THE TWINS: Have gone 3-1 through four games on their current homestand, splitting two games with Cleveland earlier in the week, followed by consecutive wins over Kansas City...

LEE SENDS 'EM OFF INTO SATURDAY NIGHT: The Twins walked-off the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field, winning by a score of 6-5...

IN BLOOM: Twins are 16-4 in May, the second-most wins in baseball for the month, and trailing Philadelphia (17-5)...

WINNESOTA: Twins are 18-7 through 25 home games this season, winning 12 of their last 13 and 16 of their last 18.

GAME OF THRONES: The Twins are playing the seventh of 13 games against the Royals this season...Minnesota is 3-3 against the Royals, going 1-3 at Kauffman and 2-0 at Target Field.

SWEEPS WEEK: Minnesota is seeking its fifth sweep of the season today...the other four came April 25-27 vs. Los Angeles-AL at Target Field, May 6-8 vs. Baltimore at Target Field, May 9-11 vs. San Francisco at Target Field and May 16-18 at Baltimore.

SOUTHPAW STUFF: Today marks the ninth time the Twins have faced a left-handed starter this season...Minnesota is 5-3 against lefty starters, their three losses against Martin Pérez (3/31 at CWS), Cole Ragans (4/8 at KC) and Chris Sale (4/19 at ATL).

TWINS MILB WEEKLYS: Twins have named Triple-A St. Paul right-handed pitcher Andrew Morris and High-A Cedar Rapids infielder Kaelen Culpepper as the club's minor league Pitcher and Player of the Week.

ON THIS DAY IN TWINS HISTORY: In 1997, the Twins retired Kirby Puckett's number 34...it was the fifth number to be retired by the Twins and now one of nine: Harmon Killebrew (#3), Rod Carew (#29), Tony Oliva (#6), Kent Hrbek (#14), Bert Blyleven (#28), Tom Kelly (#10), Joe Mauer (#7), Jim Kaat (#36) and Jackie Robinson (#42).

- ⌘ Ober is 0-4 in 11 career starts against Kansas City, posting a 5.90 ERA (50.1 IP, 33 ER), with seven walks, 49 strikeouts and a .305 (64-for-210) opponent batting average.
- ⌘ Looking to earn his fifth consecutive win today...would be the first time in his career he would have a five-plus win streak.

DON'T RAIN ON OUR PARADE: Last pitched on May 19 against the Guardians, opposite Logan Allen...Ober did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-5 victory...allowed one run on three hits, with no walks and three strikeouts in 3.0 innings of work before the game was suspended due to rain...when the game resumed on May 21, Joe Ryan came into the game in relief...Ober's one run allowed came off an RBI double in the first inning from Kyle Manzardo, scoring Angel Martinez...Ober is now tied for the third-best winning percentage in the American League among qualified pitchers.

- ⌘ Marked the third suspended game in Target Field history, also May 25 2010 vs. New York-AL (0-1 loss) and May 11, 2022 vs. Houston (0-5 loss).
- ⌘ Was Bailey's shortest outing since his 2025 season debut where he pitched 2.2 innings...was only the fifth time in his career he has pitched 3.0-or-less innings in a game.

TWO STARTS AGO: Pitched on May 14 in Game 1 of the Twins' doubleheader against the Orioles, opposite Dean Kremer...was scheduled to start a night game on May 13 in Baltimore, but a rainout forced a doubleheader the next day...Ober did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 6-3 victory...allowed two runs on three hits, with a season-high-tying three walks and three strikeouts in 4.2 innings of work...runs came off back-to-back hits in the third; an RBI double from Ryan Mountcastle, scoring Ramon Urias and a home run from Gunnar Henderson, scoring Mountcastle...was Ober's first home run allowed since April 15.

- ⌘ Was the ninth time in his career he faced an opponent in back-to-back starts...also his fifth start in a doubleheader, all five being in the first game.

A ROYAL PAIN: Ober is 0-4 in 11 career starts against the Royals, posting a 5.90 ERA (50.1 IP, 33 ER) with seven walks and 49 strikeouts...Kansas City is the only team against which Ober has recorded more than two career losses...his first start against the Royals on June 6, 2021 marked the second game of his rookie season and first on the road.

- ⌘ Last faced Kansas City on April 10 at Kauffman Stadium; did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 2-3 defeat (6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 BB, 4 K).
- ⌘ Bailey is 13-10 in 46 career starts against American League Central division opponents, posting a 3.63 ERA (243.0 IP, 98 ER), 9.07 K/9, 1.41 BB/9 and 1.30 HR/9.
- ⌘ His .305 (64-for-210) opponent batting average is his highest among opponents he has faced at least three times, and his ERA is his second highest, behind only the Cincinnati Reds (6.19) whom he has faced three times.
- ⌘ Against the Royals, Ober has allowed career-high hits (64), runs (33) and triples (3), as well as second highest number of home runs (10)...has the highest batting average among American League opponents (.316)...has the lowest win percentage (.000) among teams he has started against at least four times.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: Since 2021, Ober has gone 16-9 with a 3.73 ERA (257.0 IP, 109 ER), 9.35 K/9, 2.17 BB/9 and 1.58 HR/9 in 50 games (49 starts) at home compared to 13-14 with a 3.83 ERA (270.0 IP, 115 ER), 8.80 K/9, 1.77 BB/9 and 1.27 HR/9 in 50 road starts.

- ⌘ Ober is 2-0 in four starts at home so far this season, posting a 2.53 ERA (21.1 IP, 6 ER), with four walks, three home runs, 2 strikeouts and a .286 (24-for-84) opponent batting average.
- ⌘ Bailey is 0-1 in four career starts against the Royals at home, posting a 6.50 ERA (18.0 IP, 2 ER), with two walks and 15 strikeouts.

