THE TWINS: Completed their homestand with a record of 3-2, going 1-1 vs. Cleveland and 2-1 vs. Kansas City...tonight, Minnesota will begin a 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with the first of three at Tampa Bay...they will play three games against the Rays through Wednesday then travel to Seattle and enjoy an off-day on Thursday...they will play three games at T-Mobile Park over the weekend, then travel to Sacramento to play the A's for four games (Monday-Thursday).
 ☞ The Twins have gone 16-3 in their last 19 games, since May 3.
 ☞ Twins are 22-8 in their last 30 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.
 ☞ On the season, the Twins rank third in the AL in run differential at +34 (210-176), trailing New York's +107 (296-189) and Detroit's +79 (278-199).

OBER DOMINANT BUT TWINS MISS SWEEP CHANCE: The Twins lost to the Royals yesterday afternoon at Target Field by a score of 2-1 in 10 innings, making Minnesota 2-3 in extras this season and 7-7 in one-run games...Bailey Ober was the starter but did not factor into the decision, allowing one run on seven hits in 6.2 innings pitched, with one walk and three strikeouts...Jhoan Duran (3-1) was issued the loss, allowing the second base ghost runner to score in the 10th inning...Duran had two outs and two strikes on Maikel Garcia before the third baseman poked a single into leftfield, scoring the winning run...the offense recorded just three hits, led by Ryan Jeffers who reached twice with a single and a walk.

SPRING INTO ACTION: Twins are 16-5 in May, tied with St. Louis (16-6) for the second-most wins in baseball for the month, and trailing Philadelphia (17-6)...Twins are 96-68 all-time in May wins under Rocco Baldelli (since 2019), their highest of any month...below are Rocco's monthly records (left) and his year-by-year wins in May (right):

FLORIDA MEN: The Twins went 3-4 against the Rays last season, going 1-2 at Target Field from June 18-20 and 2-2 at Tropicana Field from September 2-5.
 ☞ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 16-16 against the Rays, including a record of 8-9 at Tropicana Field and 8-7 at Target Field.
 ☞ Twins have homered in 11-straight games against the Rays, hitting 20 home runs in that span...it's Minnesota's longest streak against Tampa Bay.
 ☞ In his last 13 games against the Rays (since 2022), Carlos Correa is hitting .373 (19-for-51) with three doubles, two home runs, five RBI and a .956 OPS.
 ☞ Rays starter Zack Littell made his debut with the Twins in 2018 and pitched parts of three seasons with Minnesota, from 2018-20, going 6-2, 4.52 ERA (63.2 IP, 32 ER) with 23 walks and 49 strikeouts in 43 games...Littell was acquired by the Twins via trade with the Yankees at the 2017 trade deadline along with Dietrich Enns, in exchange for Jaime Garcia...Zack left the Twins via free agency after the 2020 season.

BY GEORGE: The Twins are playing their first regular season games at George M. Steinbrenner Field this week...they played their first game in this ballpark during 1997 spring training, on March 25 against New York-AL and have played 24 spring games here against the Yankees...they last played here on March 6, winning by a score of 8-4...Joe Ryan started that game, pitching 2.0 scoreless innings, with one hit allowed, one walk and four strikeouts...other current 26-man roster players to appear in that game: Zebby Matthews pitched 1.1 scoreless innings...Kody Funderburk pitched 1.0 scoreless inning...Ryan Jeffers went 2-for-3 with a walk...Trevor Larnach went 2-for-3 with a walk...Brooks Lee went 2-for-4 with a home run off Gerrit Cole...DaShawn Keirse Jr. went 0-for-4.

ALSO...The pitching staff's 176 runs allowed on the season are tied for their third-fewest through 52 games (also 176 in 1969), trailing their 1968 total (156) and 1972 total (168).

HOME SICK: The Twins have gone 11-15 on the road this season, compared to their home record of 18-8...they began the season going 4-14 on the road, but have since gone 7-1 since May 3.
 ☞ Over their last roadtrip, the Twins went 5-1, going 3-0 at Baltimore, from May 14-15 and 2-1 at Milwaukee, from May 16-18.
 ☞ Last trip, the bullpen combined to go 2-0, 0.40 ERA (22.1 IP, 1 ER) with no home runs, five walks, 26 strikeouts and a .150 opponent batting average.
 ☞ Notable individual hitters over the last roadtrip: Kody Clemens went 8-for-20 (.400) with one double, two home runs, six RBI and a .750 slugging percentage...Ryan Jeffers went 8-for-22 (.364) with one double and one home run...Christian Vázquez went 6-for-17 (.353) with one double and one home run...Willi Castro went 4-for-12 (.333) with one double and one home run.

