**THE TWINS:** After completing their homestand with a record of 3-2 (1-1 vs. Cleveland and 2-1 vs. Kansas City), Minnesota began its 10-game, 11-day roadtrip with a loss to the Rays last night at George M. Steinbrenner Field...they will play the second of three tonight and finish the series tomorrow afternoon...after tomorrow's game, they will travel to Seattle to enjoy an off-day on Thursday, then play the Mariners at T-Mobile Park over the weekend...following that series, they will fly to Sacramento to play the A's for four games from Monday-Thursday.

☞ The Twins have gone 16-4 in their last 20 games, since May 3.

☞ Twins are 22-9 in their last 31 games since April 22, the most wins in baseball since that date...prior to April 22, the Twins began the season 7-15.

☞ On the season, the Twins rank third in the AL in run differential at +29 (212-183), trailing New York's +111 (301-190) and Detroit's +81 (281-200).

☞ The Twins have gone 8-2 against AL East opponents, going 2-1 at Boston (May 2-4), 3-0 vs. Baltimore at Target Field (May 6-8), 3-0 at Baltimore (May 14-15) and 0-1 against Tampa Bay...last season, they went just 10-21 against the division.

**HELP ME ARANDA:** The Twins lost to the Rays last night at George M. Steinbrenner Field by a score of 7-2, losing back-to-back games for the first time since dropping four-straight from April 29-May 2...Chris Paddack (2-5) was the starter and issued the loss, allowing two runs on five hits in 5.1 innings pitched, with no walks and five strikeouts...Brock Stewart allowed a three-run homer to his first batter faced (Jonathan Aranda) in the sixth inning...the offense recorded five hits with their only two runs coming on a Carlos Correa two-run homer in the seventh inning, his fourth of the season.

**SPENDING THE MONTH AT CAMP ROCCO:** Twins are 16-6 in May, tied with St. Louis (16-7) and Detroit (16-8) for the second-most wins in baseball for the month, trailing Philadelphia (17-6)...Twins are 96-69 all-time in May wins under Rocco Baldelli (since 2019), their highest of any month...below are Rocco's monthly records (left) and his year-by-year wins in May (right):

**50 SHADES OF RAY:** The Twins and Rays are playing the second of six games this season...their next series will be at Target Field, from July 4-6.

☞ Twins are 91-97 all-time against the Rays...they were 44-29 against Tampa from 1998-2006, but have since gone 47-68 since 2007.

☞ Rocco Baldelli has a managerial record of 16-17 against the Rays, including a record of 8-10 at Tropicana Field and 8-7 at Target Field.

☞ Twins have homered in 12-straight games against the Rays, hitting 21 home runs in that span...it's Minnesota's longest streak against Tampa Bay.

☞ In his last 14 games against the Rays (since 2022), Carlos Correa is hitting .364 (20-for-55) with three doubles, three home runs, seven RBI, a .582 slugging percentage and a .978 OPS.

ALSO...Twins rank fifth in baseball in first strike percentage at 63.7%.

**SERIES STREAK IN JEOPARDY:** Twins are looking to avoid losing their seventh series tonight and first since April 28-May 1, when they dropped three of four at Progressive Field against the Guardians...Twins are 10-6-1 in series play, going 6-2-1 at home and 4-4-0 on the road...they began the season 1-4-0 in series play but have gone 9-2-1 in their last 12.

**CLEMENS TIME:** Kody Clemens has hit safely in each of his last seven games with an at-bat, marking a new career-high...additionally, he has reached safely via hit, walk or HBP in a career-high 14-straight games, posting a .488 on-base percentage over those 14.

☞ Since May 11, he ranks second in baseball, behind Teoscar Hernández (100.6 mph) in average exit velocity at 100.5 mph (minimum of 200 pitches seen).

**C4, EXP-'LOS-IVE:** Over his last 21 games, since April 25, Carlos Correa is hitting .316 (24-for-76) with two doubles, three home runs, 11 RBI, a .461 slugging percentage and a .798 OPS — Twins are 15-6 in that span...in his previous 25 games, prior to April 25, he hit .174 (15-for-86) with six doubles, one home run, six RBI, a .279 slugging percentage and a .513 OPS — Twins 9-16 in those games.

- ☞ Making his 11th appearance (10th start) of the season...recorded his first career relief appearance on May 21 vs. Cleveland, 'starting' the resumption of May 19's rain-suspended game; pitched the fourth-eighth innings, allowing three runs on three hits with two walks and four strikeouts.
- ☞ Is decisionless in two career starts against Tampa Bay, both at Target Field, with a 2.53 ERA (10.2 IP, 3 ER), two home runs, three walks and 12 strikeouts.
- ☞ Among qualified American League pitchers entering today, he ranks 10th in ERA (2.68), fourth in K/9.0 IP (10.58), tied for third in BAA (.185), and second in K/BB (8.37) and WHIP (0.80).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Made his first career relief appearance on May 21 vs. Cleveland, starting the resumption of May 19's rain-suspended game, which lasted three innings before being halted; the Twins led 2-1 at the time of resumption and won the game in walk-off fashion in the ninth...Ryan did not factor into the game's decision, pitching the fourth-eighth innings (5.0 IP), and allowing three runs on three hits (1 HR), with two walks and four strikeouts...surrendered a solo home run to Carlos Santana in the fourth inning, Ryan's eighth of the year...was removed in the top of the ninth after giving up a double and a walk with no outs; both runners scored with Jhoan Duran on the mound.

- ☞ Marked the second time this season and the fourth time in his last 15 outings, since July 12, 2024 at San Francisco, that he's walked two-or-more batters...his 2.00 strikeout-to-walk ratio was his lowest mark in an outing since July 12 (2.00 K/BB).
- ☞ Marked his ninth consecutive game allowing an extra-base hit, the third longest streak in his career; did so in 24-straight games in 2023-24, 12-straight games in 2022 and 2024, and eight-straight games in 2023.