LEFT/RIGHT SPLITS: Through 10 starts in 2025, left-handed hitters have slashed .264/.296/.373 in 110 at-bats vs. Ober, while righties have slashed .289/.343/.495 in 108 at-bats...lefties have posted an average exit velocity of 87.5 mph and a whiff rate of 21.5 compared to righties' 91.8 mph and 30.1 percent.

- ⌘ His hard hit percentage against left-handed batters is at his highest since 2021, 30.8 percent, while his hard hit percentage against right-handed batters is at an all-time high 53.3 percent.

THE ARSENAL: Ober uses a six-pitch mix, per Baseball Savant...throws a 4-seamer over 37% of the time...primarily uses his slider, sweeper and sinker against right-handed batters, while favoring his curveball and changeup against left-handed batters...here is a look at his pitch breakdown:

- ⌘ His 7.5 foot extension currently ranks in baseball's 99th percentile...ranks in the bottom third percentile for max exit velocity at 116.6.
- ⌘ His slider strikeout percentage is at an all-time low of 10.6 percent, while his sweeper is at an all-time high of 42.9 percent.

THRILL OF THE CHASE: Per Baseball Savant, Bailey owns a 35.2 chase percentage this season, ranking in baseball's 94th percentile; ranks second on the Twins pitching staff, behind Griffin Jax (40.1).

UNDER PRESSURE: This season, with runners in scoring position vs. Ober, opponents are hitting .220 (9-for-41) with three home runs, three walks and 15 strikeouts; with runners in scoring position and two outs, opponents are hitting .100 (2-for-10) with one home run, two walks and seven strikeouts.

FIXING THE FASTBALL: Through 2024, opponents were steadily hitting Ober's 4-seam fastball harder and more often than in previous seasons...through 10 starts this season, Ober has lowered hard hit percentage and slugging percentage...here are some of his fastball numbers since his 2021 debut:

TOMORROW'S STARTER - CHRIS PADDACK (2025: 2-4, 3.98 ERA // CAREER: 29-28, 4.33 ERA)

Right-hander Chris Paddack is set to start tomorrow night's game at Tampa Bay...last started on May 21 vs. Cleveland, allowing two runs on seven hits, with two walks and two strikeouts over 5.1 scoreless innings...facing Tampa Bay for the first time in his career...he is 4-5 in 10 career starts against American League East opponents, posting a 6.44 ERA (50.1 IP, 36 ER), with 14 walks and 38 strikeouts...in five starts on the road so far this season, Paddack is 1-1 with a 4.97 ERA (25.1 IP, 14 ER), nine walks, 15 strikeouts and a .231 (21-for-91) opponent batting average.

CAREER NOTES

- In 2025, made the Twins Opening Day roster for the second consecutive year and third in career.
- In 2024, pitched first career complete game on June 22 at Oakland, allowing two runs on four hits in 9.0 innings, with two walks and 10 strikeouts...threw just 89 pitches, becoming the first pitcher with a nine-inning CG and 10+ strikeouts on fewer than 90 pitches since David Cone.
- Struck out career-high 12 batters on September 18, 2024 at Cleveland (7.0 IP), fourth time on season and fifth time in career with double-digit strikeouts totals.
- Set career highs in wins (12), starts (31), innings pitched (178.2) and strikeouts (191) in 2024.
- Made Postseason debut in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, allowing six runs on eight hits (4 HR) in 4.1 total innings between Games 1 and 3.
- In 2023, made 26 regular season starts for the Twins, going 8-6 with a 3.43 ERA (144.1 IP, 55 ER), 29 walks, 146 strikeouts and 12 quality starts.
- In 2022, made 11 starts for the Twins along with four rehab starts in the minors, going 2-3, 3.21 ERA (56.0 IP, 20 ER) with 11 walks and 51 strikeouts for Minnesota.
- Made his MLB debut on May 18, 2021, starting for the Twins against Chicago-AL.
- Finished the 2021 season with a record of 4-3, 3.99 ERA (10.1 IP, 48 ER), 24 walks and 117 strikeouts in 24 starts between St. Paul and Minnesota.
- Added to Twins 40-man roster on November 20, 2020.
- Split the 2019 season between three levels of Twins organization, combining to go 8-0, 0.69 ERA (78.2 IP, 6 ER) with nine walks, 100 strikeouts and a .194 opponent batting average in 14 games (13 starts) for GCL Twins, High-A Fort Myers and Double-A Pensacola.
- Led all minor league pitchers (min. 75.0 IP) with a 0.69 ERA in 2019 and ranked second in the minors with a 0.81 WHIP...also became the first Twins minor league pitcher to allow six-or-fewer earned runs in 78.2-or-more innings pitched since at least 1961.
- Named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week twice during the 2019 season: once for Fort Myers on August 4 (6.1 IP, 0 ER, 6 H in 1 start) and again on August 25 with Pensacola (1-0, 7.0 IP, 0 ER, 3 H, 0 BB, 12 K).
- In 2018, was named Twins minor league Pitcher of the Week in consecutive weeks: July 7, going 1-0 with 7.0 shutout innings and 12 strikeouts vs. Wisconsin for Low-A Cedar Rapids Kernels, and again July 14, going 1-0 with two runs allowed in 7.0 innings and 10 strikeouts vs. Fort Wayne...became first ever Twin to win the award twice in a season.
- Selected by Twins in 12th round of 2017 First-Year Player Draft; signed by scout Seth Moir...originally selected by Los Angeles-NL in the 23rd round of the 2016 First-Year Player Draft, but elected to return to the College of Charleston.