CLEMENS TIME: Kody Clemens has hit safely in each of his last six games with an at-bat, tying his career-high, previously done from June 4-11, 2023 (with Philadelphia)...additionally, he has reached safely via hit, walk or HBP in a career-high 13-straight games, posting a .488 on-base percentage over the 13 games.
 ☞ Since May 11, he ranks third in baseball, behind Teoscar Hernández (101.4 mph) and Oneil Cruz (101.0 mph), in average exit velocity at 100.4 mph (minimum of 200 pitches seen).

MASTER JEFF: Ryan Jeffers has reached safely in eight-straight games, tying his season-high, done twice previously...his career-high is 16, from April 22-May 9, 2024...in his last 23 games overall, he is hitting .303 (23-for-76) with six doubles, three home runs, 13 RBI, a .404 on-base percentage, a .500 slugging percentage and a .904 OPS.

HAPPY MEMORIAL DAY: The Twins are 26-32 all-time on Memorial Day...the Twins won on Memorial Day last season, a 6-5 victory against the Royals at Target Field...in that game, Joe Ryan pitched 7.0 innings, allowing one run on four hits, with no walks and nine strikeouts...Trevor Larnach and Jose Miranda each homered.

- ⚔ Making his 11th start of the season and the 93rd of his career (96th appearance)...took the loss, his fourth of the season, in his last start on May 21 vs. Cleveland (5.1 IP, 7 H, 2 R, 2 BB, 2 K).
- ⚔ Is facing Tampa Bay for the first time in his career...in two starts this season against the American League East, is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER), three walks and five strikeouts.
- ⚔ In five road starts in 2025, is 1-1 with a 4.97 ERA (25.1 IP, 14 ER), five home runs, nine walks and 15 strikeouts.

LAST TIME OUT: Took the loss in his last start, on May 21 vs. Cleveland, opposite Gavin Williams, a 5-1 Twins defeat...allowed two runs on a season-high-tying seven hits, walking two and striking out two over 5.1 innings...retired eight-straight batters in first-third innings after giving up a leadoff double to Steven Kwan...Twins led 1-0 when he exited the game with the bases loaded in the sixth; his two runs allowed came retroactively from a walk and sacrifice fly allowed by reliever Louis Varland.

- ⚔ Allowed a runner to advance to third base in the first, fourth, fifth and sixth innings...retired all but the final runner, who scored on a bases loaded walk by Louis Varland in relief.
- ⚔ Both batters he walked came around to score in the sixth inning...marked the eighth and ninth time this season that a runner has scored after being walked by Paddack (also 3x on 3/31, 1x on 4/6, 4/12, 4/24, 5/4).
- ⚔ In 15 career games allowing seven-or-more hits, Paddack is 3-10...six of those games were with the Twins; Minnesota is 2-4, their two wins coming on April 27 and May 8, 2024.

TWO STARTS AGO: Last pitched on May 15 at Baltimore opposite Tomoyuki Sugano...earned the victory in Minnesota's 4-0 win, their 11th in a row...allowed three hits and a walk, striking out three in 7.0 scoreless innings...Paddack retired the final nine batters he faced, from the fifth-seventh innings; in that stretch, Ryan Mountcastle's sixth-inning lineout to center field was the only ball that left the infield.

- ⚔ Prior to the game, Paddack had not hit a batter since April 16, 2024, also in Baltimore.
- ⚔ Marked his first scoreless outing since June 10, 2024 vs. Colorado and his first scoreless 7.0-or-more inning outing since April 22, 2024 vs. Chicago-AL; was the fourth time in his career not allowing a run while going 7.0-or-more innings.
- ⚔ Marked the fourth time since joining the Twins in 2022 that Paddack has gone 7.0-or-more innings...was his sixth quality start with Minnesota.

