (minimum of 30 plate appearances)...also, since that date, he is second in baseball, behind Teoscar Hernández (101.4 mph), in average exit velocity at 100.3 mph (minimum of 200 pitches seen).

**WHEN IN DOUBT, BARK IT OUT:** The Twins bullpen has gone 7-0, 1.44 ERA (56.1 IP, 9 ER) with two home runs allowed, 13 walks, 61 strikeouts and a .183 opponent batting average in their last 15 games (since May 6).  
 ☞ On the season, the 'pen ranks first in baseball in fWAR (3.2), FIP (3.10), and soft contact pct (21.6%), second in WHIP (1.10), fourth in ERA (3.03), sixth in strikeouts (193) and seventh in opponent batting average (.212).

**CHRISTIAN MINGLE:** Over his last five games, Christian Vázquez is hitting .300 (6-for-20) with one double, one home run, four RBI, an .800 OPS and just two strikeouts.  
 ☞ Vázquez has a catcher ERA of 2.18 (62. IP, 15 ER) over his last seven games caught...on the season, he has a 2.99 catcher ERA which ranks fourth in all of baseball (minimum of 150.0 innings caught).

- ⚔ Made seven starts at Triple-A St. Paul this year, going 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (32.2 IP, 7 ER), nine walks and 38 strikeouts.

**LAST START:** Last pitched on May 18 at Milwaukee, opposite Freddy Peralta, and took the loss in Minnesota's 2-5 defeat...allowed four runs on five hits, with three walks and five strikeouts in 3.0 innings...his four runs allowed came off two RBI singles from Sai Frelick in the second and third, and an RBI single from Isaac Collins in the third...struck out all three batters in the first...struck out two batters in the third before walking three in a row, followed by two RBI singles.

- ⚔ Joins Joe Ryan and Pablo Lopez as the three current Twins players to have five-or-more strikeouts in each of their last five games.
- ⚔ The loss snapped Minnesota's 13-game winning streak, and his second inning run snapped the Twins' record 34 scoreless innings streak.

**LAST START IN THE MINORS:** Pitched on May 10 vs. the Buffalo Bisons, opposite Lázaro Estrada...he did not factor into the decision of St. Paul's 2-1 victory, allowing one run on five hits, with no walks and four strikeouts in a season-high 5.1 innings...Buffalo's sole run allowed came after Kody Funderburk replaced Matthews in the sixth, then Will Robertson reached base on a throwing error from Ryan Fitzgerald and Davis Schneider scored, a run charged to Matthews.

**MINOR LEAGUE RECAP:** Has seven starts for the Triple-A St. Paul Saints going 2-1 with a 1.93 ERA (32.2 IP, 7 ER), with nine walks and 38 strikeouts. At the time of recall to Minnesota:

- ⚔ Matthews held the third lowest ERA in the International League among pitchers with at least seven starts, behind Carlos Rodriguez (1.59) and Jacob Misiorowski (1.66).
- ⚔ Was also one of six pitchers in the International League with 32.0-plus innings to only allow one home run.
- ⚔ Had the lowest ERA among Saints pitchers with at least 15.0 innings pitched...also the lowest opening batting average among Saints pitchers with at least 7.0 innings.

**VS. KANSAS CITY:** Matthews is 1-1 in two career starts against the Royals, posting a 5.40 ERA (10.0 IP, 6 ER) with one walk and nine strikeouts...Kansas City is the only team Matthews has faced more than once so far in his MLB career...last started against the Royals on September 6, 2024 at Kauffman Stadium where he was dealt the loss in Minnesota's 0-5 shutout defeat...allowed four runs on nine hits (1 HR), with one walk and four strikeouts in 5.0 innings.

⚔ Earned his first and only win against Kansas City on August 13, 2024 during his MLB debut where he allowed two runs on five hits (1 HR), with no walks and five strikeouts in 5.0 innings.