**TWO STARTS AGO:** Started on May 16 in Milwaukee opposite Chad Patrick...earned his fourth win of the season in Minnesota's 3-0 victory over the Brewers...allowed two hits and a walk while striking out nine over 6.0 scoreless innings...struck out six consecutive batters between the second and third innings...only threat against Ryan came in the sixth, when William Contreras doubled with one out and advanced to third on Christian Yelich's groundout; Ryan struck out Rhys Hoskins to escape the jam.

- ☞ Prior to the game, the only other time in his career that Ryan has struck out the side in order in back-to-back innings was in the fourth and fifth innings on September 22, 2021 (struck out seven consecutive between the third and fifth innings).

**FACING TAMPA BAY:** Is making his third career start against Tampa Bay and his first on the road...is 0-0 with a 2.53 ERA (10.2 IP, 3 ER), two home runs, three walks and 12 strikeouts...last faced Tampa Bay on June 19, 2024 at Target Field, allowing one run on six hits, including a solo home run, with three walks and 12 strikeouts; Twins led 2-1 when Ryan exited the game but were walked-off, 3-2, in the tenth inning.

- ☞ Was selected by the Rays in the 2018 MLB First-Year Player Draft and traded to the Twins in July 2021, along with pitcher Drew Strotman, in exchange for Nelson Cruz.

**FACING THE AL EAST:** In 17 career starts against the American League East, Ryan is 6-5 with a 3.39 ERA (101.0 IP, 38 ER), 17 walks and 108 strikeouts...11 of his 17 starts against the AL East have been quality, and the Twins own a 10-7 record when he pitches against the division...has two 10-plus strikeout games against the AL East (10 K on April 13, 2023 at New York-AL; 10 K on July 9, 2023 vs. Baltimore).

- ☞ Owns a .221 (85-for-385) career opponent batting average vs. the AL East, the second-lowest by a Twins pitcher against the division since it was formed in 1969 (min. 15 GS)...of such pitchers, Ryan's 1.01 WHIP ranks second and his 6.35 strikeout-to-walk ratio ranks first.
- ☞ Has faced the Red Sox six times, the Yankees four times, the O's three times, and the Rays and the Blue Jays twice each.

**HOME/ROAD SPLITS:** Is making his sixth road appearance of the year...is 2-1 with a 2.48 ERA (29.0 IP, 8 ER), four home runs, three walks and 31 strikeouts in five road starts, compared to 2-1 with a 2.89 ERA (28.0 IP, 9 ER), four home runs, five walks and 36 strikeouts in five home appearances (4 starts)...in his career, is 16-15 in 46 starts away from Target Field, with a 3.95 ERA (252.2 IP, 111 ER), a 1.09 WHIP and a 4.98 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

- ☞ In his five road starts this season, opposing batters are slashing .196/.246/.346 in 107 at-bats.
- ☞ Has never faced Tampa Bay on the road...in eight career starts at American League East ballparks, is 4-1 with a 3.09 ERA (46.2 IP, 16 ER), six home runs, eight walk and 45 strikeouts; Twins are 6-2.

**LEFT-RIGHT SPLITS:** This season, lefties have slashed .198/.245/.333 with four doubles, three home runs, three walks and 22 strikeouts against Ryan, while righties have slashed .174/.231/.358 with five doubles, five home runs, five walks and 45 strikeouts...in his career, left-handed hitters are slashing .206/.266/.359 with 65 walks and 231 strikeouts, while right-handed hitters are slashing .232/.276/.442 with 52 walks and 361 strikeouts.

- ☞ Tampa Bay's left-handed hitters have gone 3-for-23 (.130) with two doubles, an RBI, a walk and eight strikeouts against Ryan, while right-handed hitters have gone 8-for-19 (.421) with one double, two home runs, two RBI, two walks and four strikeouts.

**THE ARSENAL:** Through 10 appearances (nine starts) in 2025, Ryan has relied on a six-pitch mix, including a curveball which he introduced in his previous outing...here is his pitch repertoire and results, per Baseball Savant:

Note: Ryan struck out Kyren Paris in the sixth inning on 4/27 vs. LAA...the pitch type of the third strike has not been specified by Savant.

- ☞ With 897 pitches thrown this season, Ryan's chase rate is 25.9 percent and his whiff rate is 28.5 percent...his walk rate is 3.7 percent, which ranks in baseball's 96th percentile, and his strikeout rate is 30.6 percent, which ranks in baseball's 90th percentile...his average exit velocity is 90.2 mph while his hard hit rate is 42.0 percent.
- ☞ Prior to his last outing vs. Cleveland, Ryan had not utilized his curveball since September 30, 2022...he has thrown a total of 200 curves in his career with an average speed of 74.6 mph; his curveball has yielded a 23.1 percent strikeout rate and a 2.6 percent walk rate.

## TOMORROW'S STARTER - RHP PABLO LÓPEZ (2025: 4-2, 2.31 ERA // CAREER: 58-51, 3.82 ERA)

Right-hander Pablo López is set to start tomorrow's series finale at George M. Steinbrenner Field in Tampa...last pitched on May 23 vs. Kansas City at Target Field; did not factor into the decision of Minnesota's 3-1 walk-off victory, allowing one run on seven hits over 5.2 innings, walking none and striking out five...has faced the Rays eight times in his career, including five starts with Miami and three starts with Minnesota; is 2-3 with a 4.05 ERA (46.2 IP, 21 ER), eight home runs, eight walks and 47 strikeouts.