RIDING WITH THE SHERIFF: After starting the season with a combined 7.1 innings in two outings, Paddack has gone 5.0-or-more innings in eight consecutive starts, since April 12 vs. Detroit...is the third-longest streak in his career, his high being nine straight (April 16-May 30, 2024).

- ⚔ In his last seven starts, he has posted a 2.22 ERA (44.2 IP, 11 ER)...only in two other eight-game stretches in his career has he posted a lower ERA, both coming in 2019, his rookie season: posted a 1.99 ERA from March 31-May 14, 2019 and a 1.94 ERA from April 6-May 20, 2019.

FACING TAMPA BAY: Has never faced Tampa Bay in his career...following his start tonight, he will have faced all but three teams in the major leagues: the Blue Jays, the Padres and the Twins.

EAST BOUND AND DOWN: Paddack is making his 11th career start against the American League East; 10 career games against the AL East mark his fewest against any division in baseball...below are some of his career numbers against the American League East compared to the AL Central and AL West divisions:

ADDITIONALLY: In two starts against the AL East this season (May 4 at Boston, May 15 at Baltimore), Paddack is 1-0 with a 2.25 ERA (12.0 IP, 3 ER), three walks and five strikeouts.

HOME/ROAD SPLITS: In five road starts this season, is 1-1 with a 4.97 ERA (25.1 IP, 14 ER), five home runs, nine walks and 15 strikeouts, compared to 1-3 with a 3.04 ERA (26.2 P, 9 ER), two home runs, 10 walks and 20 strikeouts in five starts at Target Field...since joining the Twins in 2022, is 4-4 with a 5.31 ERA (79.2 IP, 47 ER) over 16 appearances (15 starts) on the road...in that span, is averaging 9.04 hits-per-nine innings with a 1.28 WHIP and a 2.59 strikeout-to-walk ratio in away games.

- ⚔ In his career, Paddack is 12-14 with a 4.56 ERA (241.0 IP, 122 ER), with 56 walks and 216 strikeouts over 48 appearances (47 starts) on the road.
- ⚔ Six of Paddack's 10 career games against the American League East have been on the road, including his previous three starts...in his career, is 2-3 with a 6.82 ERA (31.2 IP, 24 ER), five home runs, eight walks and 23 strikeouts when pitching at AL East ballparks; opponents are slashing .288/.338/.464 in 125 at-bats.

PLATOON SPLITS: This season, left-handed hitters are batting .212 (21-for-99) with three home runs, 10 walks, 13 strikeouts and seven RBI against Paddack, while righties are batting .261 (24-for-92) with four home runs, nine walks, 22 strikeouts and 15 RBI...in his career, lefties are slashing .242/.290/.411 with 36 home runs and 3.25 strikeout-to-walk ratio against Paddack, while righties are slashing .258/.297/.438 with 38 home runs and 5.40 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ⚔ Lefties in the American League East are slashing .280/.336/.364 with one home run, eight walks and 17 strikeouts in 107 career at-bats against Paddack, while righties are slashing .309/.346/.567 with six walks and 21 strikeouts in 97 at-bats against him.

THE ARSENAL: In 2025, Paddack has relied on a five-pitch mix, including a sinker which he introduced in his previous start, per Baseball Savant...here is his pitch repertoire and results:

- ⚔ With 870 pitches thrown this season, Paddack has a 16.1 percent strikeout rate and an 8.8 percent walk rate...batters are chasing 30.7 percent of the time, whiffing 20.4 percent of the time and hitting the ball hard 45.1 percent of the time.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025 marks his ninth professional season and fourth with the Twins...is seeking his first unbridged major league season since his rookie year in 2019.
- Finished 2024 season on 15-day IL with a right shoulder strain, retroactive July 20.
- Pitched a career-high 8.0 inning game on May 19, 2024 at Cleveland...previous high of 7.2 innings, May 6, 2019 and July 17, 2019 with San Diego.
- Made two relief appearances in 2023 ALDS vs. Houston, striking out six and allowing one baserunner in 3.2 innings between Games 1 and 4.
- In 2023, returned from second Tommy John surgery to make two September relief appearances with Minnesota.
- Signed three-year contract extension on January 18, 2023, keeping him in Minnesota through 2025 season.
